### The X's And O's

- Xavier, 6-1, won its third straight game with a 63-57 victory at Purdue on Saturday. Freshman **Semaj Christon** scored a career-high 25 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field and 8-of-8 shooting from the free-throw line to go with four rebounds, four assists and three steals to lead Xavier in his first true road game as a Musketeer. For his efforts, Christon was named Atlantic 10 Conference Rookie of the Week for the second straight week.
- Xavier, which won at Vanderbilt last season, has won nine of its last 10 games against the SEC against five different SEC teams since the 2007-08 season.
- Xavier sophomore **Dee Davis** is second on the team in scoring at 13.0 ppg. and in assists at 4.0 ppg. Davis scored a career-high 22 points to go with a career-high and XU sophomore record 15 assists in Xavier's win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9.
- Xavier's has four players averaging in double figures in scoring: freshman **Semaj Christon** (16.0 ppg.), sophomore **Dee Davis** (13.0 ppg.), sophomore **Justin Martin** (12.3 ppg.) and senior **Jeff Robinson** (10.0 ppg.). Senior **Travis Taylor** is at 9.7 ppg.
- Xavier sophomore **Justin Martin** is the only Musketeer that has scored in double figures in every game this season. Martin is third on the team in scoring at 12.3 ppg. and is second in rebounding at 5.6 rpg., while shooting 58.0 percent from the field.
- Xavier junior **Isaiah Philmore** played his first regular season games for XU in the last four games. The Towson transfer has averaged 9.0 points and 6.5 rebounds over the last two games.
- Xavier fourth-year head coach **Chris Mack** is 79-31 (.718) overall as the Xavier head coach and now stands ninth on XU's all-time wins list behind eighth-place **Bob Staak** (88 wins in six seasons from 1979-85). Mack led Xavier to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first three seasons, including the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2010 and 2012.
- Xavier is one of only four teams that have made the NCAA Sweet 16 four times in the last five years (2008-12): Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina and Xavier. No team has made all of the last five Sweet 16s. Xavier is one of only eight schools that have made at least seven straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including 2012: Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Marquette, Michigan State, Texas, Wisconsin and **Xavier**.

• Xavier's men's basketball program is ranked 21st in the 2012 rankings released by *Basketball Times*.

• Xavier is ranked 11th in the nation in the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate at 97 percent. Xavier men's basketball was among 14 XU programs at 100 percent.

• Xavier has graduated each of the last 88 men's basketball players that have played as seniors, a streak which dates back to 1986.

# 2012-13 XAVIER BASKETBALL GAME NOTES & STATS

SEVEN STRAIGHT NCAA TOURNAMENTS • FOUR SWEET 16 APPEARANCES IN FIVE YEARS

**THE XAVIER-VANDERBILT SERIES:** Xavier leads the series 5-0, including an 82-70 overtime win at Vanderbilt last season. That was their first meeting since the 1997 NCAA Tournament. No. 7 seed XU defeated No. 10 seed Vanderbilt 80-68 in the first round of the 1997 NCAA Tournament in Auburn Hills, Mich. Future NBA standout **James Posey** led the Musketeers with 22 points and eight rebounds.

**XAVIER VS. THE SEC:** Xavier is hoping to continue its recent success against the SEC when it hosts Vanderbilt. XU, which defeated Georgia and Vanderbilt last season, has won nine of its last 10 games against the SEC since the 2008 season, including road wins at Florida, Georgia, Vanderbilt, LSU and Auburn, an NCAA Tournament win over Georgia and home wins over Georgia, LSU and Auburn.

**LAST YEAR'S MEETING IN NASHVILLE (NO. 11 XAVIER 82, NO. 20 VANDERBILT 70 IN OVERTIME):** Xavier came away with an impressive overtime win in its first road game last season thanks in great part to the guard tandem of **Tu Holloway** and **Mark Lyons**. The duo, who combined for seven points in the first half, combined for 36 points in the second half and overtime to lead XU to the comeback win. The Musketeers battled back from a 10-point deficit in the second half to force overtime and then dominated the overtime. Xavier trailed by nine points, 51-42, with 13 minutes left but a 10-0 run turned that into a one point, 52-51, lead going into the under 12-minute media timeout. Lyons played the role of hero at the end of regulation with a spinning layup off of a fast break to tie the score at 66-all with six seconds left. Holloway scored 10 of Xavier's 16 points in the overtime, including a pair of deep 3-pointers. Xavier dominated the rebounding battle 54-33, including a 25-9 advantage in offensive rebounds, led by graduate student **Andre Walker's** career-high and game-high 14 rebounds. Walker, a graduate of Vanderbilt, had a successful return to the place where he enjoyed a successful career as an undergraduate. **John Jenkins** led Vanderbilt with 20 points.

