The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 27-16 (.628) overall in his second season as a head coach. He is 12-6 all-time in MVC games, including a 7-2 mark at home and a 5-4 mark on the road. During his career, he is 14-3 in all home games, 7-9 on the road, 6-4 in neutral court contests and 10-3 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 0-0 all-time against Vanderbilt, and is 0-0 against the SEC. With the Trees, Lansing is 0-2 in overtime games and 20-0 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Saturday's game is Greg Lansing's 44th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 116th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,375-1,182 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's game at Oral Roberts last season was the historic 2,500th game in the history of the program.

Against The Southeastern Conference

Indiana State is 4-7 all-time against members of the Southeastern Conference. The Sycamores' last victory over a member of the SEC was against Vanderbilt in 1984. The last time the Sycamores faced a member of the SEC, came in 2009 when the Sycamores traveled to LSU in 2009. Against members of the SEC, the Sycamores own the following records: Arkansas 2-2, Georgia 0-1, LSU 0-1, Ole Miss 0-1, Mississippi State 1-1, Vanderbilt 1-1.

Sycamores 6-2 For Best Start Since 2005

Indiana State has opened the 2011-12 campaign with victories over Eastern Illinois, Louisiana-Monroe, Ball State, Green Bay, Texas Tech, Fairfield and Maryville. The Sycamores are off to a 7-2 start to a season which is its best since the 2005-06 season when the Trees opened with an 8-1 ledger and also matches a 7-2 start to the 2000-01 season.

Walk This Way

Myles Walker scored a career-high 20 points as the Sycamores downed Maryville by the score of 68-57 on December 10. Walker went 8-of-11 from the field and was a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line in the victory. He added five rebounds and a blocked shot in 32 minutes of action. Walker scored his final three points on a conventional 3-point play in the game's final minutes which helped ISU secure the victory.

An Indiana State Win Over Vanderbilt Would ...

- Give the Sycamores its first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since downing No. 14 Butler in 2006 inside

Hulman Center.

- Give the Sycamores a total of five victories against members of the Southeastern Conference in 12 tries and its

first over a SEC member since downing Vanderbilt in 1984.

- Improve the Sycamores to 8-9 in true road contests under second-year head coach Greg Lansing.

Walker Strong In Each Of Last Three Games

Myles Walker has been force for the Sycamores in the last three games as he is averaging 15.3 points and five rebounds per game. Walker tallied a career-high 20 points on the strength of a 8-of-11 shooting performance against Maryville. He also scored 16 points in the final game of the Old Spice Classic against Fairfield and then came back with 10 more in just 15 minutes of play at Boise State. Walker has reached double figures scoring in each of the last three games. Over that stretch, Walker has hit 20-of-29 shots from the field (69.0 percent) and is a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line.

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

With the 68-57 victory over Maryville on December 10, the Sycamores are now 14-3 (.824) inside Hulman Center under second-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won each of their last five home games, dating back to a loss last season to Morehead State in the annual Sears Bracketbusters contest.

Road Warriors

Indiana State saw its road winning streak of four games snapped with a 74-65 loss at Boise State as part of the Missouri Valley/Mountain West Conference Challenge Series on December 3. The Sycamores had downed Illinois State, Southern Illinois and Northern Iowa on the road to end last season and began this year with a road victory over Louisiana-Monroe to keep the string alive. The Sycamores are 7-9 under second-year head coach Greg Lansing on the road, and have won six of their last 10 road contests.

Printy Moving Up Indiana State 3-Point List

Indiana State junior Jordan Printy currently has 172 career 3-pointers and recently passed Eddie Bird for second on the ISU all-time list. Printy is one of just 14 Sycamores in the history of the program to hit at least 100 3-point field goals in a career. Printy needs 111 more to tie Michael Menser for first on the ISU all-time 3-point list with 283. Additionally, Printy is the older brother of Iowa women's basketball sophomore Jaime Printy who was the 2010 Big Ten Freshman Of The Year. The Iowa women's basketball team received an at large bid into the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament also last season made Jordan and Jaime the only brother/sister combo in the Big Dance in 2011.

