CATAMOUNTS VERSUS COMMODORES

- The Catamounts and Commodores have met just twice on the hardwood with Vanderbilt claiming victory in both contests.
- The last meeting between the two teams came during the 2000-01 season. WCU traveled to Vanderbilt on Nov. 18, 2000 and fell 85-63.
- The only other meeting was Dec. 4, 1982 and the Catamounts fell 81-68 to the Commodores.

CATAMOUNTS AGAINST THE SEC

- Western Carolina is 2-39 all-time against current members of the Southeastern Conference.
- WCU's last win over an SEC school came in 2003. The Catamounts traveled to Arkansas and defeated the Razorbacks 62-59 in overtime.
- The Catamounts only other win against an SEC team came in 1993, a 78-71 victory over Tennessee.
- Western Carolina faced SEC members Mississippi State and Alabama during the opening weekend of the college basketball season.
- The Catamounts came up two points short last season at Georgia. WCU led by as many as 10 points in the second half and held a seven point lead with five minutes to play before the Bulldogs stormed back and took the victory, 65-63.

FAST START

- The Catamounts are a perfect 3-0 this season when leading at the halftime break and are 0-6 when falling behind prior to halftime.

CAT BURGLARS

- Western Carolina leads the Southern Conference in steals per game this season with 8.9 and ranks 29th in the NCAA.
- The Catamounts led the league in steals last season as well while averaging 7.3 thefts per game while ranking 50th in the NCAA.

DEEP THREAT

- Western Carolina ranks 32nd in the NCAA in 3-point field goal attempts with 217 while SoCon member VMI leads the NCAA with 416.
- The Catamounts also rank 40th in the NCAA in 3-point field goals made per game with 8.3 while VMI leads the NCAA with 12.9 per game.
- Junior Rhett Harrelson individually ranks eighth in the NCAA in 3-point field goals made per game with 3.8 while ranking sixth in the NCAA in total 3-point attempts with 87.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH

- Senior guard James Sinclair was named the Southern Conference's Player of the Month for all games played in the month of November.
- Sinclair is the first Catamount to earn a monthly honor from the league since it started handing out awards during the 2004-05 season.
- Sinclair averaged 19.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in six November games to help the Catamounts to a 3-3 mark.

SENSATIONAL SINCLAIR

- Senior James Sinclair scored 31 points in Western Carolina's loss at Alabama. The 31 points were the most by any player in ESPN's Tip-off Marathon presented by Dish.
- The marathon featured 20 games including 12 top-25 teams.

- The Catamounts return to Cullowhee for their second home game of the season.
- WCU hosts Wright State on Thursday, Dec. 18 for a 7 pm tip-off.

SECOND HALF SPURT DOWNS CATAMOUNTS AT MINNESOTA

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. - After trailing by just one point at halftime, the Western Carolina men's basketball was outscored 45-26 in the second half Friday night at the University of Minnesota in Williams Arena as the Golden Gophers took an 84-64 victory. The Golden Gophers shot 58.1 percent from the field in the second half while forcing 12 WCU turnovers.

Junior Mike Brown led all scorers with a career-high 21 points while going 4-6 from 3-point range. He also led all rebounders with eight boards as the Catamounts outrebounded the Golden Gophers 34-26. Senior James Sinclair was Western Carolina's only other double-figure scorer with 13 points. Sinclair came close to a triple-double with seven rebounds and seven assists in the loss.

Juniors Torrior Brummitt and Justin Browning each fouled out with eight points and seven rebounds. The loss moves WCU's record to 3-6 while Minnesota improved to 6-2.

The Catamounts had 24 turnovers in the contest which led to 29 Minnesota points. Another big deficit came at the free throw line where Minnesota knocked down 15 of 23 attempts while the Catamounts went to the line just five times and nailed four.

Junior Rhett Harrelson stole the ball on Minnesota's opening possession and nailed a 3-pointer to give WCU the first basket and lead of the contest. The Catamounts held onto the lead for the opening four minutes with the largest margin coming at 10-4. A 10-0 run by the Gophers turned the tide and gave Minnesota a 14-10 lead with just under 15 minutes to play. The Catamounts kept the score close throughout the opening period.

