TEAM NOTES

Commodores Win SEC Championship and East Regional

Vanderbilt has now won their last two tournaments - the SEC Championship and the NCAA Regional - by a combined 25 shots. The Commodores captured the SEC title by 11 shots and the East Regional by 14 shots over second-place South Carolina (on both occasions). The Dores, who set a new team course record at the SouthWood Golf Course on Thursday with an opening round 277, beat their own record on Saturday, shooting a 14-under par, 274.

Vanderbilt claimed the SEC team and individual championship in April at the Greystone Golf and Country Club, with the team winning by 11 strokes over second-place South Carolina and freshman Simin Feng earning medalist honors by eight strokes over LSU's Lindsay Gahm and Arkansas' Gaby Lopez. The 2014 title was Vanderbilt's second SEC crown in the program's history, with the other coming in 2004. The Commodores also won medalist honors that season, when May Wood was the tournament's top individual.

The Commodores did the double again at the East Regional. It was their second regional championship, with Jennifer Hahn claiming medalist honors. The regional title was Vanderbilt's second in program history (2004), and Hahn is the Commodores' second medalist at a regional (Jacqui Concolino, 2007).

Going low at Regionals

The Commodores' three-round score of 840 set a new program-best for 54 holes, beating the former record at the 2014 Central District Invitational by four shots. The final-round 274 also set a new single-round program record by one shot that was previously held in 2006 at the Stanford-Pepsi Intercollegiate on a par-71 format.

Vanderbilt Wins Four Tournaments in 2013-14

The Commodores won four tournaments this year, with all happening in the spring. Vanderbilt won the Central District Invitational in their spring opener February 17-18 for the first team win of the Greg Allen era, captured the 3M Lady Jaguar Intercollegiate March 14-15, the SEC Championship April 18-20, and the NCAA East Regional May 8-10.

Four Tournament Wins...

Is now the second-highest single-season team wins total in program history. The 2003-04 Commodores won a program-best five team titles.

Freshman Simin Feng Leads Dores

Freshman Simin Feng leads all golfers with a 71.85 stroke average and has won two tournaments in her inaugural season with the Commodores - the Central District Invitational and the SEC Championship. Feng won the SEC's Golfer of the Week on March 5, and on April 21, was named Golfweek's National Player of the Week for her SEC Championship effort. Feng's 71.96 stroke average trails only Marina Alex's 71.59 stroke average in 2009-10 when she won medalist honors at the SEC Championship in 2010 and was named a first-team All-American.

Balanced effort for Commodores

Feng is no doubt putting together an All-American season, but other Commodores are also pitching in for this record-setting season. Jennifer Hahn (Ruth's Chris Tar Heel Invitational) and Kendall Martindale (3M Lady Jaguar Intercollegiate) have each notched a top five finish this year, and four of the five Vanderbilt starters (Feng, Hahn, Martindale, Antonia Scherer) have notched rounds in the 60's. At the East Regional, Hahn claimed medalist honors, Martindale finished in a tie for second, and junior Irina Gabasa finished in a tie for fourth.

Commodores heading to fifth straight NCAA Championship

The Commodores are heading to their fifth consecutive NCAA Championship, a program best, and Vanderbilt head coach Greg Allen, now in his seventh season, will be heading to his 11th as a head coach. Allen was the head coach at Arizona, where he coached Lorena Ochoa and Natalie Gulbis, among others, before moving to Nashville in 2007. His best finish at a national championship was a second-place finish at the 2002 NCAA Championship.

SEC Accolades

Three Commodores were honored by the SEC for their play this season, with freshman Simin Feng leading the way. Feng was named the conference's Freshman of the Year, while also being honored on the All-SEC First Team and the All-Freshman team. Sophomore Jennifer Hahn was named to the All-SEC Second Team, while freshman Antonia Scherer was named to the All-Freshman team.

Dores finished in top three at Regional for 3rd consecutive season in 2014

Vanderbilt finished atop the team standings at the East Regional in 2014, the third consecutive season VU has finished in the top three. The Commodores finished in third at the 2013 West Regional at Stanford Golf Course, which followed up a second-place finish at the 2012 Central Regional in Columbus, Ohio.

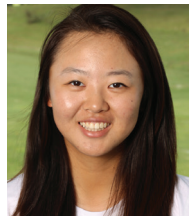

Greg Allen, Head Coach



Greg Allen, considered one of the outstanding collegiate golf coaches in the NCAA, is in his seventh season at the helm of the Vanderbilt women's golf program.

Allen has made an impact in seven seasons - his Commodores have been to seven consecutive NCAA Regionals and and five consecutive NCAA Championships, a school first.

His seventh Vanderbilt team has been his most successful to date, winning four tournaments in 2013-14, including the 2014 SEC Championship and the NCAA East Regional, the Commodores' first victories at the events since 2004. Freshman Simin Feng also won medalist honors at the SEC Championship and the Central District Invitational, while sophomore Jennifer Hahn won the NCAA East Regional individual title. Additionally, three different Vanderbilt golfers have finished in the top five in a tournament this season.