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 5-2 on the season when the Sycamores' starting five outscore the opponents' starting five. ISU's starters outscored the opponent's at Louisiana-Monroe and against Green Bay plus Texas Tech, Fairfield and Maryville this season and won. ISU starters outscored Minnesota and Boise State, but fell to each. Under second-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 17-4 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's counterparts.

63 Is The Magic Number

Indiana State is 5-0 this season when holding an opponent to 63 points or less. Under second-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are a perfect 20-0 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 9-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Triple-Double For Odum And Tournament Record To Boot

Sycamore sophomore guard Jake Odum battled a foot injury while playing three games in four days at the 2011 Old Spice Classic. After two solid performances in the first two days of the event, Odum saved his best for last as he posted 10 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists against Fairfield on November 27. That triple-double was the first by a Sycamore since Larry Bird posted one in 1979 versus Drake and the first by a member of the MVC in 14 seasons. Additionally, the 12 assists are an Old Spice Classic single-game record. His 12 assists is the first double digit assist total in his career and the first by a Sycamore since Michael Menser had 11 against Wichita State in 2001.

Odum Close To Second Triple-Double At Boise State

One game removed from posting the first triple double by a Sycamore since the 1979 season, sophomore Jake Odum nearly did the impossible and posted one in consecutive games as he scored nine points, pulled down eight rebounds and dished out six assists in 34 minutes of action at Boise State. Only Larry Bird posted a triple-double in consecutive contests for the Sycamores as he opened the 1976-77 campaign with triple-doubles against both Chicago State and St. Ambrose.

Indiana State Goes 2-1 At 2011 Old Spice Classic

Indiana State downed Texas Tech and Fairfield while falling to Minnesota as the Sycamores put together a 2-1 record at the 2011 Old Spice Classic held over Thanksgiving Weekend on the campus of Walt Disney World Resort. The Sycamores have now won two games in a row of over members of the Big 12 Conference (Texas Tech and Oklahoma in the 2001 NCAA Tournament). Jake Odum was named to the Old Spice Classic All-Tournament Team. ISU is the third MVC team to play in the event and the third place finish is the highest by any league team.

Indiana State Opens Tournament Play With A Win Over BCS School For First Time Since 1973

Indiana State's victory over Texas Tech in the opening round of the 2011 Old Spice Classic marked the second consecutive year that the Sycamores have opened an early season multi-team event with a win. ISU downed Texas Pan-American in the opening game of a tournament at Loyola-Chicago last season. Prior to the victory over Texas Tech, the last time a Sycamore team opened a tournament such as the Old Spice Classic with a win over a BCS school came on December 27, 1973 when ISU downed Florida State in the first game of the Bear Classic, played on the campus of Mercer University in Macon, Ga.

New King Of The Four-Point Play

Indiana State redshirt freshman RJ Mahurin learned a few trick from Aaron Carter, a graduated player who had eight career four-point plays. Mahurin posted two 4-point plays during his freshman season, one each in ISU's games against Drake and Bradley. His two 4-point plays have each come in the first half of the two contests in which he has been fouled while stepping out for a 3-pointer, has been fouled and has converted the ensuing free throw. Mahurin was fouled on a 3-point attempt against Illinois State, and made all three of his free throws. He is already at it again this year as he was fouled on a 3-point attempt against Ball State, missed the shot, but made all three of his awarded free throws. Mahurin was fouled on a 3-point attempt against Minnesota, but missed the ensuing free throw.

Jake Odum Named To Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Squad; Sycamore Picked Third

Jake Odum was one of two sophomores league wide to be named to the 2011-12 Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team as voted upon this fall by league head coaches, media and sports information directors. Odum was named to the league's honorable mention squad as well as to the all-freshman, all-newcomer and all-defensive squads one year ago as a freshman. Odum headlined a group of five players selected to the 2011-12 MVC Preseason All-Conference Team. Joining Odum were Creighton's Doug McDermott, Wichita State's Toure' Murry, Evansville's Colt Ryan and Missouri State's Kyle Weems. Weems is the league's preseason player of the year. As a team, Indiana State was picked to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference race behind Creighton and Wichita State. The Sycamores third place prediction is tied for its highest since the league began using preseason polls in 1985.

