## IT'S WORTH NOTING...

- Villanova comes to Nashville for the first time since winning a pair of games in the 2005 NCAA Tournament. The Wildcats downed New Mexico 55-47 and Florida 76-65 to advance to the NCAA Sweet 16 in Syracuse, N.Y. This will be Villanova's first-ever appearance at Memorial Gymnasium.

- The Wildcats enter action on Saturday looking to snap a three game losing skid that began in the finals of the 2K Sports Classic against another member of the Southeastern Conference, Alabama. This stretch followed a three game winning streak to open the season.

- After using the same starting lineup for the season's first five games, Villanova made a change on Sunday, inserting senior forward Maurice Sutton in place in of sophomore JayVaughn Pinkston. Pinkston responded with 19 points and seven rebounds while Sutton contributed four points and a team-high eight caroms in a 77-74 overtime loss at La Salle.

- This matchup is part of the SEC/BIG EAST Challenge. VU last took part in this event in 2007, when it staged a frantic rally to defeat LSU 68-67.

- The Wildcats return to the Pavilion on Wednesday evening to host Philadelphia Big Five rival Temple at 9:00 p.m. The game will be telecast by ESPN2.

# 2012-13 VILLANOVA WILDCATS GAME NOTES

## Explorers Outlasted Wildcats

La Salle (3-1 overall, 1-0 Big Five) rallied from deficits in both the second half and overtime to claim a 77-74 victory over Villanova (3-3 overall, 0-1 Big Five) Sunday at Tom Gola Arena.

“I know I say this after every Big Five game, but that was a great college basketball game,” stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright. “I don’t like coming up on this end of it, but it was a classic Big Five game and a classic example of one team executing down the stretch and another team not executing.

“We’ve got to learn from this and take responsibility for not executing and give (LaSalle) credit for making the plays.”

The Wildcats built an 11-point lead early in the second half and led by as many as four in the extra period. But La Salle chased Villanova down each time and then made key plays in the final seconds to snap a 10-game losing skid to the Wildcats that dated back to 2001.

Ramon Galloway scored 26 points to pace the winners while Tyreek Duren added 23 more. Senior forward Mouphtaou Yarou paced the Wildcats

with 20 points (he also had seven rebounds) while Jay Vaughn Pinkston contributed 19 points and seven boards.

After Villanova grabbed a 5-4 lead in the early minutes, La Salle relied on its long-range shooting to forge a 13-6 run with Galloway doing much of the damage with a pair of 3-point field goals. A Wildcat turnover and subsequent Sam Mills layup gave the Explorers a 17-11 lead with 11:30 to play in the first half.

The Wildcats bounced back to within 23-22 with some defensive toughness and a 3-point goal from Pinkston in the corner set up by quality ball movement. Pinkston’s work on the interior allowed VU to re-take the lead with under four minutes remaining. His short jumper and free throw capped a 17-2 run that gave the Wildcats a 32-25 lead with 3:13 to play in the first half.

Villanova withstood a late push in the period to take a 34-30 lead into the locker room at the break.

After a tight defensive first half, matters opened up early in the second 20 minutes. Junior James Bell sank a pair of triples to spark an 8-1 surge only to see La Salle answer with a 7-2 spurt of its own to make it 44-37 with 15:17 left to

play in the second half.

The Explorers’ pressure, however, began causing issues for Villanova. Galloway sparked a run that allowed La Salle to tie the game at 46 after a free throw from Steve Zack with 11:32 on the clock in the second half.

“I thought their guards did a great job of pressuring our guards,” stated Wright. “We really struggled to get into our offense, especially late in regulation and in overtime.”

The contest was tight through the rest of regulation. A free throw from Ryan Arcidiacono gave the ‘Cats a 67-64 lead with 25 seconds left before Duren drained a triple from deep with Yarou’s hand in his face and six seconds on the clock to knot the game at 67. VU came up empty on its final possession and overtime came next.

The Wildcats twice built four point leads in the overtime only to see La Salle come back each time. A nifty feed off a back-door cut led to a layup for Duren to give La Salle back the lead at 75-74.

“Give them credit for their execution,” said Wright, “and give us poor marks for our execution. We’ve got to get better.”

# 2012-13 VILLANOVA WILDCATS GAME NOTES

## Tale of the Turnovers

If Villanova can point to any one area that has been especially harmful of late, it would be the turnover column. With two new point guards - freshman Ryan Arcidiacono and junior transfer Tony Chennault - Villanova is learning about itself and has paid the price.

Through six games, VU has 74 assists with 100 turnovers, a ratio that places it at the bottom of the BIG EAST (No. 15). What's more, the miscues have helped generate offense for its opponents, particularly of late.