**FOR THE RECORD (VANDERBILT):** Vanderbilt, 2-4, is coming off a 62-52 loss to Villanova on Saturday.

**FOR THE RECORD (XAVIER):** Xavier, 6-1, won its third straight game with a 63-57 victory at Purdue on Saturday. Freshman **Semaj Christon** scored a career-high 25 points on

8-of-12 shooting from the field and 8-of-8 shooting from the free-throw line to go with four rebounds, four assists and three steals to lead Xavier in his first true road game as a Musketeer. Sophomore **Justin Martin** also scored double figures with 12 points. Those efforts and a stingy XU defense helped offset a 44-29 Purdue advantage in rebounding. The Musketeer defense held Purdue to 35 percent shooting for the game, including 0 percent (0-of-17) from 3-point range.

## **XAVIER STRETCHED ITS SUCCESS AGAINST THE BIG TEN WITH THE WIN AT PURDUE:**

Xavier's win this past Saturday at Purdue was Xavier's seventh straight win over five different teams from the Big Ten (a streak that includes Purdue three times, Indiana, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Iowa). In fact, XU has won eight out of its last nine games against seven different teams (add Illinois to the list of victims) from the Big Ten Conference since the 2006-07 season. All of these nine games were played at neutral sites or on the road except the XU-Purdue game at Cintas Center in the 2011-12 season. The only loss during this stretch was a heart-breaking overtime loss to then-No. 1 Ohio State in the 2007 NCAA Second Round. XU has beaten Purdue five straight times.

**BALANCING ACT:** Xavier's balanced attack has four players averaging in double figures in scoring and a fifth player at 9.7 ppg. The top three scorers are either freshmen or sophomores: freshman **Semaj Christon** (16.0 ppg.), sophomore **Dee Davis** (13.0 ppg.), sophomore **Justin Martin** (12.3 ppg.) and seniors **Jeff Robinson** (10.0 ppg.) and **Travis Taylor** (9.7 ppg.).

**SHOOTING HAS BEEN ON THE MARK:** Xavier is shooting 52.0 percent as a team. In fact, all five starters are shooting 49.1 percent or higher.

**SENIOR LEADERSHIP:** Xavier has no starters and only five letterwinners back from last season's Sweet 16 team. Three seniors are being counted on for leadership of this year's squad, including forwards **Travis Taylor** and **Jeff Robinson** and guard **Brad Redford**, and all three have been major contributors so far. The trio has combined to contribute 26.9 points, 12.0 rebounds and shot a combined 51.1 percent (67-131).

**DEE DAVIS HAS BEEN A LEADER:** Sophomore **Dee Davis**, who is second on the team in scoring at 13.0 ppg. and is second

in assists at 4.0 apg., earned Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Week honors and also was named as one of ESPN's "Best of the Best" Top Performers of the weekend after scoring a career-high 22 points on the strength of a career-high five 3-pointers to go with a career-high 15 assists in Xavier's season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9. His previous highs were 10 points and six assists against Oral Roberts on Dec. 18, 2011. Davis hit 8-of-11 from the field, including 5-of-7 from 3-point range. Davis' 15 assists set a new Xavier sophomore record and tied for the second-best assist mark by any Xavier player. The 15 assists were just three shy of the school record of 18, which was set by **Keith Walker** against Detroit in the 1979-80 season.

## **CHRISTON EARNS ATLANTIC 10 ROOKIE HONORS AGAIN:**

Freshman **Semaj Christon**, who leads Xavier in scoring at 16.0 ppg. and in assists at 6.2 apg., was named Atlantic 10 Conference Rookie of the Week for a second straight week for his efforts at Purdue on Saturday. Christon had a tremendous game on Dec. 1 at Purdue in his first true road game as a Musketeer. Christon had a career-high 25 points on 8-of-12 from the field and 8-of-8 from the free throw line to go with four assists, four rebounds and three steals and was the only player on either team to play all 40 minutes. The week before Christon averaged 19.0 points, 6.3 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.0 steals for Xavier's three games in the DIRECTV Classic (Pacific, Drexel and Drake) from Nov. 22-25 in Anaheim, Calif., which also earned him a spot on the five-member DIRECTV Classic All-Tournament Team. Christon, who was a preseason Atlantic 10 All-Rookie Team selection by the coaches and media, had 18 points and six assists versus Pacific in the first round on Nov. 22, a career-high 23 points on 10-of-14 shooting to go with six assists in the win over Drexel on Nov. 23 and 16 points, seven assists and six rebounds in the win over Drake on Nov. 25.

