HOME-ROAD SPLITS

Auburn has gone 14-7 (.667) at home this season but is just 3-7 (.300) on the road ... The offense has hit .321 inside Plainsman Park, scoring 140 runs (6.7 runs per game) with 63 extra-base hits (46 doubles, nine triples, eight home runs) while the pitching staff has a 2.39 ERA in 188 innings, striking out 141 (6.75 K/9) ... When Auburn hits the road those numbers change to a .276 team batting average and 4.3 runs per game while the pitching staff has a 6.00 ERA, averaging just 3.96 strike outs per game.

COOP-A-LOOP!

Junior first baseman Garrett Cooper has not only been getting it done in the field, where he has a .996 fielding percentage on 282 chances, but the junior has also reached base safely in 30 of the 31 games he has played in this year ... He is currently riding an eight-game hitting streak in which he is hitting .412 (14-34) with two doubles, a home run, five RBIs and seven runs scored ... He has struck out just five times in those eight games.

TWIN KILLINGS

Auburn's defense turned three double plays on Tuesday night against Samford, the fourth time this season Auburn has turned three double plays in a game ... Auburn's middle infielders Creede Simpson and Dan Glevenyak have been in on 20 and 19, respectively, of Auburn's 27 double plays, which is third in the SEC.

DON'T TEST THE BACKSTOPS

Auburn's catching duo of Blake Austin and Caleb Bowen have helped control the opposing running game as they have thrown out a combined 18 of 47 runners trying to steal a base ... As a team Auburn has thrown out 22 runners, which leads the SEC ... Austin's 10 caught stealing by is third in the league while Bowen's eight are tied for fourth.

TELLA ME ABOUT IT

Ryan Tella enters the weekend among the SEC leaders in batting average (.395, 3rd), slugging percentage (.540, 11th), on base percentage (.487, 2nd), hits (49, 4th), triples (2, T-7th), total bases (67, 9th), walks (21, T-8th) and steals (8, T-5th) ... He is currently riding a seven-game streak of reaching base safely ... In 32 games this season, he has been on base in all but two of them.

RIDING THE PITCHING

Auburn's pitching staff leads the SEC in ERA in league games, owning a 3.24 staff ERA, with Arkansas second in the league at 3.38 ... Auburn's starting pitching has been

AUBURN ALL-TIME VS. VANDERBILT

Auburn leads the all-time series, 78-40, and holds a slight 26-24 advantage in Nashville ... Auburn has lost its last four series in Nashville with its last series win coming in the 2001 season ... Since then Auburn has gone just 3-9 in Nashville ... Auburn's last series win anywhere over Vanderbilt was in 2009 at Auburn ... Auburn has won just one of the last seven series played between the two teams.

JOHN PAWLOWSKI is 3-6 all-time against Vanderbilt, with all nine games coming as the head coach at Auburn ... He and Vanderbilt Head Coach Tim Corbin were both assistant coaches at Clemson during their careers ... Pawlowski was a Jack Leggett assistant from 1994-98 while Corbin was there from 1994-02 ... Both were on staff when Clemson went to the College World Series in 1995 and 1996.

JON LUKE JACOBS will be making his third career start against Vanderbilt ... Is 1-1 all-time against the Commodores, earning a win on Saturday in 2009 and taking a Saturday loss in 2011 ... In 12 career innings, he has struck out 10 while allowing just 13 hits and two walks, surrendering three earned runs in each outing ... He has never pitched at Hawkins Field.

CORY LUCKIE is the only player on this year's roster that played in Auburn's last win over Vanderbilt ... He threw a complete game five-hitter on Saturday in 2010 as Auburn claimed a 12-2 win in Nashville.

a big reason for that as the trio of Derek Varnadore (4.32), Will Kendall (3.27) and Daniel Koger (2.25) have a combined 3.30 ERA while the bullpen is even better at a combined 3.12 ERA in 34 2/3 innings from a combined nine relievers.

A NEW ROTATION

Auburn will be breaking in a new rotation this weekend after Will Kendall suffered an elbow strain on his left arm in his start at Alabama on Saturday.

WINNING IN THE MIDWEEK

Auburn has gone 7-1 in midweek games this year, outscoring teams 75-22 ... Auburn has been led by Jon Luke Jacobs, who is 4-0 with a 2.53 ERA and a .207 batting average against, ninth in the SEC, to go along with his 35 strike outs in 32 innings ... As a whole the team is hitting a blustery .349 in the midweek (led by Creede Simpson's .500 [15-30]) while the entire pitching staff has a combined 2.27 ERA ... Last year Auburn finished at .500 overall (29-29) and was just 6-7 in midweek contests.

AUBURN VS THE SEC WEST

Auburn opened its SEC season by playing four straight series against teams from the SEC West, winning three of the series and going 6-6 to start the year, holding tie-breakers over LSU, Ole Miss and Mississippi State ... Since the start of the 2010 season Auburn has gone a combined 27-19 (.587) against the West (5-7 vs. Alabama, 4-2 vs. Arkansas, 6-3 vs. LSU, 7-3 vs. Ole Miss and 5-4 vs. Mississippi State) and has finished in the top two in the division each of the last two years.

PUTTING THE PRESSURE ON EARLY

Auburn has outscored its opponents 52-27 over the first two innings of games this year and is 12-3 when scoring in the first inning and 16-5 when scoring first.

FIRST TO FOUR

Four has been the magic number of late for Auburn as the team has gone 15-6 when scoring four runs or more and 3-8 when it scores three-or-less

... Conversely, Auburn is 5-12 when opponents scored four-or-more and 13-2 when holding its opponents to three or fewer.