A 7-0 run by WCU with under eight minutes to play regained the lead for the Catamounts. Brown, senior Kenneth Hall and Sinclair combined for the seven points to give WCU a 27-25 lead. The two teams exchanged the lead five more times over the next several minutes with Minnesota holding the slight edge at the break, 39-38.

The second half was a battle for the opening eight minutes but as the Catamounts began to get into foul trouble the Gophers pulled away. Minnesota closed the game on a 20-9 run as they took an 84-64 victory.

Minnesota had five players in double-figures including DeAndre Mathieu and Carlos Morris who led the squad with 16 points a piece.

THE LAST TIME OUT VS. THE SEC

ALABAMA SLIPS PAST CATAMOUNTS LATE, 80-74

TUSCALOOSA, Ala. - For the second-straight game, the Western Carolina men's basketball team fell victim to the free throw line. The University of Alabama hit 34-42 from the charity stripe in an 80-74 victory over the Catamounts as Western Carolina took just 22 trips to the free throw line and hit 15.

The Catamounts trailed by as many as 12 points in the first half but that would not be the story for Western Carolina as they battled back and took a six point lead with six minutes left in the game. A 13-2 run ended WCU's hopes as the Crimson Tide went on to win 80-74.

Senior James Sinclair poured in a career-high 31 points in the loss as he hit 10-18 from the field including 4-10 from three. He was also 7-9 at the charity stripe. He added five rebounds, three assists and three steals to the cause as well. Junior Rhett Harrelson, who returned to his home state, scored 13 points, dished out three assists and grabbed three steals in the loss.

WCU's final double-digit scorer was junior Mike Brown who added 12 points and five rebounds to the effort. Junior Torrior Brummitt led the Catamounts on the glass with 10 rebounds while scoring seven points. Freshman Tucker Thompson scored his first career points in the first half and went on to finish with eight points, a block and two rebounds.

Junior Justin Browning added six rebounds off the bench while freshmen Devin Peterson and Charlendez Brooks picked up the first points of their collegiate career.

The Crimson Tide out-rebounded the Catamounts 37-33 while both teams finished with 15 turnovers.

The opening five minutes of the game featured nine different lead changes as the teams went back and forth. With the score tied at 10, the Crimson Tide began a 9-0 run that lasted nearly five minutes. A free throw by Devin Peterson ended the run but the Tide answered with four-straight free throws to take their largest lead of the half, 23-11.

Down 12, the Catamounts made a run on the back of Harrelson as he hit back-to-back 3-pointers after a Tucker Thompson jumper to cut the deficit to four. The Crimson Tide would respond and eventually build their lead up to 11 points with just over two minutes to play. A short run by the Catamounts cut the lead to six but a last second tip-in gave the Crimson Tide a 41-33 halftime lead.

The Catamounts battled back in the second half as a 7-0 run that began at the 14:08 mark gave WCU its first lead since the 16:54 mark of the first half, 50-49. Both teams would trade baskets over the next several possessions but a 3-pointer by Sinclair gave the Catamounts their largest lead of the contest at 67-61 with 6:35 to play. The Crimson Tide answered with a 13-2 run to take a five-point advantage with less than three minutes to play. A free throw by Harrelson with a minute to play cut the lead to two but the Catamounts would be outscored 6-2 in the final minute of play giving Alabama the 80-74 lead.

