HITTING THE ROAD: After opening the season with three home wins in the friendly confines of the RBC Center, NC State hits the road for the first time when it travels to New Jersey to face No. 18 Vanderbilt in the championship round of the fifth-annual Legends Classic on Saturday night at 6:30 p.m.

Joining the Wolfpack and Commodores in the championship round are Texas and Oregon State.

SCOUTING THE FIELD:

- Vanderbilt: The Commodores enter this weekend with a 2-1 record following an 80-68 home win over Bucknell on Tuesday. The 'Dores bounced back from their first loss of the year, a 71-58 upset loss to Cleveland State last Sunday. They opened the year with a 78-64 win over Oregon (11/11/11).

John Jenkins leads Vandy in scoring, averaging 20.5 points per game, despite missing the last game with an injury. Jeffery Taylor and Lance Goulbourne are the squad's top rebounders with each hauling down 7.0 boards per contest.

- Oregon State is 3-0 after an 82-72 victory over Hofstra on Wednesday. The Beavers opened the year with an 86-62 win versus Cal State Bakersfield (11/12/11) followed by a 93-60 triumph over West Alabama (11/14/11).

Jared Cunningham is OSU's top scorer with an average of 22.3 points per outing. Joe Burton and Eric Moreland are the team's top rebounders with each averaging 7.0 rebounds per game.

- Texas is off to a 2-0 start with victories over Boston University and Rhode Island. The Longhorns posted an 82-46 season-opening win over BU (11/13/11) followed by a 100-90 triumph over Rhode Island (11/15/11).

J'Covan Brown leads UT in scoring with an average of 31.5 points per game, while Clint Chapman is the squad's leading rebounder, pulling down 6.0 rebounds per game.

GOTTFRIED VERSUS VANDERBILT: Mark Gottfried is 5-5 all-time in meetings with the Commodores.

In head-to-head match ups with Vandy head coach Kevin Stallings, Gottfried holds 5-4 advantage.

WHITTENBURG ON THE CALL: Former NC State standout Dereck Whittenburg will provide the color analysis for ESPN's broadcasts of the Pack's two games in New Jersey.

Whittenburg helped NC State to the 1983 national title, including scoring 14 points in the championship game.

In the waning seconds of the title game against Houston, Whittenburg ended up with the ball in his hands, launching a shot that missed, but the carom landed in the hands of teammate Lorenzo Charles who dunked the put back for the win, sealing the Pack's second national crown.

PAINTER'S SPLASH GIVES STATE WIN OVER PRINCETON: Junior center DeShawn Painter knocked down a jumper with 4.2 seconds left to give NC State a 60-58 comeback victory over Princeton on Wednesday at home.

Painter finished with 11 points, the first time in his career that he has had three straight double-figure games.

Sophomore Lorenzo Brown, who missed Tuesday's practice due illness, showed no effects from the virus with 16 points and eight

assists.

Joining Painter and Brown in double figures were senior C.J. Williams and junior Richard Howell with 10 points each. Howell also grabbed nine rebounds.

Graduate student Alex Johnson broke the Pack's drought from three-point range with a conversion with 1:57 left in the game. State's effort from long range were hampered when junior sharp shooter Scott Wood went down with a rolled ankle two minutes into the game.

It was the Pack's first win over the Tigers since the two teams first met in the 1952 Dixie Classic with State prevailing, 87-63.

STRONG OUT OF THE GATE: With the Princeton win, NC State has now opened the last four seasons with a mark of 3-0.

SERVING IT UP: It's only three games into Lorenzo Brown's tenure as the Wolfpack's point guard and he is averaging 7.6 assists per outing.

Against UNC Asheville, Brown recorded a career-best nine assists.

LESLIE TO RETURN FOR VANDERBILT GAME: Junior forward C.J. Leslie, who sat out the first three games of the season after it was determined that he and a relative had received impermissible benefits totaling \$410, will make his season debut against the Commodores.

NC State reported the violations to the NCAA. The university and the NCAA conducted a joint inquiry to determine the facts.

Following an auto accident in May 2011, Leslie borrowed a car from a friend and former NC State student. He used the car for about a week.

In addition, the facts indicate that the same former student paid apartment application fees for Leslie's half-brother.

Leslie also will make charitable contributions of \$410. The contributions represent the value of the car had it been rented (\$150) and the application fees (\$260).

Leslie was declared ineligible by the university and a reinstatement was requested through the NCAA, which granted the request on Tuesday, Nov. 8, provided he meet the stipulations of sitting out three games and making a charitable contributions.

A TRIMMER HOWELL, IS A BETTER HOWELL: It didn't take long for NC State coach Mark Gottfried and Wolfpack fans to see the

results of a slimmed down junior forward Richard Howell.

Howell dropped 11 pounds from his frame going down from 261 a year ago to 250 to start the season and effects were all positive.

Against Morehead State, he posted a career-high 25 points.

Through three games, Howell leads the team in scoring, averaging 16.3 points per game, and rebounding, grabbing 10.7 boards per contest. At the line, he is 81 percent (13-16) for the year.

