PRIVACY NOTICE

PURSUANT PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION LAW REGARDING COOKIES

1. INTRODUCTION

This Privacy Notice is prepared in accordance with Article 10 of the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 ("Law"), the Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles to be Followed in Fulfilling the Obligation to Inform ("Communiqué"), and the Guidelines on Cookie Practices ("Guidelines"), by VİTSAN MÜMESSİLLİK VE MÜŞAVİRLİK A.Ş. ("Company" or "Vitsan") in the capacity of data controller, in order to inform you, as the data subject, regarding the cookies that will be processed during your visit to www.vitsan.com.tr ("Website") in compliance with the Law, the Communiqué, the Guidelines and other applicable legislation. In addition, this Privacy Notice provides information regarding the purposes for which cookies are used on our Website, the types of cookies we use, and how you can control these cookies.

Through the cookies on the Website, your data is processed for the purposes of enabling you to use the Website in the most efficient manner and to improve your user experience.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES

2.1 What is a Cookie?

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer (or on other internet-enabled devices such as smartphones and tablets) or on the network server via browsers by the websites you visit. Cookies are created by the servers associated with the website you visit. Accordingly, when the device where the text files are stored visits the site again, the server recognizes it.

2.2 Types of Cookies and Their Purposes of Use

3. COOKIE MANAGEMENT

4. COOKIES USED ON THE SITE, PURPOSES OF PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS

4.1 Necessary Cookies:

These cookies are necessary for the functioning of our Site and for our visitors to use the Site, for example, to log in as a user.

The personal data collected through these cookies are processed in accordance with Article 5(2)(c) of the Law, which states that "processing of personal data belonging to the parties of a contract is necessary, provided that it is directly related to the establishment or performance of the contract" or Article 5(2)(f), which states that "processing of personal data is mandatory for the legitimate interests of

the data controller, provided that it does not harm the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject"

Information regarding the necessary cookies used on the Website is provided in the table below:

4.2 Performance (Analytics) Cookies:

Performance cookies allow us to track and analyze the number of visitors to the Website and its traffic. Through these cookies, we can obtain information such as which areas of the Website are visited most or least frequently, and optimize the Website's traffic accordingly.

For the processing activities we carry out while using first-party analytics cookies, which are statistical measurement tools used for purposes such as obtaining statistical information that do not significantly impact users' privacy—we rely on the data processing grounds stipulated in Article 5(2)(c) of the Law "processing of personal data belonging to the parties to the contract is necessary provided that it is directly related to the establishment or performance of the contract" or Article 5(2)(f) "processing of data is mandatory for the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that it does not harm the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject".

For data processing activities carried out while using third-party analytics cookies, we rely on your explicit consent, if applicable, under Article 5 of the Law.

Your personal data processed through these cookies may be transferred to our business partners and suppliers located abroad in accordance with the data processing conditions specified in Article 5 of the Law and the rules regarding the transfer of personal data specified in Article 9 of the Law.

6. YOUR RIGHTS UNDER ARTICLE 11 OF THE LAW