In the last five seasons, his teams have advanced to five consecutive NCAA Championships and he has coached a SEC Player of the Year in Marina Alex, who won two of those awards, a SEC Freshman of the Year in Simin Feng, two first-team All-Americans in Alex and Lauren Stratton, and a NCAA regional champion in Hahn.

In 2010, his first NCAA Championship team at Vanderbilt broke through to finish seventh in Wilmington, N.C., while also in 2010, he coached the SEC Player of the Year in Marina Alex and had two freshmen make the All-SEC Freshmen in Anna Leigh Keith and Lauren Stratton.

In 2011, his Commodore team qualified for the NCAA Championship after winning a one-hole playoff against Florida State in the NCAA East Regional. It was Allen's second consecutive trip to the national championship as Vanderbilt's coach and eighth overall. He also guided Vanderbilt to their first back-to-back top 10 finishes at the NCAA Championship after his 2011 squad ended the event in a tie for 10th place. Two of his players, Alex and senior Megan Grehan, were named to the All-SEC Second team at the end of the regular season.

In 2012, Vanderbilt advanced to the NCAA Championships for the third consecutive season and a date on their home course when the Commodores finished in second place at the NCAA Central Regional in Columbus, Ohio. The Commodores' second-place finish was the second-best at a regional in program history - only the 2004 team's win at the Central Regional was better. VU finished in 11th place at the national championship, and Alex and Stratton were each named NGCA First-Team All-Americans. It was the first time in the history of the program that the Commodores have had two first-team All-Americans in the same season.

Allen came to Vanderbilt after a seven-year tenure as the head coach at the University of Arizona, where he twice won the Pac-10 Conference, finished as NCAA runner-up in 2002 and coached Lorena Ochoa - the number one ranked player on the LPGA Tour before her retirement in 2010 - among nine other All-Americans.

Allen had a lengthy record of achievement at Arizona during his seven years there. In addition to his Pac-10 titles and 10 All-Americans, he coached eight NCAA All-Scholars, 13 Academic All-Pac-10 student-athletes, three NCAA Players of the Year, two National Freshmen of the Year, three Pac-10 Players of the Year, two Curtis Cup selections and 21 All-Pac-10 performers. Two of his players won three Golfstat Cup Award for the nation's lowest stroke average. His Wildcat teams also won nine tournament championships and registered 28 individual victories. Allen has also coached LPGA and PGA stars Natalie Gulbis, Erica Blasberg, Laura Myerscough, and David Gossett during his coaching career.

Allen arrived at Arizona after serving as assistant men's golf coach at Texas from 1998-2000. He helped lead the 1999-2000 Longhorns to a banner year that included the NCAA Central Region championship and a fifth-place finish at the NCAA Championship, its highest finish in five years. The squad ended the season ranked No. 8 in the final MasterCard Collegiate Rankings. The 1998-99 team had its best showing in six years, as it earned three tournament victories and finished in the top three in seven of its 13 competitions. Well known for his rapport with collegiate players, Allen handled many of the day-to-day operations for the Longhorns and assisted head coach John Fields with scheduling, recruiting and coaching at practices and tournaments.

Prior to that he was Director of Tournament Operations for the American Junior Golf Association in Roswell, Ga., where he spent five years as both director of tournament operations and tournament director. While in Roswell, Allen was responsible for planning and executing 47 national junior golf tournaments and other AJGA events. He oversaw all AJGA tournaments and was responsible for the supervision of eight tournament directors, as well as the hiring of 24 summer interns.

He is a native of Beechmont, Kentucky and graduated from Murray State in 1993 with a degree in journalism. As a student, he worked in the sports information office, where he was a liaison for numerous sports, including golf. Prior to graduation, Allen worked two summers as a communications intern for the AJGA, where he was responsible for all on-site media relations at 10 national junior golf tournaments.

He and his wife Julie, a swim coach who competed in the 1988 Olympic trials, have four children, Maggie (18), Mollie (14), Mason (12) and Mabry Jane (5).

Prior to her arrival at Vanderbilt, Clark began the Carson Newman golf program in January of 2008 as the team's first head coach, and helped lead the Lady Eagles to their first NCAA Regional appearance in 2010 and the South Atlantic Conference Championship in their first year of existence in 2009. Clark had an individual compete in the NCAA Regional in the program's first year in 2009, and coached a NGCA All-American and an Academic All-American in 2009-10.

"I'm really excited to have Holly join our program and become part of the family," said Vanderbilt head coach Greg Allen.



"She has an impressive background in a very short time as a coach. Starting a college golf program shows me that she knows what it takes to work hard and get things done. She has a wonderful personality filled with southern charm that the Vanderbilt community will fall in love with."

Before her arrival at Carson Newman, Clark was a four-year standout player at the University of Tennessee, where she helped lead the Volunteers to the 2006 NCAA East Regional title.
