The No. 14/13 Marquette University men's basketball team (11-1) wraps up the non-conference portion of its 2011-12 campaign Thursday night at 8 p.m. CT when the team hosts Vanderbilt (8-4) at the Bradley Center. ESPN2 will feature Marquette's sixth national television broadcast of the season, with Dave O'Brien (play-by-play) and Jimmy Dykes (analyst) calling the action. Following the matchup with the Commodores, the Golden Eagles will open BIG EAST Conference play for the third time in four years on New Year's Day at home. MU hosts Villanova at Noon CT after facing the Wildcats on the first day of the year in 2008-09 (W, 79-72) and West Virginia in 2010-11 (W, 79-74).

## Golden Eagles Switch Roles In Win Over Milwaukee

Several Golden Eagles rank among the league leaders in a variety of categories, but in the Dec. 22 victory over Milwaukee those players displayed their versatility by contributing in other areas.

Guard Junior Cadougan is among the best in the BIG EAST in assists per game (5th, 5.55), but collected just one versus the Panthers. Instead, he matched a career high with 15 points (first time he has ever led team in scoring) and set a personal best with seven rebounds. Senior Darius Johnson-Odom was held well below his season scoring average, but managed to grab a team high and personal-best eight rebounds. Forward Davante Gardner paced the team with four assists against UWM, after collecting a total of just five in the previous 11 games of the year.

## MU Extends Series Winning Streak Against Milwaukee

Marquette has matched up with Milwaukee in men's basketball on 39 occasions all-time, coming away victorious in each of those outings.

The Golden Eagles' current 39-game winning streak is the second-longest active run by any program against a single opponent and ranks sixth all-time.

Of the 39 matchups, 36 have come in Marquette's home arena. That current home-court run is sixth in the NCAA Record Book's latest edition.

## Marquette Searching For Rare Non-Conference Success

The Golden Eagles have the opportunity to finish the non-conference portion of the regular season with a record of 12-1, which would mark a rare occurrence for a number of reasons.

Marquette hasn't collected 12-or-more non-league victories since 2006-07 and hasn't finished with just one out-of-conference setback since 2004-05 (L, 48-43 vs. No. 15 Arizona). Since MU joined the Midwestern Collegiate Conference in 1989-90, the program has yet to conclude non-conference play undefeated.

The 2011-12 edition of the squad is one of just six teams in the 95-year history of the storied program to claim at least 10 victories to begin the season. Marquette most recently began the year 10-0 in 2001-02 and rattled off a school-record 27-straight wins to start the 1970-71 campaign.

## Is Key To Victory Field Goal Percentage?

Head coach Buzz Williams has stressed defense since he took over the reigns of the program and that focus, along with offensive efficiency, has played a key role in the team's success during his tenure.

Dating back to the start of 2008-09, the Golden Eagles are 60-4 when finishing the game with a field goal percentage even-or-better than their opponents. That includes a 10-0 mark thus far in 2011-12.

Since 2008-09, MU has finished 50 percent-or-better from the field on 42 occasions and owns a 39-3 record (at Villanova in 2008-09, vs. Washington in 2009-10, at Vanderbilt in 2010-11) in those outings.

## Jamil Wilson Showing Glimpses Of Potential

Sophomore forward Jamil Wilson has struggled with consistency early in his first season on the court with the Golden Eagles, but Marquette fans are seeing his potential on a more frequent basis in recent games.

The Racine, Wis., native, who redshirted in 2010-11 after transferring from Oregon, chipped in eight points and four rebounds in 24 minutes off the bench against Milwaukee. He netted a personal-best 11 points (lone double-figure game) in the victory against Northern Colorado (Dec. 17) and grabbed four boards.

For the season, Wilson is playing 18.0 minutes per night and shooting 46.5 percent from the field and 84.6 percent from the charity stripe. Following the injury to Chris Otule, Wilson is seeing a majority of his action as a backup to Davante Gardner.

## Gardner Settling Into Starting Role In The Middle

With the injury to junior center Chris Otule, sophomore Davante Gardner has been moved into the starting lineup in each of the past four outings.

The Suffolk, Va., native has responded to the challenge in the four games since the matchup with Washington on Dec. 6. In 25.5 minutes per night (well above season aver-

age), Gardner is averaging 11.8 points and 6.8 rebounds per contest while shooting 55.2 percent (16-of-29) from the field and 83.3 percent (15-of-18) from the charity stripe.

For the season, Gardner is averaging 8.7 points and 4.8 rebounds per game in just 17.8 minutes per night.

## Otule Suffers ACL Injury; Evaluating Options

Junior Center Chris Otule has suffered an injury to the anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee.