## **CHRISTON LOOKING TO MAKE AN IMPRESSIVE SHORT LIST OF XAVIER FRESHMAN SCORERS:**

Freshman **Semaj Christon**, who leads Xavier in scoring at 16.0 ppg., is bidding to become the first Xavier freshman to average double figures in scoring or the first XU freshman to lead the team in scoring since **Stanley Burrell** scored a team-high 12.7 ppg. in the 2004-05 season. Burrell is one of only three Xavier freshmen that have scored in double figures over the last 15 sea-

sons. The other two are **David West** (11.7 ppg. in 1999-2000) and **Romain Sato** (10.7 ppg. in 2000-01).

#### **CHRISTON ALSO LOOKING TO MAKE HIS MARK AMONG XAVIER ASSIST LEADERS:**

Freshman **Semaj Christon** leads the team in assists at 6.2 apg. and is bidding to become the first Xavier freshman to lead the team in assists since **Dedrick Finn** at 4.3 apg. in the 2002-03 season. For the record, the last Xavier player to average more than six assists per game for an entire season was **Steve Gentry** at 6.1 apg. in the 1993-94 season.

#### **CHRISTON'S DEBUT WAS RECORD-BREAKING:**

Freshman **Semaj Christon**, who had to sit out the first game due to an infection, made his collegiate debut on Nov. 13 against Butler and dished off a game-high eight assists in 27 minutes of action. The eight assists set a new Xavier record for most assists by a freshman in his first collegiate game. For the record, the most assists on record by a Xavier freshman in his first collegiate game was previously shared by **Michael Hawkins** (6 vs. Colgate on 11-30-91), **Jamal Walker** (6 vs. Huntington on 11-28-87) and **Ralph Lee** (6 vs. Union on 11-29-82). The freshman record for assists in a game is 11 by **Dedrick Finn** vs. Rhode Island (2-15-03) and by **Michael Hawkins** vs. Fordham (2-26-92).

#### **MARTIN ENJOYING HIS STARTING ROLE:**

Sophomore **Justin Martin** has started and scored in double figures in each of the first seven games, the only XU player that has scored in double figures in every game this season. Martin is third on the team in scoring at 12.3 ppg. and second in rebounding at 5.6 rpg., while shooting 58.0 percent from the field. Martin, who averaged a team-high 7.3 rebounds during the DIRECTV Classic, was just one rebound shy of a double-double with 12 points and a game-high nine rebounds in the win over Drexel on Nov. 23. Martin led Xavier with a career-high 17 points against Robert Morris on Nov. 17 on the strength of a career-high six field goals, including a career-high four 3-pointers. Martin dished off a career-high six assists to go with 11 points and six rebounds in Xavier's season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9.

**TAYLOR MADE FOR THE PAINT:** Senior **Travis Taylor** leads Xavier in rebounding at 6.4 rpg. and is fifth in scoring at 9.7 ppg.

Taylor recorded a double-double with 20 points (hitting 7-of-9 from the field) and 12 rebounds in Xavier's season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9. His 20 points established a new Xavier career high and his 12 rebounds tied his career high.

**TAYLOR HAS OVER 1,000 POINTS FOR HIS COLLEGIATE CAREER:** Senior **Travis Taylor** scored 15 points against Butler on Nov. 13 and passed the 1,000-point mark for his collegiate career. Taylor now has 1,043 career points, including 812 as a freshman and sophomore at Monmouth University and 231 points so far at Xavier.

**WELCOME ISAIAH:** Junior forward **Isaiah Philmore**, a transfer from Towson University, has played his first regular season games as a Musketeer in the last four games. Philmore enjoyed his best game so far as a Musketeer with 10 points and six rebounds in the win over Drake on Nov. 25, while he contributed eight points and seven rebounds at Purdue on Dec. 1. Philmore sat out all three games of the season-opening homestand due to an oversight at Towson his freshman year with NCAA paperwork. Philmore sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules.