- Head coach Larry Hunter announced the signing of three student-athletes for the 2015-16 incoming class. Elijah Pughley (Lima, Ohio/Lima Senior), Deriece Parks (Charlotte, N.C./South Georgia Tech) and Jesse Deloach (Grayson, Ga./Mount Pisgah Christian) all inked National Letters of Intent with Western Carolina University on Nov. 13.
- Elijah Pughley, a 6-1 guard from Lima, Ohio, is set to begin his senior season at Lima Senior High School. He spent last season at Hughes High School in Cincinnati, Ohio where he averaged 16 points and five assists per game while leading the team to a 17-6 record. He was an honorable mention Cincinnati Metro Athletic All-Conference selection. He also set the program record for 3-pointers in a season with 69.
- Deriece Parks, a 6-5 guard from Charlotte, N.C., is starting his sophomore season at South Georgia Technical College and will join the Catamounts as a junior. He spent his freshman season at Barton Community College in Great Bend, Kan. He averaged 8.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game while at Barton. He shot 39.5 percent from the field and 35.4 percent from 3-point range.
- Jesse Deloach, a 6-7 forward from Grayson, Ga., is beginning his senior season at Mount Pisgah Christian School, the alma mater of current Catamount, Devin Peterson. As a junior, he averaged six points, seven rebounds and four blocks per game. He was named the Most Improved Player at MPCS.

SoCon PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Senior guard James Sinclair was selected Nov. 18 as the Southern Conference's Player of the Week for his performances against Mississippi State and Alabama.
- The weekly honor is the first for the Catamounts this season and first for Sinclair. The last time a Catamount earned the SoCon Player of the Week honor was December 31, 2013 when Trey Sumler earned his second Player of the Week of the 2013-14 season.
- Sinclair averaged 25.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.0 assists in two games against SEC opponents last week. The senior began the week with a game-high 20 points at Mississippi State on Friday night. He followed that performance with a career-high 31 points at Alabama on Monday. He shot 53 percent from the field for the week and knocked down 44 percent (7-16) of his shots from 3-point range. He went 10-of-14 from the free throw line over the two games.

- Some notable names on the list include all-time wins leader Mike Krzyzewski of Duke, Bob Knight, Dean Smith, Adolph Rupp and many more.
- Coach Hunter is just 12 wins shy of all-time great John Wooden.

TWO OF THE LAST THREE

- The Catamounts have seen two of their last three seasons end in heartbreak in the Southern Conference Tournament Championship game.
- Both championship game appearances were decided by a total of five points.
- Last season, the Catamounts fell to Wofford, 56-53. WCU had a shot at the buzzer but it knocked off the rim ending the Catamounts hopes of its first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 1996.
- In the 2012 championship, the Catamounts fell in double overtime to Davidson, 93-91. Western Carolina rallied from 13 points down with 2:47 to play to force overtime but could not find the winning basket.

IT'S A TWIN THING

- Aaron and Ashley Williams are the first set of twins to play for the Catamounts since Jonas and Jarvis Hayes competed for Western Carolina during the 1999-00 season.
- Jarvis led the Catamounts and the Southern Conference in scoring that season as a freshman.
- The Hayes brothers eventually transferred to Georgia and Jarvis became a first round NBA draft pick.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

- The 2014-15 Catamounts are looking to replace five seniors who combined to score 5,121 career points.
- Trey Sumler (1,996 pts.), Brandon Boggs (1,370 pts.), Tawaski King (1,009), Tom Tankelewicz (670 pts.) and Josh Mendenhall (76 pts.) will no longer be on the court to carry the scoring load.
- Current senior James Sinclair who finished third on the team in scoring a season ago will look to lead the 2014-15 squad. He currently has 865 career points and could become WCU's 45th 1,000 point scorer.

WHEE LOVE CULLOWHEE

- All three Western Carolina assistant coaches call WCU their alma mater.
- Anquell McCollum played at Western Carolina from 1993-96. He was a member of WCU's 12-man, All-20th Century Team, was a two-time, first team All-SoCon selection and finished his career as the WCU and SoCon all-time leader in both 3-pointers made (245) and attempted (670).
- Eric Wilson played at Western Carolina from 2005-08. During his four-year career at WCU, Wilson earned the moniker of defensive specialist, generally drawing the assignment of shutting down the opposition's top guard. He recorded his career-high 21 points in November of 2005 in a home win over Atlanta Christian.
- Brigham Waginger played at Western Carolina from 2007-10. Known for his tough, hard-nosed play on the court during his four-year career at WCU, Waginger finished with 810 points including 27 double-digit scoring outings. He shattered the school's career benchmark for steals by 64, finishing with 285 career thefts, well above the previous record of 221 steals held by WCU Hall of Famer, Henry Logan. His 285 career steals rank third in SoCon history.

CATAMOUNT DID YOU KNOW?

- Western Carolina's Henry Logan – the program's all-time leading scorer – helped break the color barrier in college basketball when he signed with Western Carolina in 1964 becoming the first African-American collegiate athlete in the history of North Carolina and perhaps at any predominantly white institution in the southeastern United States.
 - Logan scored an astounding 3,290 points – an average of 30.7 points per game – during his WCU career and was a four-time NAIA All-America selection
 - One of 11 in WCU's initial Athletics Hall of Fame Class, Logan was inducted into the North Carolina Sports Hall of Fame in 2000.
- Western Carolina University gave birth to the first 3-point shot in NCAA history as former Catamount Ronnie Carr buried the first 3-pointer in NCAA history in WCU's 77-70 victory over Middle Tennessee State on Nov. 29, 1980
 - The ball he used is on display at the Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass.
 - The shot was made from the left corner with 16:09 left in the first half (7:06 pm).
 - Carr actually took and missed a 3-pointer from the top of the key at the 18:15 mark of the first half.

- Western Carolina finished as the 1963 NAIA National Runner-Up under head coach Jim Gudger.
 - WCU posted a 28-7 overall record, won the Carolina's Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (CIAC) Tournament and the NAIA District title.
 - The Catamounts then rattled off wins on consecutive days over Eastern Montana, Miles, Lewis & Clark and Fort Hayes State before falling in the championship game to Texas Pan American.

- In its only NCAA tournament appearance, the 1996 Western Carolina Catamounts nearly pulled off the most improbable of upsets as the No. 16 seed fell by two, 73-71, to No. 1 seed Purdue in Albuquerque, N.M.
 - The game was tied 71-71 with under three minutes to play with Purdue's Brandon Brantley scoring the game's final bucket with 1:30 to play.
 - WCU had two looks at both a game-winning and a game-tying shot inside the closing seconds but both attempts missed.

- WCU's bid to play in the CollegelInsider.com Post-Season Tournament (CIT) following the 2009-10 season represented the Catamounts' return to post-season play for the first time since 1996.

- Western Carolina has one former player currently in the National Basketball Association in Kevin Martin, who played for the Catamounts from 2001-04.
 - He currently plays for the Minnesota Timberwolves.
 - Martin, a first-round pick of the Sacramento Kings in '04, was the first Catamount to ever be selected in the first round of the NFL, NBA or MLB Draft.

- Three of the top 11 scorers in MAC history played for Hunter, including Dave Jamerson (3rd with 2,336); Gary Trent (7th with 2,108) and Brandon Hunter (11th with 2,012). Hunter (1,103) and Trent (1,050) rank fifth and ninth, respectively, on the MAC career rebounds list.

- Brandon Hunter, who Larry Hunter recruited and coached for two years, went on to earn MAC Player of the Year honors in 2003.

- In 1989-90, Dave Jamerson set a MAC record with 874 points in a season;

- Jamerson was an NBA first round pick and played three years in the NBA. Trent was an NBA first round pick and played nine years in the NBA. B. Hunter was a second round NBA pick in 2003 and played three years in the league.

WESTERN CAROLINA NOTES:

- WCU set a school-record by making 221 3-pointers in a season in 2005-06... One year later, the Catamounts eclipsed that mark with 226 treys in '07-08, doing so again with 237 in his third season; rewrote the record in 2009-10 with a school-record 274 made 3-pointers;
- Coached two SoCon Freshman of the Year award winners, two SoCon Defensive Player of the Year award winners and nine All-Conference selections.
- WCU made runs to the 2012 and 2014 SoCon Championship games.
- Guided WCU to 4-0 SoCon starts in 2012-13 and 2013-14.