Otule injured the knee while tracking down a loose ball in the opening minutes of the team's Dec. 6 victory over Washington in the Jimmy V Classic. Otule and the Marquette medical staff are evaluating the best course of action, which will determine the amount of time he will miss.

## Depth Providing Much-Needed Options For Coaching Staff

Head coach Buzz Williams and his staff have assembled the deepest roster during his tenure and the fourth-year head coach is utilizing all of his options. The contributions of each player are even more important following the injury suffered by center Chris Otule.

Of the 10 active players, not including Otule, nine are averaging at least 10.0 minutes per game and six are chipping in at least 7.6 points per contest. Through the first 12 games, Marquette's reserves are contributing 20.3 points and 15.2 rebounds per outing while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor and 73.4 percent from the charity stripe.

## Free Throw Line Continues To Provide Advantage

The ability to consistently get to the free throw line, as well as convert on those opportunities, has been a focus since fourth-year head coach Buzz Williams took over.

The focus has been evident early in 2011-12, where once again the Golden Eagles have made more free throws (223) than their opponents have attempted (208). As a result, MU is outscoring opponents by an average of nearly eight points per game (18.6-11.3) from the line. The victory over Ole Miss provided a perfect example. MU finished 33-of-43 from the line and the Rebels were just 13-of-21 from the charity stripe.

Since the start of the 2008-09 season, Marquette is 2,025-of-2,810 (72.1 percent) from the free throw line and opponents are 1,316-of-1,968 (66.9 percent).

## Wilson Quietly Goes About His Work

Freshman guard Derrick Wilson has yet to provide significant statistical contributions through his first 12 collegiate games, but his efforts on the court have been vital to the team's success in 2011-12.

Serving as the primary backup for point guard Junior Cadougan, Wilson has turned the ball over on just five occasions this season while running MU's potent offensive attack. He has played a total of 157 minutes (13.1 minutes per night) and taken a total of just six shots. Wilson also owns 12 assists and six steals in his limited action.

He made his first career start at rival Wisconsin and collected a pair of rebounds in 20 minutes. His defense on UW's Jordan Taylor played a key role in the MU victory.

## Crowder's Trey Allows MU To Rally For Win

Senior forward Jae Crowder's 3-pointer with less than seven seconds left in regulation allowed the Golden Eagles to escape with a 79-77 victory over Washington Dec. 6 in the Jimmy V Classic.

The Villa Rica, Ga., native who was held to just two points in the win at Wisconsin, netted 16 of his 18 points against the Huskies in the second half. He finished the night 8-of-15 from the field and the lone trey he made all game proved to be the game winner. Crowder's shot was his first contest-deciding basket at Marquette, but he did have one against Midland Junior College while attending Howard College.

## Golden Eagles Grind Out Huge Win At Rival Wisconsin

The Golden Eagles were able to claim an important 61-54 victory at Wisconsin Dec. 3, with the final box score indicating just how difficult the win was to earn.

Marquette shot just 38.3 percent from the floor, including 18.2 percent from behind the 3-point line, and turned the ball over 13 times while collecting just seven assists. MU was also in foul trouble the entire evening and playing without starting point guard Junior Cadougan. Senior Jae Crowder was also limited to just two points on four shot attempts.

MU's defensive effort, which allowed the Badgers to shoot just 32.0 percent from the floor for the game, was the key to victory. Marquette held UW to just 26.1 percent from the floor in the opening half and collected 10-straight stops down the stretch to help secure the win.

## MU Collects Program First With Potent Attack

Marquette's 59 points in the championship game of the Paradise Jam win over Norfolk State not only marked the lowest total for the team through five games in 2011-12, it was the first time the squad failed to score at least 90 points.

The Golden Eagles entered the title outing having reached the 90-point plateau in each of the first four games, marking the first occasion in program history MU had posted four-consecutive games with over 90 points on the scoreboard.

In its 95-year history, MU has posted three-straight games of at least 90 points on several occasions, most recently to begin the 2008-09 campaign.

## Offense & Defense Lead MU To Paradise Jam Title

Marquette claimed its first tournament victory of any kind since the 2006-07 campaign (CBE Classic), when the squad captured the 2011 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam championship with a 59-57 win over Norfolk State on Nov. 21.

In the three games in St. Thomas, Marquette averaged 83.3 points per game and shot 50.0 percent from the floor. Three players averaged double figures in points, led by Darius Johnson-Odom's 20.0 points per game clip.

MU's defensive efforts were just as impressive, holding opposing shooters to a combined 35.6 percent effort from the field overall and a 28.6 percent effort from behind the 3-point line. As a result, Winthrop, Ole Miss and NSU averaged just 65.3 points per outing. The Golden Eagles defeated Duke in the 2006 CBE Classic title game.

