- It is just the second meeting in the all-time series history between the two teams and first ever in Atlantic Coast Conference action
- All series meetings between the Hokies and Cardinal have occurred in Palo Alto
- The last time Virginia Tech and No. 3 Stanford met was in the third round of the NCAA Championship in 2019
- Stanford has been ranked inside the top 10 of the United Soccer Coaches Poll for each meeting between the two teams
- This is the first instance where VT will not be ranked heading into a match with the Cardinal

ABOUT OUR NAME

Our official name is Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, but using the full name is cumbersome. Thus, "Virginia Tech" is preferable in all but formal uses. When using the full name of the university, never use an ampersand instead of "and." Never use VPI&SU, VPI and SU, VA Tech, Va. Tech, or Virginia Tech University. "Tech" is acceptable after a first reference to "Virginia Tech," but it should not be used repeatedly or solely. "VT" is acceptable only in limited, informal situations. "VPI," which was the university's acronym/nickname from 1896 to 1970, should be used only in historical contexts. The same is true for "VAMC," the university's acronym/nickname before 1896.

MATCH NOTES

HOKIES VERSUS RANKED TEAMS IN 2025

- Virginia Tech is 1-0-1 against top 25 teams through six games in the 2025 campaign
- The Hokies have only faced teams ranked within the top three spots
- No. 3 Stanford is the second national third-ranked squad Tech has faced this season
- VT's lone top 25 win in 2025 came in the season opener, a 1-0 defeat of No. 3 Ohio State in the season opener in Blacksburg

LOOKING FOR A WIN

- A favorable result for the Hokies would be their first ever win over No. 3 Stanford and first of the series
- It would be Tech's first ACC victory of the season
- It would be the first time since 2004 to beat two top three teams in a season (Oct. 8 at No. 1 Duke, 1-0, and Oct. 30 vs. No. 2 Virginia, 2-1)
- A second victory over a top 25 team in 2025 would be the most since the 2021 squad recorded two

IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL STANDINGS

- The Hokies land top 50 nationally in corner kicks per game (16th, 6.67), shutout percentage (36th, 0.500), shots per game (41st, 14.50), team goals against average (41st, 0.833), and shots on goal per game (44th, 6.00)
- Veteran forward Declan Quill has emerged in the national ranks with a 3.17 shots per game and 1.50 shots on goal per game, good for 30th and 32nd nationally, respectively
- Goalkeeper Sam Joseph is 28th in the nation with three shutouts

RECAPPING THE MATCH AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- Virginia Tech held the advantage in both shots, 16-6, and corner kicks, 9-2
- The Hokies faced their fourth penalty shot of the season
- Declan Quill led all players with seven shots
- Forward Andy Sullins put all three of his shots on frame, a game-high
- Goalkeeper Sam Joseph has now totaled five saves in ACC play after stopping two shots from the Eagles

PUTTING OUR SKILLS TO TEST

- Through six games, Virginia Tech has played the nation's 18th toughest schedule
- The Hokies past opponents combine for a 18-9-5 overall record with a 0.641 winning percentage
- Tech's slate ranks the toughest amongst all ACC foes

- VT has played two top three opponents so far in their 2025 campaign

SOMETHING'S BREWING IN BLACKSBURG

- Virginia Tech has played for some of the best crowds in the nation, totaling 6,801 fans through six games played which is 15th nationally
- The Hokies are one of eight ACC squads drawing top 25 crowds this season
- Tech saw their largest crowd of 2,438 fans on Sept. 5 against Virginia which also set a top five program attendance record
- Lastly, VT claims the top spot amongst Commonwealth teams, followed by George Mason who is 23rd with 5,525 fans

WHO TO WATCH

- Tech's inclusion on the 2025 Men's Soccer Preseason Watch List was goalkeeper Sam Joseph.
- The California native transferred to VT from UCLA in the spring of 2025 and started his first match for the Hokies against No. 3 Ohio State, a team his Bruins defeated last season. He did not feature in that match
- Joseph was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 26 after posting two clean sheets and stopping five shots

ALL AROUND THE WORLD

- The 2025 roster is made up of nine countries not named the United States: France (2), Portugal (2), Spain (2), Argentina (1), England (1), Germany (1), Iceland (1), Sweden (1), and the United Kingdom (1)
- 46% of the Hokie roster is made up of international players

TRANSFERS OF TALENT

- Five transfers headed into Blacksburg this summer
- Beltran Alvarez (So., FGCU), Yanis Belatrache (Jr., UCF), Ugo Bertelli (Jr., Campbell), and Sam Joseph (Sr., UCLA) all made their Hokie debuts on Thursday Aug. 21 while Leo Ledin (So., Wofford) is still looking to see his first minutes

INSIGHT ON THE ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE

- Six teams line up in the United Soccer Coaches Poll after week four of action and claim the top three spots
- ACC teams combined for a 47-14-15 record during non-conference play of the season with a nation leading 0.721 winning percentage
- Road teams are 5-2-5 in the first two weeks of conference action
