### GAME 5 STORYLINES

**1. FIRST MEETING:** Saturday's (Sept. 29) game between Eastern Michigan University and Vanderbilt University will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

**2. FORMER COMMODORE LEADS EMU ATHLETICS:** EMU athletics director **Dr. Derrick Gragg** is a Vanderbilt alumnus, graduating in the class of 1992. He was a wide receiver on the Vanderbilt football team and earned four letters from 1988-91. He was an Academic All-Southeastern Conference selection in 1991.

**3. THIRD IN THE SEC:** Vanderbilt will be the third Southeastern Conference team that the Eastern Michigan University football team has faced. The Eagles made their first trip into SEC country, Sept. 16, 2000, when Eastern lost a 41-6 decision at South Carolina. The second pairing came, Sept. 11, 2004, when the Eagles traveled to Gainesville, Fla. and dropped a 49-10 decision to the No. 10 ranked Florida Gators.

**SATURDAY PREVIEW:** EMU will be out of Mid-American Conference action for the second week in a row when the Eagles travel to Nashville, Tenn. Saturday, Sept. 29, to square off against Vanderbilt University. The game will be the first ever between the two schools and the third game in EMU school history against a Southeastern Conference team. The Eagles lost a 41-6 decision at South Carolina, Sept. 16, 2000, and then dropped a 49-10 contest in Gainesville, Fla., Sept. 11, 2004, against the No. 10 ranked Florida Gators. Eastern hosted Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference foe Howard University last weekend, Sept. 22, and won the non-league tilt, 38-15.

**BIG STOPPER:** EMU junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** came up with his single-game best for tackles with a whopping 19 stops last weekend, Sept. 22, against Howard University. The 19 tackles were not only a career best for Holtzclaw but also marked the 12th double-digit tackle effort in his three-year career.

**MORE THAN A PUNTER:** Redshirt sophomore **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** has been one of the top punters in the nation for the past two years. He was one of 10 finalists for the 2006 Ray Guy Award which goes to the nation's top punter. He is on the Ray Guy watch list again this season. He was not only the starting punter last weekend, Sept. 22, against Howard University, but he was also called on to handle the place-kicking duties for the first time in his short career. Johnson responded with an outstanding effort on all fronts in that game. He punted six times for 251 yards and a 41.8 yard average, had four punts inside the 20-yard line, and had just two returned for two yards. Johnson made a 22-yard field goal in his only attempt, booted all five PAT kicks and also handled the kickoff duties, one of which led to an EMU recovery followed by a touchdown two plays later.

**FOUR FOR SCORES:** EMU redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** turned in a complete game Saturday, Sept. 22, against Howard. He completed 14-of-21 passes for 214 yards and threw for four touchdown passes. That four-touchdown pass performance tied for second-best in school history, a feat that has been accomplished 12 times. **Kainoa Akina** holds the EMU single-game record with six touchdown tosses, Nov. 24, 2001, at Akron.

**FIRST PICK:** Redshirt freshman safety **Ryan Downard (Lima, Ohio-Shawnee)** came up with the first interception of his career when he halted a Howard University scoring attempt with a pick in the end zone last weekend, Sept. 22. Downard has earned a starting role at free safety in the last two games in place of the injured **Chris May (Jupiter, Fla.-Dwyer)**.

**TWO STRAIGHT:** EMU's 38-15 win over Howard University last weekend, Sept. 22, marked the first time the Eagles have won two consecutive games since the 2005 squad posted back-to-back wins over Central Michigan, 23-20, in overtime, Sept. 24, and Kent State, 27-20, Oct. 1.

**SPREADING THE WEALTH:** When EMU redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** threw for four touchdown passes last weekend, Sept. 22, against Howard, he called upon four different receivers for scores. Schmitt hooked up with freshman tailback **Dwayne Priest (Roanoke, Va.-William Fleming-Fork Union Academy)** on a 24-yard touchdown strike followed by a four-yard touchdown pass to senior **Ken Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)**, a 35-yard TD strike to redshirt freshman **Tyrone Burke (Syracuse, NY-Corcoran)** and a 10-yard scoring strike to senior **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)**.