**ROBINSON HAS BEEN A KEY CONTRIBUTOR:** Senior **Jeff Robinson**, who is fourth on the team in scoring (10.0 ppg.) and third in rebounding (4.7 rpg.), scored 13 points and grabbed four rebounds in the Drexel win on Nov. 23. Robinson came back to score 13 points (all in the second half, while hitting all five of his second-half shots) and grab seven rebounds (six in the second half) in the win over Drake on Nov. 25. Robinson led XU in scoring in the Butler win on Nov. 13 with 17 points to go with eight rebounds and two steals.

**SCHOLARSHIP EFFORT:** Junior **Erik Stenger**, who transferred to Xavier from Northern Kentucky University as a walk-on, has been awarded a scholarship for the 2012-13 season. Stenger, who is averaging 11.0 minutes per game, started each of the first two regular season games and the exhibition game before coming off the bench for the last four games. Stenger scored 12 points, hitting all six of his shots from the field, and grabbed four rebounds in Xavier's season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9. Stenger also started the exhibition game against Kentucky State on Nov. 3, tying for team-high scoring honors with 12 points

to go with team highs of nine rebounds, four blocked shots and three steals.

**REDFORD IS OFF TO A SOLID START:** Senior **Brad Redford** is sixth on the team in scoring at 7.1 ppg., while hitting 12-of-27 (.444) from 3-point range. Redford, who has 141 career 3-pointers out of 159 career field goals, hit two big 3-pointers in the Drexel win on Nov. 23. Redford scored a career-high 19 points on 6-of-7 3-point shooting in Xavier's season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 9. The point total and 3-point field goal total both set new career highs. His previous career scoring high was 16 points at Kansas State on Dec. 8, 2009. His previous career high for treys was five against Fordham on Feb. 14, 2009, and Robert Morris on Dec. 31, 2008.

**AN IMPRESSIVE DEBUT FOR FARR IN THE OPENER:** Freshman **James Farr** hit 6-of-7 from the field, including 2-of-3 3-pointers, on his way to 14 points in his collegiate debut in the season-opening win over Fairleigh Dickinson. Farr also grabbed four rebounds.

**SITTING OUT...FOR NOW:** Junior forward **Chris Cantino**, a transfer from Palm Beach State College, is practicing with the Musketeers and sitting on the bench.

**LOCAL CONNECTIONS:** In addition to Xavier head coach **Chris Mack**, a graduate of Cincinnati's St. Xavier High School, XU boasts two scholarship players from the area (freshman **Semaj Christon** from Winton Woods High School as well as junior **Erik Stenger**, who is from St. Xavier High School and is a transfer from Northern Kentucky University). One of the walk-ons, junior **Tim Whelan**, is also a St. Xavier High School graduate.

**PLENTY OF SUCCESS AT CINTAS CENTER:** The Xavier men's basketball team, which is in its 13th season at its beautiful on-campus home, has compiled a 165-21 (.887) record and has won seven straight games at Cintas Center. Xavier is 85-11 (.885) against Atlantic 10 teams and 80-10 (.889) against non-conference teams since Cintas Center opened for the 2000-01 season. Xavier holds a 47-1 Atlantic 10 Conference record at Cintas Center over the last six seasons. XU had a conference record 43-game A-10 home win streak snapped by Saint Louis last season (1-25-12).

**FAN SUPPORT:** Xavier has averaged 10,041 fans for its 186 games played so far at Cintas Center, while selling out 109 games, including 10 last season.

## RECORD-SETTING SCORING EFFORT IN THE OPENER:

The 117 points scored against Fairleigh Dickinson in the season opener on Nov. 9 are a new Cintas Center record, the most points scored during Chris Mack's tenure at Xavier and the most points by an XU team since XU defeated Loyola Marymount 118-113 at LMU in the 1988-89 season (1-4-89). For the record, XU was just eight points shy of the school record of 125 points vs. Florida International (1-9-88 at Schmidt Fieldhouse). The 68 points scored in the first half by Xavier mark XU's highest total in a half since scoring 72 in that 1988 win over FIU. In addition, the win over FDU marked Xavier's 23rd straight season-opening win and kept XU perfect at 13-0 in season openers at Cintas Center.