## Johnson-Odom, Crowder Earn Island Accolades

Senior guard Darius Johnson-Odom was named the MVP of the 2011 U.S. Virgin Islands Paradise Jam and classmate Jae Crowder was named to the all-tourney squad after both players helped Marquette to the championship.

Johnson-Odom averaged 20.0 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists in the three games, shooting 51.6 percent from the floor and 75.9 percent from the free throw line. Crowder posted game averages of 16.7 points, 8.0 rebounds and 1.3 assists per outing and connected on 55.9 percent of his shots from the field and 75.0 percent from the charity stripe.

## Crowder Looking For Norfolk State On Schedule Again

While a scheduling quirk allowed the Golden Eagles the rare occasion to face Norfolk State twice in a week, senior forward Jae Crowder might be looking for another matchup in 2011-12.

The Villa Rica, Ga., native averaged 19.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game in the two outings and shot 55.2 percent from the floor. He posted a double-double in each of the two contests in an average of 29.5 minutes per game on the court. Crowder finished with 25 points and 10 boards in the first matchup and chipped in 14 points and 11 rebounds in the championship game.

Following his 19-point, 11-rebound effort in the win over Northern Colorado, Crowder now owns three double-doubles on the year and five for his career.

## Season Opener Provides Plethora Of Notes

Marquette's season-opening 54-point win over Mount. St. Mary's was significant for a number of reasons besides the final margin of victory. Several individual and team accomplishments of note were collected.

- The 54-point triumph over the Mountaineers is Marquette's largest margin of victory since MU's 104-49 win (55 points) over Prairie View A&M on Dec. 6, 1996.
- Led by 14 points each by Jae Crowder and Chris Otule, six players scored in double figures for Marquette for the first time since last season's 89-69 win over Green Bay (No. 17, 2010) at the Bradley Center.
- Each of the 10 players to see action for MU contributed at least one point and one rebound. The last time every player to see the court chipped in came Feb. 2, 2011 in a 75-70 loss at Villanova.
- Marquette's 54-point margin of victory was the largest in a season opener since MU downed Milwaukee Teachers College 83-28 (55 point margin) to begin the 1944-45 campaign.
- Marquette's 19 steals established a new single-game team record at the Bradley Center, led by four steals apiece from Jae Crowder and Vander Blue.
- Marquette improves to 80-15 (.842) in season openers. MU has won 11 consecutive season openers and 12 of its last 13.

## Four Players Ink With Marquette For 2012-13 Season

The Marquette University men's basketball coaching staff, which has collected numerous nationally ranked recruiting classes in recent years, announced another quality class.

Joining the Golden Eagles in 2012-13 are **Aaron Durley** (Houston, TX/Ft. Bend Bush HS), **Jamal Ferguson** (Norfolk, VA/Maury HS), **Steve Taylor** (Chicago, IL/Simeon HS) and **T.J. Taylor** (Denison, TX/Paris JC).

The 2011-12 campaign will mark Durley's first with the varsity squad at Ft. Bend Bush High School in Texas. He missed the 2010-11 season because of an Achilles' injury after playing at Houston's St. Thomas Catholic High School as a sophomore. That year he was named second team all-state by the state's private and parochial schools association. Durley most recently competed on the AAU circuit with the Houston Hoopstars. He is ranked 58th nationally at his position by ESPN.com. Current Marquette center Chris Otule also prepped at Ft. Bend Bush High School under head coach Ronnie Courtney.

A nationally recognized recruit under head coach Jack Baker at Maury High School in Norfolk, Va., Ferguson is ranked 22nd at his position by Scout.com, 29th by Rivals.com and 51st by ESPN.com. Rivals.com places him 137th overall amongst all players nationally. A three-year letterwinner at Maury HS, Ferguson averaged over 19.0 points and 7.0 rebounds as a junior in 2010-11. He was named first team all-district and shared the squad's most valuable player accolades. As a sophomore, he chipped in 17.6 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game and helped the Commodores to an appearance in the state quarterfinals. He was tabbed first team all-district and all-area in 2009-10.

A nationally recognized recruit under head coach Robert Smith at Chicago's Simeon High School, Steve Taylor is ranked 56th overall by Scout.com and 108th by Rivals.com. He is ranked 11th and 20th, respectively, at his position by each of those outlets. ESPN.com places him 18th amongst all small forwards in the nation and 64th in the ESPNU 100. Taylor averaged 9.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game last season at Simeon HS, helping the program to its second-straight state championship and a 30-2 overall record. He netted 20 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in the Wolverines' supersectional victory over Farragut.