Sycamore Signees

Indiana State second year head coach Greg Lansing announced a pair of signees during the NCAA Early Signing Period in November of 2011. ISU has inked TJ Bell (Charleston, Ill./Charleston HS) and Rhett Smith (Sullivan, Ind./Sullivan HS) to national letters of intent and they will begin their Sycamore careers as freshman in time for the 2012-13 campaign.

Bell is a 6-8 guard/forward who will begin his senior season at Charleston (Ill.) High School later this month. He was listed early in his career as one of the Top 25 players in the state of Illinois and averaged 13.9 points as well as 8.2 rebounds as a junior. Bell was named to the All-Apollo Conference in 2011 for his Charleston team which finished with a 16-13 record.

Smith is a 6-7 post player who will begin his senior campaign next week for Sullivan High School and head coach Jeff Moore. He has been the Golden Arrows leading scorer each of his first three seasons of playing at the varsity level. He averaged 17.3 points per game last season as a junior despite missing playing time due to a hand injury. Smith connected on 61.6 percent of his shots from the field. He scored a season-best 28 points against West Vigo during the 2010-11 campaign.

The Last Time Out ...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. -- Despite trailing at halftime for the first time all season, senior center Myles Walker led ISU with a career high 20 points to defeat the Saints of Maryville by a final score of 68-57 in front of 4,929 people at Hulman Center.

Indiana State got on the board first with a layup from Walker before the Saints knocked down their first of seven first half 3-pointers to take a 3-0 lead. The Sycamores got some offense going early jumping out to a 17-10 lead with 11:36 remaining in the first half.

The Saints sharpshooting from the outside kept the Sycamores off balance and Maryville went on a 25-5 run to take a 35-22 lead over the Sycamores with just 4:45 remaining in the game.

Indiana State battled back, ending the half on a 14-2 run of their own to cut their deficit to just one at halftime at 37-36.

Maryville shot 65% from the floor in the first half and an astounding 78% off 7-9 shooting from 3-point range.

The Sycamores picked up their defensive intensity coming out of the locker room and retook the lead at 44-41 with just over 15 minutes left to go in the game. The Saints battled back and retook their final lead of the game at 45-44 with 14:42 to go, however, senior forward Carl Richard knocked down a 3-pointer to give the Sycamores a 47-45 lead; one the would not give up the rest of the game.

Indiana State continued to stretch out its lead over the remainder of the game en route to a 68-57 win over the Saints.

Walker led all scorers with 20 points and five rebounds. Senior guard Dwayne Lathan and sophomore guard Jake Odum also finished in double figures for ISU. Lathan ended with 13 points, four steals and three rebounds while Odum had 10 points, seven rebounds and six assists.

As a team the Sycamores shot 47 percent from the floor and are 20-0 when holding teams under 60 points in the Greg Lansing era.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Second Season

Greg Lansing is in his second season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the last three as as-

sociate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 min-

Lansing has also been a major reason for several all-conference accolades for numerous players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign and Marshall again in 2009-10. In 2008-09, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven-year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeye's went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to accomplish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under his direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree

from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Lansing earned all-state honors in three different sports at Harlan Community High School, graduating in 1986.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament.

Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004.

Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.

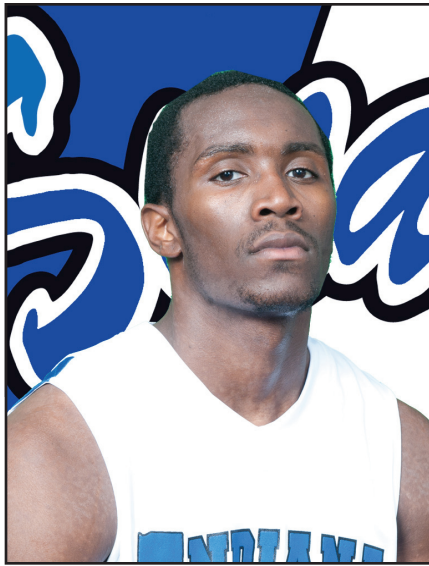