SCOTT WOOD IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Junior forward Scott Wood is 10th all-time for consecutive starts at NCSU with 70.

Wood is now 13th on the career three-point field goals made with 142. He moves past Brandon Costner following his 5-of-8 showing from long range against Morehead State.

PAINT PRODUCTION: Through the first three games of the year, junior center DeShawn Painter's production has picked up from a year ago.

Last season, Painter averaged 4.6 points per game, while pulling down 3.5 rebounds a game, while shooting 47 percent from the floor and 63 percent from the line. He also notched a double-double of 12 points, 10 rebounds in an 85-65 win over East Carolina.

This year, he is averaging 14.0 points per game and seven rebounds per contest. He also a logged double-double against UNC Asheville (12 points, 12 rebounds) and has scored in double figures in three consecutive games for the first time in his State career.

PACK INKS NO. 2 CLASS IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD: On Nov. 9, first-year NC State basketball coach Mark Gottfried announced the signings of Tyler Lewis (Statesville, N.C.), Rodney Purvis (Raleigh, N.C.) and T.J. Warren (Durham, N.C.) to play for the Wolfpack beginning with the 2012-13 season.

"We're extremely excited about Tyler, Rodney and T.J.," said Gottfried. "They are great additions to our team. We like that they are great people, and they have the to potential to become great players."

The highly touted trio is considered one of the premier classes by several recruiting services and media outlets. According to ESPNU 100 rankings, Gottfried has assembled the No. 2 class in the nation, while Rivals.com has rated the Wolfpack's incoming class as the No. 3 class in the country.

"The class that Mark Gottfried has put together will change the direction of the program," said Paul Biancardi, National Director of Recruiting for ESPN. "This is an impressive class considering the team is coming off some tough years. The perception of NC State is changing under Mark Gottfried. He and his staff will not be outworked."

GOTTFRIED PARTICIPATES IN SHOTS FROM THE HEART: NC State coach Mark Gottfried is among field of head coaches participating in Shots From The Heart program.

The concept was developed by Collegeinsider.com co-founder Angela Lento to help raise awareness for heart disease and benefit the Skip Prosser Foundation.

The coaches participating will shoot 25 free throws at their convenience with a athletic department official on hand to verify the results. The coaches hitting the most free throws in each round will advance to the next. The shots are weighted in value with shots 1-10 are worth a point, 11-15 are worth two points, 16-20 are worth three points, 21-24 are worth four points and the final shot is worth five points.

Prosser spent 21 years as a collegiate head coach at Loyola (MD), Xavier and Wake Forest, making 18 postseason appearances during that span.

Other coaches participating are Mike Brey (Notre Dame), Johnny Dawkins (Stanford), Fred Hoiberg (Iowa State), Jim Larranaga (Miami), Bill Self (Kansas) and Brad Stevens (Butler).

HEAD COACH TIMES THREE: Mark Gottfried may have given his first team an distinct advantage with inclusion of assistants Orlando Early and Bobby Lutz on his staff.

Both aides have served as head coaches with Early spending five years at the helm of Louisiana Monroe and Lutz spending 12 years as the head man at Charlotte.

In Early's second year (2006-07) at ULM, he guided his squad to a 18-14 mark, its first winning mark since 2001-02, and a share of the Sun Belt Western Division crown. His effort garnered him league coach of the year honors.

Lutz owns the distinction of being the winningest coach in 49er history with a 218-158 mark. He guided Charlotte to a school-record five 20-win seasons. Lutz also led the 49ers to a eight postseason appearances (five NCAA, three NIT).

NO REST FOR THE WEARY: In addition to NC State's tough slate of competition to start the season, the Wolfpack's schedule features a combined 14 games in the months of November and December. The 14 games are the most played since the Pack played 13 contests in the 2009-10 and 2001-02 campaigns.

THREE FOR REYNOLDS: The Wolfpack returns to its former stomping grounds when it hosts three games at Reynolds Coliseum this year. NC State will take on in-state foes Elon (Nov. 25), North Carolina Central (Dec. 11) and Campbell (Dec. 29).

The Wolfpack played in Reynolds starting with the 1949-50 season to the 1998-99 campaign. Over that 50-year span, NC State amassed a record of 589-177 (.769).

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION: This season, NC State will make 26 television appearances.

The Wolfpack games will be broadcast on the ESPN family of networks, Fox Sports, Raycom, The ACC Network and via the ACC Digital platform. NC State's 2011-12 television debut will be against Morehead State on ESPN3 on Nov. 13.

PENDING WOLFPACK MILESTONES:

-First-year head coach Mark Gottfried needs 19 wins to reach 300 career victories.

-Junior Richard Howell needs 82 points to reach 500. He needs 135 rebounds to reach 500.

-Sophomore C.J. Leslie needs 169 points to reach 500. He needs 289 rebounds to reach 500.

-Senior C.J. Williams needs 76 points to reach 500.

Charles died this past June in a bus accident in the Raleigh area.

Charles' dunk of Dereck Whittenburg's missed jumper as time expired sealed 1983 national championship for NC State and completed one of the most amazing runs in NCAA Tournament history.