T.J. Taylor signed with Oklahoma out of high school and spent the first semester of the 2010-11 campaign with the Sooners, but did not see any game action after missing time with a concussion. Taylor is currently in his first season at Paris Junior College in Texas. A three-time Texas Association of Basketball Coaches all-state selection, Taylor concluded his career as the all-time scoring leader at Denison High School with 2,630 points. He was ranked No. 78 nationally by ESPN and No. 104 by Rivals.com. Taylor averaged 20.7 points, 7.4 rebounds and 4.4 assists as a senior in 2009-10, helping the Yellow Jackets to a 16-win season. He was named the district's co-offensive player of the year and also claimed the same award as a sophomore and junior. As a junior, he averaged 27.1 points, 6.1 rebounds and 3.7 assists per outing and led Denison to a 21-11 record and an appearance in the state tournament area final.

## Buzz Williams

Head Coach I Fourth Season  
Oklahoma City, 1994

Two words have served as the foundation for fourth-year head coach Buzz Williams' program at Marquette University since he was officially hired on April 8, 2008 – Character Revealed.

Because of the values and work ethic contained within that philosophy, the Golden Eagles were able to add "Sweet Sixteen" in 2010-11 as another two-word extension to the squad's impressive list of accomplishments during his tenure.

Williams has guided Marquette to three-straight NCAA Championship appearances (six overall), including the program's 14th participation in the regional semifinals last season. Continuing the University's proud tradition of success on the court, MU has remained a fixture in the national rankings, claimed wins over multiple nationally ranked teams and been extremely competitive in the BIG EAST Conference. The squad has also ramped up its community service efforts under Williams' guidance and collected academic recognition since he assumed the reigns of the program prior to the 2008-09 campaign.

Marquette claimed 22 victories in 2010-11, including a road victory at eventual national champion Connecticut and a quarterfinal appearance in the league tourney, en route to being tabbed a No. 11 seed in the NAAs. The Golden Eagles posted upset wins over No. 6 seed Xavier and No. 3 seed Syracuse to claim a spot in the round of 16, which marked the furthest the team had advanced since 2003. Senior forward Jimmy Butler garnered all-conference accolades for the second-straight year and junior guard Darius Johnson-Odom earned a spot on the All-BIG EAST Second Team. MU also concluded the year ranked nationally in the top-25 poll thanks to its NCAA run.

The team's character was tested from start to finish in 2009-10, beginning with low preseason expectations from national pundits and concluding with a heartbreaking postseason loss. No team in the nation played in more one-possession games than MU, but that didn't stop the squad from collecting the program's fifth-straight NCAA Championship appearance and 20-win season. Marquette finished 22-12 overall, including an 11-7 mark in the BIG EAST Conference, which was good enough for fifth-place in the 16-team league.

Lazar Hayward (Second Team All-BIG EAST) finished second all-time in scoring at MU and four of the program's top-10 all-time scorers have graduated within the past three seasons. Junior forward Jimmy Butler was one of the most improved players in the country and as a result was tabbed honorable mention all-league.

Williams directed MU to a 25-10 overall record in 2008-09, which included a school-record 12 BIG EAST victories. The Golden Eagles advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship and were ranked among the nation's top-25 teams the entire campaign. A pair of players, Jerel McNeal and Wesley Matthews, claimed all-league accolades and McNeal also earned All-America honors.

Off the court, Williams and his staff assembled a consensus top-25 recruiting class in each of the first two years of his tenure, including a group rated as high as No. 1 in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com (2008-09).

The program's community service efforts have also reached new heights under Williams, highlighted by "Buzz's Bunch." This group, founded by Williams, focuses on providing opportunities for special needs children to attend games and summer camps. The Golden Eagles have also continued and strengthened their long-standing relationships with the Children's Hospital of Wisconsin as well as the Special Olympics.

In 2007-08, Williams served as an assistant coach with the Golden Eagles in his first season at Marquette. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has over 15 years of experience at the

NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and two Associated Press All-Americans (McNeal and Hayward).

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top-50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05/2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01/2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference.

Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com. Williams was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98).

Williams signed the highest-rated recruiting class in the history of the Southland Conference while at Northwestern State. The Demons advanced to their first ever NCAA tourney the following season and two of his recruited players were named all-conference, while one was tabbed Southland Conference Tournament MVP.

His accomplishments at Texas A&M-Kingsville include signing the 1998-99 Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year and a third team All-America guard. At Texas-Arlington, Williams recruited a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year and signed the first Academic All-American in the school's history. Williams was a student assistant coach from 1992-94 at Oklahoma City Univ. where he assisted the team to the 1994 NAIA title after it made it to the Sweet 16 the previous season.

Williams served as a student assistant from 1990-92 at Navarro College (Corsicana, Texas) where the team won consecutive conference titles while sporting a 45-17 record during his tenure. He began his career under mentor Lewis Orr, who was inducted into the National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame in 2009 after a 37-year career at the junior college level.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.