RUN LIKE THE WIND

Auburn enters the weekend with 62 steals (in 85 attempts, 73 percent), surpassing what the team did in 58 games in 2011 ... The 60 steals entering the week were 13th nationally ... Auburn's current pace of 1.94 steals per game has it ending the regular season with 109 steals ... The Auburn record for stolen bases in a season is 116 in 1974 and the team has eclipsed the century mark just two other times, in 2007 (105) and 1971 (101) ... Against SEC competition, Auburn is just 6-for-10.

2 FOR 2?

With Creede Simpson (16) and Jay Gonzalez (15) one-two in the SEC in steals, the duo is attempting to become the first set of Auburn teammates to steal 20-plus bases in a single season since Tyler Johnstone (24) and Clete Thomas (23) combined for 47 steals in 2005.

SMALL BALL

Auburn has already recorded 17 bunt base hits (in 37 attempts, .459) and 34 sacrifice bunts, tied for the SEC lead ... Ryan Tella leads the team with four bunt base hits each while Dan Glevenyak leads the club and is tied for third in the SEC with six sac bunts.

PAWLOWSKI IN YEAR FOUR

Auburn head coach John Pawlowski is in his fourth season at Auburn ... In three-plus seasons he is 121-89 (.576) ... Overall he is 459-281-1 (.620) in 13-plus seasons at Auburn and the College of Charleston (2000-08) ... He was the third-fastest coach in Auburn history to reach 100 wins at the school, needing 169 games to get there.

WHAT'S ON DECK...

Following the weekend in Nashville, Tenn., Auburn will return home for five straight games, beginning Tuesday at 6pm against Troy followed by a rescheduled game against Alabama A&M on Wednesday

SEASON LONG NOTES

THREE-FOR-THREE

Auburn won its first three SEC series for the first time since 2003, winning at No. 12 Ole Miss and then at home against No. 8 LSU and Mississippi State.

COMEBACK WINS

Auburn's 3-2 win on Sunday at Ole Miss was Auburn's third come-from-behind win of the season but the first in which it trailed going into the ninth ... Before Sunday the last time Auburn won a game that it was trailing going into the ninth was in 2010 after the team went 0-20 in those situations last season ... The 2010 team finished the year 1-18 when trailing after nine.

TELLA NAMED CO SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ryan Tella was named the SEC Co Player of the Week following Auburn's 3-1 record against South Alabama and LSU ... He hit .417 (5-12) in Auburn's series win over No. 8 LSU, collecting a double, a triple and a home run in the process ... Added a 3-for-4 day with a run and a RBI in Auburn's win over South Alabama on Tuesday and now leads the team with 15 multi-hit games ... Against LSU he had three of Auburn's 10 RBIs and scored two of Auburn's 10 runs as Auburn claimed a third straight series win over LSU, the first time it has done that since 1988-90.

PITCHING LEADS THE WAY

The Auburn pitching staff had a fantastic weekend at No. 12 Ole Miss, surrendering just eight runs over three games (2.7 R/g) as the team took two-out-of-three on SEC opening weekend ... The staff combined for a 2.77 ERA, with the bullpen working 8 1/3 innings of shutout baseball with a win and two saves ... The staff also had a .200 batting average against ... The staff then bettered itself against No. 8 LSU, combining for a 1.29 ERA in 28 innings.

FIVE-AND-UNDER

Auburn has held its opponents to five runs or less in 13 straight games from March 3-25 ... In those 13 games Auburn outscored its opponents, 66-36, and went 9-4 ... The staff ERA was 2.08 over that stretch, dropping the overall team mark from 4.07 to 3.14 ... The last time the team had such a successful run was from March 1-29, 2002 when the team ran off a 16 straight games of allowing five or less runs, going 14-2 during that time.

YAKETY-YAK, YAKETY-YAK

Dan Glevenyak had his team-best 12-game hitting streak snapped on St. Patty's day at No. 12 Ole Miss ... During the streak he was (18-42, .429, 10 runs scored) and had five multi-hit games and six on the season ... He had a night to remember in the Capital City Classic, winning MVP honors after driving in a career-high three RBIs on a career-high three hits

to go along with his fifth sac bunt of the season.

STEALING EIGHT

Without complete records Auburn Media Relations is unable to verify that the team's eight stolen bases in the 7-1 win over Alabama State is a school record ... It is in the record books, however, that three steals is the most a single player has ever had in a game, which has been matched twice this season, once by Bobby Andrews (2/22 vs. Alcorn State) and once by Jay Gonzalez (2/28 vs. Alabama State).

VARNADORE NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Derek Varnadore was named the SEBaseball.com SEC Pitcher of the Week following his opening weekend 11 strike out performance against Missouri ... In seven innings he allowed just one run on five hits and didn't allow a hit until the fourth ... Of his 11 strike outs, six came in the first 10 hitters he faced as he topped double-digit strike outs for the second time in his career, coming up two shy of his career best.

WHO'S ON FIRST?

Auburn welcomed 17 newcomers into the program for the 2012 season ... Of the returning starting position players, only two return in Creede Simpson and Cullen Wacker ... In total, Auburn must replace 74 percent of last season's at bats ... On the mound Auburn returns 398 2/3 out of 518 innings (77 percent) from last year.

GUESS WHO'S BACK? JB'S BACK!

Senior Justin Bryant returns after missing the most of the 2011 season due to injury ... Last season he played in just four games, going 2-for-11 (.182) at the plate and making one appearance on the mound, earning a save in 1 1/3 innings ... In 2010 Auburn was 22-4 when he was in the starting lineup as he hit .323 with 32 RBIs.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Auburn has been picked to finish sixth in the SEC West by SEC Coaches, SEBaseball.com and Perfect-Game.org ... The only major preseason poll to disagree was Baseball America, which picked Auburn fifth and Alabama sixth.