**MOVING UP NATIONALLY:** Several EMU players made a big jump in the national rankings from Sept. 15 to Sept. 22. Junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** moved all the way up from a tie for 23rd, Sept. 15, to currently rank No. 4 in the nation with an average of 12.75 tackles per game. Redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** was 77th in passing efficiency two weeks ago and moved up to 41st this week at 137.79. As a team, EMU moved all the way up to third nationally, from sixth previously, in sacks allowed at .50 per game.

**BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK RUSHING EFFORTS:** Senior tailback **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** turned in the three best back-to-back-to-back rushing efforts of his career the last three weeks. Walker turned in the second-best effort in his career when he gained 66 yards on 25 carries at Northern Illinois, Sept. 15. The previous week, Sept. 8 against Ball State, Walker gained 65 yards on 15 rushes. He then ran 16 times for 52 yards and a touchdown in last weekend's, Sept. 22, win over Howard University. Walker's previous best was 70 yards on 14 rushes versus Toledo, Oct. 21, 2006.

**HOLTZCLAW MAKES IT SIX:** Junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** turned in the sixth interception of his career when he picked off a pass at Northern Illinois, Sept. 15. Holtzclaw's pick led to EMU's winning touchdown in the 21-19 victory. The 6-foot-1 junior had five interceptions as a freshman.

**BIG PLAY MAN:** Sophomore **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, GA-Kell)** has turned into one of the big-play men on the EMU offense. He turned in the longest reception of his short career when he raced 65 yards with an **Andy Schmitt (St. Johns, Mich.-St. John's)** pass for a touchdown in the Ball State game (Sept. 8). It was the first touchdown of White's career. He came right back at NIU (Sept. 15) with a 68-yard touchdown run.

**BALANCED ATTACK:** Most football coaches want a balanced offensive attack and EMU head coach **Jeff Genyk** had exactly that in the thrilling 21-19 Mid-American Conference West Division win at Northern Illinois (Sept. 15). The Eagles had 189 yards rushing and 189 yards passing for 378 total offensive yards.

**116th SEASON OPENER:** The EMU at Pitt football game, Saturday, Sept. 1, was the 116th season-opening game for the Eagles and they now hold a 52-56-8 record in lid-lifters.

**CAPTAINS NAMED:** EMU will have five captains for the 2007 season. The captains, as voted by the players, are: **Ken Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)**, **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)**, **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)**, **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)**, and **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)**.

**SMALL SENIOR CLASS:** The senior class is the smallest group on the 2007 Eagles' roster. A total of 11 seniors will be suiting up for the last time for the Green and White this fall. The seniors are listed below.

**JEFF GENYK RADIO SHOW SET:** EMU head football coach **Jeff Genyk** will be the featured guest on the Monday evening radio show, "Green Eggs and Coffee", from 6 p.m.-7 p.m. each Monday of the football season. The shows, with WTKA radio's **Jeff Radford** and WEMU radio reporter **Brian Nemerovski** serving as co-hosts, will be broadcast live from WTKA's studio in Ann Arbor. The next show of the 2007 season will be Sept. 17.

**HOLTZCLAW EARNS WEEKLY MAC AWARD:** Junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** was named Mid-American Conference West Division Defensive Player of the Week for the Northern Illinois game, Sept. 15. The 6-foot-1 Holtzclaw had 13 tackles, one tackle-for-loss of three yards, one pass breakup and an interception in NIU territory that led to the game-winning EMU touchdown.