## TWO MORE TALENTED RECRUITS SIGN TO PLAY FOR XAVIER:

Xavier University head coach **Chris Mack** has received National Letters of Intent from 6-1 guard **Brandon Randolph** (Inglewood, Calif./Inglewood High) and 6-6 small forward **Kamall Richards** (Henryville, Pa./South Kent). Richards transferred to the Connecticut prep school South Kent this past year after playing at St. Benedict's Prep in Newark, N.J. "Kamall is a physical wing who hates to lose, loves to win and brings more toughness to our team," said Mack. "He has good size, an ability to shoot and will have a college-ready physique as a freshman. Brandon is an explosive guard capable of playing on and off the ball. He excels in transition and can be a lockdown defender in the future." Randolph, a Scout.com four-star recruit, is a standout member of the Pump N Run AAU team, while Richards, an ESPN.com three-star recruit whose stock is quickly rising, is a star on the We-R1 East Coast Elite AAU squad.

## THREE OTHER PLAYERS OF NOTE FOR NEXT SEASON:

**Matt Stainbrook**, a 6-10 junior center, is sitting out this season after transferring from Western Michigan but is practicing with the Musketeers. Two future Musketeers are concentrating on academics this school year and will join the active roster next season: **Myles Davis**, a 6-2 and 200-pound guard who played at Notre Dame Preparatory School in Fitchburg, Mass., in the 2011-12 season and **Jalen Reynolds**, a 6-9 and 220-pound forward who played with **Semaj Christon** and won a National Prep

School Championship at Brewster Academy in Wolfeboro, N.H., in the 2011-12 season.

**RANKED BY THE MAJOR POLLS:** Xavier was ranked 24th in the final 2012 ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. This marked the fifth straight year XU has appeared in the final Associated Press and/or Coaches Poll. XU, Duke and Kansas are the only schools that have been in one or both of the two major final polls each of the last five years.

## HIGHLY RANKED BY BASKETBALL TIMES:

Xavier's men's basketball program is ranked 21st in the 2012 rankings released by *Basketball Times*. The rankings are based on five categories: winning percentage, NBA players, federal graduation rate, *U.S. News and World Report* academic reputation and program cleanliness. Every five years since 1997, *BT* has evaluated the best NCAA programs, those that have won two-thirds of their games over 10 seasons. Xavier is one of only nine schools that have qualified for the rankings project every year, a list that also includes Arizona, Connecticut, Duke, Kansas, Kentucky, Murray State, North Carolina and Syracuse.

**NCAA SWEET SUCCESS:** Xavier is one of only four teams that have made the NCAA Sweet 16 four times in the last five years (2008-12). That list includes Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina and Xavier. No team has made all of the last five Sweet 16s. Xavier is one of only eight schools that have made at least seven straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including 2012: Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Marquette, Michigan State, Texas, Wisconsin and **Xavier**. Last season Xavier made its 11th NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 12 years.

**CHRIS MACK RADIO SHOW:** The weekly "Chris Mack Show" presented by Toyota on 55KRC airs live from T.G.I. Friday's in Kenwood from 7-8 p.m. on Mondays. There are shows every Monday from 7-8 p.m. in Nov., Dec., Jan. and Feb. except for Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. The 16th and final show is on Monday, March 4. Xavier's long-time radio tandem of **Joe Sunderman** (XU '79) and **Byron Larkin** (XU '88) host the show along with head coach **Chris Mack**. Sunderman and Larkin, who are both members of the XU Athletic Hall of Fame, also can be heard all season on 700 WLW and 55KRC with pre-game and post-game shows in addition to every regular season and postseason game broadcast.

## IMPRESSIVE GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE:

The NCAA has released this year's Graduation Success Rates (GSR) for student-athletes in Division I athletics. Xavier has continued its strong academic tradition among its student-athletes by posting a score of 97 percent, which ranked tied for 11th in the nation and was the best GSR score in the Atlantic 10 Conference. An impressive list of 14 Xavier teams out of XU's 18 NCAA Division I sports boasted GSR scores of 100 percent, including men's basketball.

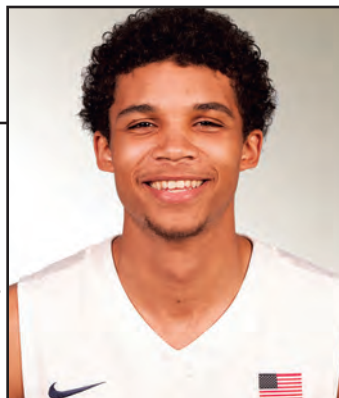

## IMPRESSIVE RECORD UNDER MACK

Xavier fourth-year head coach **Chris Mack** has proven he is a winner. Mack, 79-31 (.718) overall, stands ninth on XU's all-time wins list behind eighth-place **Bob Staak** (88 wins in six seasons from 1979-85).

