- Provide security guidelines and training for Global Distribution and Logistics LLC, employees, contractors, service providers, and others associated with the company.
- Provide a safe and secure environment for our employees, customers, vendors, other visitors and goods.
- Identify security vulnerabilities and take corrective actions to mitigate risks.
- Notify and cooperate with CBP and/or the proper authorities in the case of a supply chain security breach or suspicious activity.
- Review, revise, and update security practices and procedures on an annual basis, or as needed.