**LONG DISTANCE BEST:** EMU redshirt sophomore **Dontayo Gage (Pontiac, Mich.-Northern)** set a Rynearson Stadium record for an EMU player with a 90-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in EMU's 38-16 loss to Ball State Saturday (Sept. 8). That return was the third-best in stadium history. The record is 94 yards by Miami's Tremayne Banks, Oct. 12, 1996 while Western Michigan's Ron Rogers returned a kickoff 92 yards in a game played, Sept. 29, 2001. Gage's return broke the EMU Rynearson record of 88 yards by Craig Thompson, Sept. 9, 1993, versus Temple. That return was also just the fourth kickoff return for a touchdown in stadium history. It was also the first EMU return of any kind for a touchdown since Jerry Gaines returned a fumble 82 yards, Sept. 2, 2004, against Buffalo.

**WHITE JUST MISSES THE CENTURY MARK:** Sophomore **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, GA-Kell)** just missed the magic mark of 100 yards in receptions when he hauled in seven passes for 94 yards in the home opener against Ball State (Sept. 8).

**STARTING A HABIT:** Two EMU players have earned starts in every game during their Eagle careers. Long snapper **Jerry Topolinski (Grand Blanc, Mich.-Flint Powers)** has been a fixture in the long-snapping department for the Eagles, starting all 38 games the past four seasons. Middle linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** has started all 27 games during his three-year career. Offensive lineman **T.J. Lang (Ferndale, Mich.-Birmingham Brother Rice)** was a starter in all 12 games last season and has started all four games this season.

**STATELY BREAKDOWN:** The 2007 EMU football roster has 60 players from the state of Michigan, 16 from Ohio, seven from Florida, two each from Indiana and Virginia, and one apiece from Washington D.C., Wisconsin, Oklahoma, Illinois, New York and Georgia.

**BREAKING THE STREAK:** EMU's 21-19 win at Northern Illinois Saturday, Sept. 15, broke a six-game NIU winning streak over the Eagles and was the first for Eastern in DeKalb since a 38-10 win, Nov. 8, 1997, a four-game Huskie home winning string.

**DOUBLE DIGIT STOPS:** Two EMU linebackers turned in double-digit tackles in a 21-19 win at Northern Illinois, Sept. 15. Sophomore **Andre Hatchett (Indianapolis, Ind.-Warren Central)** and junior **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, OK-Enid)** both had 13 tackles.

**TWO-SPORT MAN:** EMU senior wide receiver **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)** is one of a handful of college football players that have double duties in both football and basketball. He has earned three letters in football and two in basketball. In football he has played in 38 games, starting 20 times with 58 career receptions for 585 yards with three touchdowns scored. Lewis joined the basketball team at the end of the 2005 and 2006 football seasons and has played in 43 games, starting 20 times, and has scored 101 points (2.4 ppg) and hauled down 167 (3.9 rpg) rebounds in those two years. He is known as one of the top defenders on the hoops squad and was named the winner of the Earl Boykins Award as the 2007 men's basketball team's top defensive player.

**PLAYERS GET A VOICE:** EMU head football coach **Jeff Genyk** has credited a newly formed Leadership Council with helping the team work harder in the off season. **COACH HAS A VOTE:** Eastern Michigan head football coach **Jeff Genyk** will be involved in weekly coaches' polls for 2007. Genyk, the fourth-year head coach of the Eagles' football squad, will be one of 60 head coaches that will vote in the weekly *USA Today* Coaches' Poll that will pick the top 25 teams in the NCAA Bowl Championship Series each week of the season.

**COLLEGIATE CLASH:** For the fourth year in a row the EMU football team will be taking one of its home games on the road, hosting a Big Ten team for the first time ever in the fourth annual Collegiate Clash at Ford Field, home of the Detroit Lions, in Detroit. EMU will be the host team for the non-conference battle with game time set for 7 p.m. Friday, Oct. 19. The Eagles hosted Central Michigan in the inaugural Collegiate Clash, Nov. 6, 2004, and Eastern won a thriller, 61-58, in four overtimes. In 2005 EMU hosted Western Michigan, Nov. 5, 2005, and lost a 44-36 shootout. Last year Navy recorded a 49-21 win, Nov. 5, 2006, in the game at Ford Field.