Mack led Xavier to the NCAA Tournament in each of his first three seasons at the helm, including the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2010 and 2012. Mack led Xavier to Atlantic 10 Conference Regular Season Championships in 2010 and 2011. XU has finished in the top 25 of the Associated Press and/or *USA Today*/ESPN Poll each of his three seasons at the helm.

Mack, who a year ago signed a contract extension at Xavier that runs through the 2017-18 season, is very familiar with the NCAA Tournament. In fact, Mack has been a part of 13 NCAA Tournaments, including two as a player and 11 on the coaching staffs at Xavier and Wake Forest.

## ATLANTIC 10 COACH OF THE YEAR AWARD AND SKIP PROSSER AWARD

Xavier fourth-year head coach Chris Mack, 42, was selected as the 2010-11 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year by his fellow A-10 coaches. In addition, Mack was the recipient of the 2011 Skip Prosser Man of the Year award, which is sponsored by CollegeInsider.com. The Skip Prosser Award was established in 2008 to honor those who not only achieve success on the basketball court but who display moral integrity off of it as well. "Chris Mack is a winner on and off the floor," said ESPN's Jay Bilas.

## MACK MADE XAVIER HISTORY IN THE 2009-10 SEASON AS A ROOKIE HEAD COACH

Mack, the 2009-10 *Basketball Times* Rookie Coach of the Year, was 26-9 in his first season as Xavier's head coach. He was the winningest first-year head coach in Division I for the 2009-10 season. He was the only rookie head coach to lead his team into the 2010 NCAA Tournament. Mack became the first Xavier head coach to guide XU to the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in either his first or second season. Mack led Xavier to a 20-win season, the first time in school history that a coach has led a team to 20 wins without at least two seniors on the roster. He also accomplished that feat with no returning double-figure scorers from the 2008-09 season. In fact, Mack won 26 games, tying him for the best total ever for a Xavier rookie head coach.

## XAVIER COACHING SUCCESS STORY

Mack is the 17th head coach in program history. Prior to being named Xavier's head coach on April 15, 2009, Mack spent five seasons as an assistant on Sean Miller's Xavier staff. Prior to that he was on the staff of the late Skip Prosser both at Xavier and at Wake Forest.

## LEARNED UNDER PROSSER AND MILLER

Mack was XU's Director of Basketball Operations from 1999-2001 under Prosser. Mack spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Wake Forest under Prosser from 2001-04. He returned to Xavier from 2004-09 as an assistant coach under Miller. During those 10 years on the Prosser and Miller staffs at Xavier and Wake, Mack coached on nine teams that made postseason play, including eight teams that made the NCAA Tournament field. Those eight NCAA teams made the NCAA Second Round three times (2002, 2003 and 2007), the NCAA Sweet 16 twice (2004 and 2009) and the NCAA Elite Eight once (2008).

## XU PLAYER AND GRADUATE

Mack, a 1992 Xavier University graduate, is the fifth Xavier alumnus out of 17 all-time head coaches to take over the Xavier men's basketball program. Mack was a two-time team captain as a player at Xavier under then-head coach Pete Gillen. He won an MCC Regular Season Championship at 12-2 and reached the second round of the 1993 NCAA Tournament. Mack was the 1987-88 *Cincinnati Post* Metro Player of the Year at St. Xavier High School in Cincinnati before going on to start for two seasons at Evansville, winning an MCC Regular Season Championship and a trip to the second round of the 1989 NCAA Tournament as a UE freshman. He transferred to Xavier after his sophomore season.

## BASKETBALL FAMILY MAN

Mack and his wife, Christi, have two daughters, Hailee (6) and Laine (7). Christi has a basketball background as a collegiate standout at the University of Dayton, the Director of Basketball Operations for XU's women's basketball team (2001-03) and more recently as the former head girls basketball coach at Cincinnati's Colerain High School.

Xavier enjoyed a record-setting 117-75 win over Fairleigh Dickinson in the regular season opener at Cintas Center. XU raced out to a 68-32 halftime lead, hitting 70.6 percent from the field in the first half. The Musketeers broke open a tight game early in the first half with a 30-6 run over about seven minutes, to take a 42-19 lead with 8:28 remaining. Senior **Brad Redford**, who finished with a career-high 19 points, came off the bench to spark Xavier with 13 points during the run on four three-pointers and a free throw. Seven Musketeers in all reached double figures, including sophomore **Dee Davis** with a career-high 22 points to go with a career-high and Xavier sophomore record 15 assists. Senior **Travis Taylor** contributed a double-double with Xavier career highs of 20 points and 12 rebounds. Senior **Jeff Robinson** (16), freshman **James Farr** (14), junior **Erik Stenger** (12) and sophomore **Justin Martin** (11) also reached double figures. This marked the first time Xavier has placed seven players in double figures in scoring since the 2007-08 season against Virginia at Cintas Center (1-3-08). Xavier dominated the rebounding 41-11. The 117 points scored against Fairleigh Dickinson are a new Cintas Center record, the most points scored during Chris Mack's tenure at Xavier and the most points by an XU team since XU defeated Loyola Marymount 118-113 at LMU in the 1988-89 season (1-4-89). For the record, XU was just eight points shy of the school record of 125 points vs. Florida International (1-9-88 at Schmidt Fieldhouse). The 68 points scored in the first half by Xavier mark XU's highest total in a half since scoring 72 in that 1988 win over FIU. Xavier won its 23rd straight season opener and remained perfect at 13-0 in season openers at Cintas Center.

Xavier recorded an impressive win over Butler as part of ESPN's Tip-Off Marathon. Seniors **Jeff Robinson** and **Travis Taylor** combined for 32 points and 17 rebounds to lead the Musketeers. Taylor passed the 1,000-point mark for his collegiate career during his 15-point, nine-rebound effort. Freshman **Semaj Christon**, who missed the first game due to an infection, made his collegiate debut and dished off eight assists. Sophomore **Dee Davis** led the XU defense that held Butler to 36.5 percent shooting, including 25 percent in the second half. The Musketeers held Butler to 1-of-9 (11.1 percent) shooting from the field in their first 10 possessions in the second half. With the score tied 9-9 with 13:23 to go in the first half, Xavier went on a 12-2 run to go up 21-11 with 10:01 left. Robinson and Davis led the way with five points each during the run. Butler chipped away at the lead and trailed by seven points, 36-29, at halftime. After Butler narrowed the margin to 36-32 at the 17:59 mark of the second half, Xavier outscored the Bulldogs 10-1 to push the lead to 46-33 with 12:12 remaining. Robinson, who finished with a game-high 17 points to go with eight rebounds, hit a jumper with 5:28 left that extended the Xavier lead to 20 points at 57-37. This game was played as a non-conference tilt despite the fact that both schools are now in the Atlantic 10 Conference. The two teams will meet again Saturday, March 9 at Hinkle Fieldhouse and that game will be an Atlantic 10 Conference contest.

Xavier escaped with the two-point win over Robert Morris that completed a sweep of the season-opening three-game homestand. Sophomore **Justin Martin**, who was the only Xavier player who scored in double figures in all three games of the homestand, led XU with a career-high 17 points on the strength of a career-high four 3-pointers. Sophomore **Dee Davis** had 15 points, while freshman **Semaj Christon** made his first collegiate start and contributed 12 points and six assists. Senior **Brad Redford** scored his only two points on a pair of clutch free throws with 37 seconds left that broke a 59-all tie and proved to be the game-winners. Both teams were hot to start the game as they connected on all six 3-point attempts. XU was 2-for-2 from the long range while RMU was a perfect 4-for-4. Xavier used a 9-0 run midway through the first half to take a 26-19 lead with 8:31 left before intermission. The Colonials cut the lead down to 32-31 with under a minute left but a Davis free throw followed later by a Davis' 3-pointer at the buzzer gave XU a 36-31 halftime lead. Robert Morris scored the first four points of the second half, cutting the lead to 36-35 with under 18 minutes left. Then the Musketeers answered with a 7-0 run to extend the lead to 43-35 with 15:51 left but the visitors wouldn't go away quietly. Robert Morris came all the way back and eventually forced a pair of ties, the last of which came at 59-all thanks to a jumper by RMU's Velton Jones. XU's defense held Robert Morris scoreless the rest of the game. In fact, Redford's two free throws proved to be the only points by either team in the final 1:50 of action.

Davis contributed 14 points, senior **Travis Taylor** had 13 and sophomore **Justin Martin** scored 11.