In its last three games - all losses - Villanova has been outscored 75-24 in points off of turnovers. In those three games Wildcat opponents have accounted for 32 steals.

"The turnovers killed us against Columbia and La Salle," stated Wright. "We've got to improve in that area."

"Our two main ballhandlers, Ryan and Tony, are both new to our program. We're trying to simplify as best we can to help those two as they adjust to what we do."

## Mouph on the Move

A season ago, forward Mouphtaou Yarou did some of his best work when playing alongside 6-11 Maurice Sutton. The pattern continued Sunday as Yarou played his most efficient game of the young season when joined by Sutton in the starting lineup.

After scoring 27 total points in his first five games, the senior from Benin contributed 20 points on 9-of-15 shooting from the field. He also added seven rebounds.

## That 70's Show

If you are looking for a quick indicator on Villanova, keep an eye on the 70 point plateau. Over the course of the past few seasons, it has often provided extra insight into the Wildcats.

Thus far, in 2012-13, the pattern has continued.

Villanova has scored 70 or more points in three games thus far and is 3-1 in those games. The Wildcats scored a season-low 55 points against Alabama on Nov. 16 and followed it with just 57 points against Columbia on Tuesday night, dropping both contests.

Last season, VU was 12-8 when scoring 70 or more points in a game. It was just 1-11 when it scored below that number.

## JP Prospered

Sophomore forward JayVaughn Pinkston moved to a sixth man role on Sunday and the early returns were quite promising. The native of Brooklyn, N.Y, tallied 19 points and seven rebounds in 27 minutes.

"It all goes back to simplifying things," stated Wright. "I thought JayVaughn did a really good job coming off the bench. We're trying to get Tony and Ryan comfortable. JayVaughn is great with it, as you can see by the way he played."

## Notables

- Villanova has been led in scoring through six games by six different Wildcats - Sutton, Arcidiacono, Darrun Hilliard, Pinkston, James Bell and Yarou.

- The Wildcats have been hurt by the 3-point shot at both ends of the court. Villanova ranks last in the BIG EAST in 3-pt field goal defense (.367) and ninth in 3-point field goal percent-

## Hart and Jenkins to Arrive in 2013-14

Two products of the metropolitan Washington, D.C., region have inked national letters of intent to become Villanova Wildcats, it was announced today. Guard Josh Hart, 6-5, of Sidwell Friends School, and forward Kris Jenkins, 6-6, Gonzaga High School, are set to enroll in the fall of 2013.

Hart averaged 20.6 points, 11.6 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game as a junior in 2011-12. The versatile swingman played his AAU basketball for Team Takeover.

“Josh Hart is a complete player who can play any position,” stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright. “He and his family will be great Villanovans for life. Josh is an outstanding player and student coming from Sidwell Friends and having been coached by Eric Singletary.”

Jenkins is ranked No. 73 in the ESPN top 100 listing of the class of 2013. As a junior, he averaged 20.4 points and 10.6 rebounds per outing. The native of Washington, D.C. played his AAU basketball for D.C. Assault.

“We’re thrilled to have Kris Jenkins join the Villanova family,” stated Wright. “He brings incredible skill, toughness and great basketball IQ. He comes from a tremendous program with a great coach in Steve Turner. He will be a favorite of the Nova Nation.”

Hart and Jenkins will add to a rich legacy of Wildcats from the metropolitan region of Washington that includes former standouts George Raveling, George Leftwich, Larry, Keith and Reggie Herron, Dwayne Anderson, Dante Cunningham and Scottie Reynolds.

## Johnson Departs

Sophomore guard Ty Johnson (Plainfield, N.J./Montrose Christian School) informed the Villanova coaching staff during the first week of November that he intends to transfer. Johnson spent one season in a Wildcats’ uniform.

## Pavilion Power

Villanova owns a string of 126 consecutive regular season sellouts in the 6,500 seat facility, dating to 2000-2001. The South end zone includes the entire VU student section, through which the team descends prior to tipoff.

Villanova has a lifetime record of 239-58 (.805) in the building on Ithan Avenue. Since the 1994-95 season, the Wildcats are 178-26 (.873) in the Pavilion.

## The Philadelphia Big Five

Villanova will take part in the historic City Series, the Philadelphia Big Five again in 2012-13. The round-robin series dates to the 1956-57 season and is contested between La Salle, Penn, Saint Joseph’s Villanova and Temple.

The Wildcats are currently 0-1 in the City Series after having dropped a 77-74 overtime decision to La Salle on Nov. 25 at Tom Gola Arena.

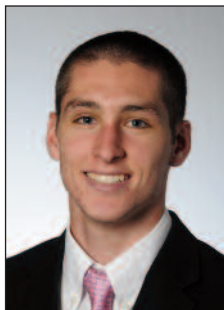