**ZACH JOHNSON NAMED TO PRESEASON RAY GUY LIST:**

EMU redshirt sophomore punter **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** has been named to the 2007 Ray Guy Award Preseason Watch List. He was one of 10 semifinalists for the 2006 award, won by Daniel Sepulveda of Baylor. Joining Johnson on this year's preseason watch list are Durant Brooks (Georgia Tech-Sr.), Geoff Price (Notre Dame-Sr.), Louie Sakoda (Utah-Jr.) and Sam Swank (Wake Forest-Jr.). The Ray Guy Award is presented to the nation's best collegiate punter as determined by a national selection committee comprised of sports writers, college football coaches, sports information directors, former punters and members designated by the Greater Augusta Sports Council. Among the statistics used to identify the Ray Guy Award winner are total yardage punted, number of times a punt is downed or kicked out of bounds inside the opponent's 20-yard line, net average, average returned yardage, and percentage of punts not returned. It is also of importance for the award winner to display team leadership, self-discipline and to have a positive impact on the team's success. The Ray Guy Award Watch List will be expanded after the start of the season when statistical figures can be added. The national voting body will then vote for the top three finalists who will be announced at the end of November. In December the top three finalists will be in Orlando, Fla. for the Home Depot College Football awards show. The winner will be announced live on ESPN. Johnson, who spent the entire 2006 season as the holder on field goal and PAT kick attempts, was the starting punter in the last 11 games of the season. Senior **Andrew Wellock (Canton, Ohio-Green)** was the returning field-goal kicker and punter when the 2006 season opened, and he started the first game of the 2006 season at both positions. Johnson was then called upon to take over the punting chores in game two and quickly established himself as one of the top punters in the NCAA Division I ranks. He finished the season with a 40.0 yard average, punting 65 times for 2,603 yards, including dropping 20 punts inside the 20-yard line. He was named an honorable mention Freshman All-American by *The Sporting News*.

**EAGLES DROP 27-3 OPENER AT PITT**

**PITTSBURGH, Pa.**—The Eastern Michigan University football team scored first but Pittsburgh came back with 27 unanswered points in a 27-3 setback for the Eagles here Saturday night in a non-conference game at Pitt's Heinz Field.

The game was the season opener for both teams and gives Pitt a 2-0 lead in the series.

Sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's Mich.-St. John's)** completed 16-of-27 passes for 106 yards. Senior **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** led the Eagles' rushing attack with 11 carries for 30 yards. Defensively, junior **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** led Eastern with 10 tackles, while sophomore **Chris May (Jupiter, Fla.-Dwyer)** added nine tackles.

The Panthers were led by junior quarterback Bill Stull who was 14-of-20 for 177 yards and a touchdown before leaving in the third quarter with an injury to his throwing hand. Freshman running back LeSean McCoy rushed for 68 yards while sophomore Shane Brooks rushed for 12 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

Eastern Michigan got on the board first with 3:30 left in the first quarter as redshirt freshman **Sean Dutcher (Owosso, Mich.-Owosso)** split the uprights for a 27-yard field goal to give the Eagles an early 3-0 advantage. However, Pittsburgh quickly drove 65 yards in five minutes before Shane Brooks scampered into the end zone for a touchdown with 1:26 left in the quarter to give the Panthers the 7-3 edge.

Following an EMU turnover the Panthers expanded the margin to 11 points, 14-3, as Bill Stull connected with Oderick Turner for a 21-yard touchdown strike with 14:05 remaining in the second quarter.

The Green and White strung together a 14-play, 49-yard drive midway through the second period, but the drive stalled at the 23-yard line. Dutcher once again was called upon to put points on the board but his 40-yard field goal attempt was just short.

That was all the scoring the rest of the period as the defense for both sides stepped up to limit the opposing offense. For the period the Eagles racked up 96 total yards compared to 154 for Pitt.

