13-3 STARTS:

Auburn is off to its best start at 13-3 since the 2007 team started out the year 14-2 ... That team was 18-3 heading into SEC play and finished the year 31-25 (10-20 SEC) ... Auburn's best-ever 16-game start was in 1997 when it was 16-0.

OPENING SEC PLAY:

Auburn opens up SEC play this weekend against No. 2 Vanderbilt ... It is the first time Auburn opens up league play against Vanderbilt since the 1989 season, when Auburn took two-of-three from the Commodores ... Under John Pawlowski (since 2009), Auburn has won its opening conference series all four times, winning a series at Tennessee in 2009, sweeping a series at Georgia in 2010, winning a home series against No. 9 Arkansas in 2011 and winning at No. 12 Ole Miss in 2012.

AUBURN VS. NO. 2:

Auburn is facing the No. 2 team for the second straight SEC weekend after closing the 2012 season against No. 2 Florida at home ... Auburn dropped that series to end the season 13-17 in league play ... The last time Auburn won a series against a team ranked as high as No. 2 was in 2008, when it took two-of-three at home from No. 2 Kentucky.

AUBURN VS. VANDERBILT:

Auburn holds a 79-42 series advantage over Vanderbilt since 1949 and is 41-13 against the Commodores at home ... Vanderbilt has won each of the past three series, including a sweep at Auburn in 2001 when Vanderbilt was No. 1 ... Auburn's last series win was in 2009 when it dropped the first game but rebounded to win the last two, including an 11-10 win in the Sunday series finale.

KOGER LOOKING FOR THE ELUSIVE FIRST WIN:

Sophomore left-handed starting pitcher Daniel Koger is still in search of his first win of the season and is the only weekend starter yet to record one for Auburn ... The Friday night starter all four weekends, Koger has left three games with the lead but has yet to earn a win, though Auburn is 2-2 in his four starts and is averaging 5.8 runs per game in support of him ... Koger's last regular-season win was on April 28, 2012 against Tennessee, a span of seven regular-season starts.

O'NEAL IS PERFECT AT 4-0:

Junior left-handed pitcher Michael O'Neal is in a class of his own in Auburn history ... Standing at 4-0, he is the first first-year pitcher going back to 1983 to have won each of his first four starts ... He is currently 11th in the SEC with a 1.40 ERA and his four wins are tied for second in the SEC ... In 25 2/3 innings, he has allowed just two extra-base hits and is holding opponents to a .204 batting average ... The last player to earn the win in his first four appearances was Jon Luke Jacobs in 2012 while the last time a player in his first year at Auburn won his first four decisions was in 2010 when both Cole Nelson and Slade Smith did it.

KENDALL MAKES '13 DEBUT:

Junior left-handed pitcher Will Kendall made his 2013 debut on Tuesday at Kennesaw State after missing the first 15 games following Tommy John surgery ... In his debut, he allowed one hit and struck out two in a scoreless inning (23 pitches) ... Appearing in nine games last season (six starts), he was 4-0 with a 1.88 ERA before injuring his pitching arm on April 7 in a start at Alabama ... At the time of his injury, his 1.88 ERA was fourth in the SEC.

EBERT'S 13-GAME HITTING STREAK ENDS:

Jordan Ebert had his season-best 13-game hitting streak end on Tuesday night at Kennesaw State with an 0-for-3 showing at the plate ... The freshman from Foley, Ala., went 19-for-47 (.404) during the streak and of his 19 hits, 17 went for singles along with a double and a home run ... He scored nine runs and drove in six RBI all while hitting in the nine hole in the lineup ... His 13-game hitting streak was the longest by an Auburn freshman since Sean Gamble hit in 13 straight games as a freshman in 2002 ... He did reach base on a walk to extend his consecutive games reaching base safely to 14.

KENDRICK TAKING CHARGE:

Junior pitcher Conner Kendrick threw six innings of shut-

out baseball at the Capital City Classic to earn the game's MVP as Auburn won the event for the fifth straight year ... On the season the lefty is 1-0 with two saves and a perfect 0.00 ERA, having tossed 16 1/3 innings ... He has allowed just nine base runners (four hits, five walks) and is holding teams to a .077 batting average, best in the SEC ... Of those four hits, three have come to the first hitter he has faced out of the bullpen and he has never allowed two hits in a game ... He also has a team-high 22 strike outs.

