#### FAST BREAK POINTS

- Stony Brook will face its second SEC opponent in as many years, having lost at Georgia, 80-70, in the Preseason NIT last season. The Seawolves are 0-3 against the Southeastern Conference.
- The Seawolves are 1-9 all-time against the AP Top 25. Their only win happened last year at No. 13 Washington, rallying to beat the Huskies, 62-57. SBU beat Penn State in 2006 for its other win over a BCS opponent.
- Stony Brook previously reached the 100-point mark in wins against Detroit (104-102 3OT in 2013) and New England College (107-45 in 2000). The 58 points scored in the first half and 62 rebounds against USMMA are new school records, breaking the previous marks of 53 and 61, respectively, set against New England College.
- Stony Brook will make play its first game in the state of Tennessee.
- USMMA, which made 10 threes and shot .435 from behind the arc last season against Stony Brook, made only two threes and shot .091 in Saturday's game.
- The 22 assists recorded Saturday were the most since accounting for 24 against Mount Ida in 2011.

**SEAWOLVES FAMILIAR WITH CRESSLER**

Stony Brook went 2-0 against Nolan Cressler when he was on Cornell. Cressler averaged 8.5 points, but shot 6 of 19 in two games against Stony Brook.

**WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT STONY BROOK**

- Stony Brook is a member of the Association of American Universities (AAU), the invitation-only organization of the best 62 research institutions in North America. Vanderbilt is a member of this association, too.
- Stony Brook is 60 miles east of Manhattan.
- New York Giants tight end Will Tye became the first Stony Brook player to make a 53-man roster.
- Stony Brook is one of the 35 best values in colleges and universities by Kiplinger.
- Stony Brook is one of four University centers, joining Binghamton, Albany and Buffalo.
- Four Stony Brook grads played Major League Baseball in 2015 -- Travis Jankowski (San Diego), Nick Tropeano (Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim), Joe Nathan (Detroit Tigers) and Tom Koehler (Florida Marlins).
- Stony Brook's women's lacrosse team consistently was ranked in the top 10 last season.
- Stony Brook's baseball team advanced to the College World Series in 2012, becoming the second No. 4 seed since 1999 to reach the eight-team tournament.

**BEEN IN THIS POSITION BEFORE**

Stony Brook will enter Thursday's game 1-9 all-time against the AP Top 25. But the Seawolves lone win was memorable as they defeated No. 13 Washington, 62-57, last season in Seattle.

The Huskies led 47-31 with 13:43 left in the second half, but the Seawolves ended the game on a 31-10 spurt.

Stony Brook also outscored Washington, 17-2, over the final 6:36.

The victory was the Seawolves' first over a school from a Power Five conference since beating Penn State in 2006.

**WALK-ER THIS WAY**

Ahmad Walker made his return to Stony Brook in a big way against USMMA, totaling 17 points, six assists, five rebounds, two steals and a block. He made all four of his field goal attempts and went 8 of 11 from the free throw line (all in the first half).

**TY GOES TO THE REBOUNDER**

Sophomore Tyrell Sturdivant made his first collegiate start against USMMA and produced seven points and a career-high 13 rebounds. He led the Seawolves with nine defensive boards.

**COOL HAND LUKE**

Junior Lucas Woodhouse made his long-awaited debut for Stony Brook against USMMA and produced a near-perfect

stat line. He scored 10 points, shooting 3 of 3 from the field, 2 of 2 from three, and made both of his free throw attempts. Woodhouse also had three assists.

**STREAKY FROM THE LINE**

Stony Brook made three of its first eight attempts from the free throw line against USMMA, but rebounded to connect on its next 17 attempts.

**STONY BROOK IN HOME OPENERS**

Stony Brook won its fourth straight season opener and are 7-4 in season openers under Steve Pikiell.

**STONY BROOK SIGNS ALMONACY, GARCIA**

Head Coach Steve Pikiell announced the signing of a pair of tri-state area standouts. Michael Almonacy (Brentwood, N.Y.) and Andrew Garcia (Harlem, N.Y.) signed National Letters of Intent and will join the Seawolves in the Fall of 2016.

**HOME DEFINITELY IS WHERE THE HEART IS**

Over the last four-plus seasons, Stony Brook is 50-7 at home, losing just two non-conference games (70-68 vs. St. Francis Brooklyn, 2012; 64-62 vs. Sacred Heart, 2011) during that stretch. The Seawolves are in the midst of an nine-game non-conference home winning streak.

**DYNAMIC DUOS!**

**Jameel Warney** and **Carson Puriefoy** were one of two Division I duos last season to finish first and second in their conference in scoring, joining Georgia State's R.J. Hunter (19.7) and Ryan Harrow (18.3), who led the Sun Belt. Warney (16.4) and Puriefoy (14.4) represented 47 percent of Stony Brook's scoring last season.

Warney and **Rayshaun McGrew** were the only Division I duo to lead their conference in rebounding. Warney averaged 11.7 rebounds per game and McGrew 7.9.

**BACK AT THE ISLAND**

Stony Brook begins its second season at Island Federal Credit Union Arena, where it posted a 13-2 record last season. The Seawolves are scheduled to play 13 games at home, where they own a 50-7 (.877) record over the last four seasons. The Arena underwent a two-year, \$21 million renovation. Island Federal Credit Union and Stony Brook University agreed to a \$10 million, seven-year partnership.

**WELCOME BACK**

**Ahmad Walker**, who earned America East All-Rookie Team honors for Stony Brook in 2013-14, returns to the team after an All-American sophomore year at Barton CC in Kansas.

Walker led the Jayhawk West Conference with 20.6 points per game and the team with 7.7 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game.

As a freshman, Walker averaged 7.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per game.

**24 DOUBLE-DOUBLES!**

**Jameel Warney** led Division I with 24 double-doubles last season and has 40 for his career. With another season like last year or better, Warney will move into the top 25 all-time in Division I history.

Since the 2009-10 season, only five players have recorded more than 24 double-doubles in a season.

**WARNEY LOOKING TO JOIN ELITE COMPANY**

Should **Jameel Warney** win America East Player of the Year in 2015-16, he will join Vermont's Taylor Coppenrath and Northeastern's Reggie Lewis as the only three-time Player of the Year award winners.

Coppenrath won the award in 2002-03, 03-04 and 04-05 and Lewis won it in 1984-85, 85-86 and 86-87.

Coppenrath and Lewis won America East Rookie of the Year and won Player of the Year over the next three seasons.

**2,000-POINTS, 1,000-REBOUNDERS**

Only Drexel's Malik Rose and Boston University's Tunji Awojobi totaled at least 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in their careers. **Jameel Warney** begins the 2015-16 season with 1,477 points and 918 rebounds and currently has 1,493 points and 932 rebounds.

Rose finished his career with 2,024 points and 1,514 rebounds and Awojobi had 2,308 points and 1,237 rebounds.

Only 108 players have accomplished the feat in Division I history. Since the 2009-10 season, only seven players have reached that mark.

Niagara's Juan Mendez (2,210 points, 1,053 rebounds) and Syracuse's Hakim Warrick (2,073, 1,026) are the last players from a New York school to reach the feat.