Following the intermission, the Panthers marched 60 yards in 11 plays before Brooks capped off the drive with a one-yard touchdown dive with 5:49 left in the third quarter. Pittsburgh would tack on a pair of late field goals to reach the game's final margin of 24, 27-3.

The Eagles return to Ypsilanti, Mich. next Saturday, Sept. 8, to open the Mid-American Conference portion of the schedule against West Division foe Ball State University. Game time is set for noon at EMU's Rynearson Stadium. The game is billed as Eagle Nation Day; at halftime of the contest, EMU will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the 1987 California Bowl and Mid-American Conference championships.

**EAGLES FALL IN MAC OPENER**

**YPSILANTI, Mich.** — The return of the players and coaching staff from the 1987 Mid-American Conference and California Bowl champions wasn't enough for the Eastern Michigan University football team as it fell to a visiting Ball State team, 38-16, here Saturday afternoon in Rynearson Stadium.

The day marked the 20th anniversary of the 1987 team and more than 75 players and coaches were on hand for the season opener.

It was a disappointing ending for both the guests and the current EMU squad as the Eagles were limited to just 262 yards in total offense to 459 for the Cardinals.

Despite the loss the Eagles had two bright plays during the game. The first one game as redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** connected with sophomore wide receiver **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, GA-Kell)** on a 67-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter. The second huge play came in the fourth quarter as sophomore wide receiver and kick return specialist **Dontayo Gage (Pontiac, Mich.-Northern)** set a Rynearson Stadium record with a 90-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. That return broke the stadium record of 88 yards by Craig Thompson against Temple (Sept. 9, 1993).

The Eagles' offense was paced by senior tailback **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** who rushed for 65 yards on 15 carries. Schmitt completed 16-of-24 passes for 155 yards and one touchdown.

Defensively the Eagles were led by the linebacking trio of **Andre Hatchett (Indianapolis, Ind.-Warren Central)**, **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, OK-Enid)** and **Darran Matthews (Redford, Mich.-Thurston)** with nine tackles each. EMU also recorded eight tackles-for-loss of 26 yards, with **Jason Jones (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** notching three for 10 yards.

Eastern, now 0-2 overall and 0-1 in MAC action, will travel to DeKalb, Ill. next Saturday, Sept. 15, for a MAC West Division battle with Northern Illinois. Game time is 11 a.m. (CDT).

With the win Ball State moves to 1-1 overall and 1-1 in the MAC.

EAGLES USE BLOCKED FIELD GOAL TO WIN THRILLER

DeKALB, Ill. — A blocked field goal by senior defensive end **Eric Young (Shiocton, Wisc.-Shiocton-North Iowa C.C.)** on the game's final play preserved a thrilling 21-19 Eastern Michigan University Mid-American Conference West Division victory over Northern Illinois here at Brigham Field at Huskie Stadium Saturday.

The visiting Eagles held the tenuous two-point lead when Northern Illinois took possession of the ball on the NIU 39-yard line with 1:54 left in the game.

The Huskies advanced the ball to the EMU 33-yard line and called time out with 11 seconds left and called on senior place-kicker Chris Nendick to attempt a 50-yard field goal.

That left it all up to the EMU defense and they rose to the occasion, getting a tremendous surge from the front four with Young breaking through for the timely block.

The last-second heroics were set up by a stingy EMU defense and a resurgent offense after the Eagles trailed 13-0 heading into the second quarter.

After that sluggish first quarter, the Green and White rallied to out score the Huskies 21-6 over the final three quarters.

Head coach **Jeff Genyk's** Eagles used a balanced offensive attack to pull off the win, recording 189 yards on the ground and 189 yards through the air.

Sophomore **DeAnthony White (Kennesaw, Ga.-Kell)** was the big-play man on offense, scoring on a 68-yard run and also had a 38-yard pass reception that led to a touchdown one play later. Senior tailback **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** was a workhorse on offense, rushing 25 times for 66 yards and two touchdown runs of one yard each.

Linebackers **Andre Hatchett (Indianapolis, Ind.-Warren Central)** and **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok.-Enid)** each recorded 13 tackles for the EMU defense.

After Northern Illinois raced out to the 13-0 lead, the Eagles got on the board with just 22 seconds left in the second quarter when Walker bulldozed through the NIU defense for a one-yard score with **Sean Dutcher (Owosso, Mich.-Owosso)** adding the PAT.

Eastern came out of halftime on a mission, taking its first lead of the game, 14-13, on the spectacular 68-yard touchdown run by White, aided by a downfield block by quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's. Mich.-St. John's)**. Dutcher added the PAT.

The Eagles increased that advantage to 21-13 on another one-yard Walker touchdown run after Holtzclaw intercepted a pass at the NIU 16-yard line. That was the sixth pick of Holtzclaw's career. Dutcher again added the PAT.

Northern pulled within two, 21-19, with 04:20 left on a seven-yard touchdown pass, missing a two-point conversion pass to set up the final late-game drama.

Eastern, now 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the MAC, will head out of MAC play this Saturday, Sept. 22, when it hosts Howard University in a 3:30 p.m. game in Rynearson Stadium.

**EAGLES MAKE IT TWO IN A ROW WITH 38-15 WIN OVER HOWARD**

**YPSILANTI, Mich.** — The Eastern Michigan University football team made it two consecutive wins with a convincing 38-15 non-conference win over a visiting Howard University squad here Saturday, Sept. 22, in Rynearson Stadium.

EMU redshirt sophomore quarterback **Andy Schmitt (St. John's, Mich.-St. John's)** directed an Eagles' offense that took advantage of five Howard turnovers to score a season-high 38 points. Schmitt completed 14-of-21 passes for 214 yards and four touchdowns, tying the EMU record for second-most touchdown passes in a single game.

Schmitt called on four different receivers for touchdowns in the game. Schmitt hooked up with freshman tailback **Dwayne Priest (Roanoke, Va.-William Fleming-Fork Union Academy)** on a 24-yard touchdown strike followed by a four-yard touchdown pass to senior **Ken Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)**, a 35-yard TD strike to redshirt freshman **Tyrone Burke (Syracuse, NY-Corcoran)** and a 10-yard scoring strike to senior **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)**.

Redshirt sophomore punter **Zach Johnson (Springboro, Ohio-Springboro)** turned in an outstanding special teams effort, punting six times for a 41.8 yards, booting a field goal of 22 yards and kicking all five PAT's.

Defensively, the Eagles were paced by junior linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Ok-Enid)** who had a career-best 19 tackles, the 12th double-digit effort in his three seasons on the team.

The Eagles pounced on the Bison early, recovering the game's opening kickoff on the Howard 19-yard line. Senior **Pierre Walker (Detroit, Mich.-Central)** then rushed twice, for 12 yards on the first run followed by a seven-yard touchdown burst on the second play from scrimmage. Johnson added the PAT for a 7-0 lead.

Johnson then booted a 22-yard field goal to stake the Eagles to a 10-0 lead. Priest caught his 24-yard touchdown pass from Schmitt with Johnson adding the PAT to help EMU close out the first half with a 17-0 advantage.

The Eagles then scored twice in the third quarter, on Bohnet's four-yard reception and Burke's 35-yard score. Johnson booted both PAT's for a 31-0 EMU lead with 3:59 left in the third quarter.

Howard finally got on the board with two quick scores, the first an 11-yard pass to make it 31-7 with 40 seconds left in the third quarter. The second came on a 27-yard pass followed by a two-point conversion to cut EMU's lead to 31-15 with just 6:19 left in the game.

The Eagles left little doubt at the end, however, with Lewis scoring on his 10-yard reception with just 00:35 left. Johnson's PAT made the final score, 38-15.

Eastern, now 2-2 on the season will travel to Nashville, Tenn. Saturday, Sept. 29, to battle Vanderbilt University from the Southeastern Conference.