EVERYDAY DAMEK:

Junior third baseman Damek Tomscha has reached base safely in every game this season, best on the team, and has a .420 on base percentage, hitting .245 and drawing 12 walks ... He has also been bit by a pitch four times while he has struck out just seven times in 53 at bats.

PAWLOWSKI IN YEAR FIVE:

Auburn head coach John Pawlowski is in his fifth season at Auburn ... In five seasons he is 147-106 (.581) ... In his 14th season as a head coach, he is 485-298-1 (.619) overall ... In his fifth season, he is the longest-tenured coach at Auburn since Hal Baird's 16-year run (1985-00) and the fourth-longest tenured overall ... With the team's 6-3 win over Brown on Sunday, March 10, he became the third-

FRESHMEN OFFENSIVE IMPACT:

Auburn has regularly started true freshmen Jackson Burgreen and Jordan Ebert in the lineup this season and the duo has hit a combined .303 (37-for-122) and has five of the team's 33 doubles (fifth in the SEC) and scored 26 of the team's 108 runs (24 percent).

PITCHING LEADING THE WAY:

Auburn's pitching staff has a 2.75 ERA through the first 16 games, good enough for eighth in the SEC ... The 2.75 ERA is the lowest for an Auburn pitching staff after 16 games since the 2001 staff had a combined 2.23 ERA in an 15-1 start ... That club had allowed 35 earned runs through 141 innings while this year's team has allowed 44 in 144 innings ... The '01 staff finished with a 4.05 ERA as the team went 37-21, 15-15 SEC and played in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional in coach Steve Renfroe's first season.

COME-FROM-BEHIND WINS:

Auburn has already amassed eight come-from-behind wins this season, coming back from a one-run deficit five times and a two-run deficit three times ... Last year Auburn had just nine come-from-behind wins the entire season ... In total, the winning team has come-from-behind to win in 10 of 16 games.

ONE-RUN GAMES:

Auburn has already played five one-run games and is 3-2 in them ... All five of the one-run games this season featured come-from-behind wins for the winner ... Auburn played 18 one-run games last season, going 8-10 in those games.

BULLPEN BULLIES:

Auburn's bullpen is currently 7-2 with a 3.11 ERA and six saves ... Five of the six saves have come from five different people with just Conner Kendrick picking up two ... Justin Camp (2-0), Chase Williamson (2-0) and Terrance Dedrick (1-2) have been involved in multiple decisions ... Combined the bullpen has a .241 opponent batting average and has struck out 51 over 63 2/3 innings.

AUSTIN AND THE RECORD BOOKS:

Junior catcher Blake Austin has now registered 25 caught stealing by in his three year career, which is currently ninth in Auburn history ... He needs two more to pass Kirby Clark (1995-96) for eighth.

WHERE EVERYBODY KNOWS YOUR NAME:

Auburn plays its first 11 and 18 of its first 20 games all at Plainsman Park this year and is already 11-3 at home ... In John Pawlowski's five-year reign, Auburn is 104-52 (.667) at Plainsman Park, going 22-13 in 2009, 30-9 in 2010, 19-14 in 2011 and 22-13 in 2012 ... Auburn will play a total of 34 home games this season.

***** SEASON-LONG NOTES *****

INSIDE THE PARK HOME RUNS:

Ryan Tella's first home run of the season was an inside the park job against College of Charleston ... It was the first inside the park home run by an Auburn player since Trent Mummey did it at Florida State in 2009 and the first by an Auburn player at Plainsman Park since Jeff Boutwell hit an inside the park grand slam against Florida in 2005.

WALKING OFF ON OPENING DAY:

Damek Tomscha's walk-off home run against Maine on Opening Day was Auburn's first walk-off home run since Brian Fletcher hit a walk-off against Boston College on Feb. 26, 2010 ... Tomscha's walk-off was the fourth for Auburn on an Opening Day since 1979, joining Tony Haney (1987), Sean Gamble (2003) and Justin Hargett (2009).

EXPERIENCED LINEUP:
