COMMODORES ADVANCE TO FOURTH NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Making its fourth trip in seven years under the direction of head coach **Martha Richards**, the Vanderbilt women's golf team returns to compete in the NCAA Championship, May 22-25, at the LPGA International Legends Course in Daytona Beach, Fla.

The Commodores qualified for the event after finishing sixth at the NCAA Central Regional (34-over par 886) in Ann Arbor Mich. on May 12. Vanderbilt is back at the NCAA Championship for the first time since the 2004 campaign. That year, Vanderbilt won the NCAA Central Regional and finished fifth at the NCAA Championship - completing a three-year run of appearances at the event. VU had never advanced to the NCAA Championship prior to Richards' arrival in June 2000.

Jacqui Concolino became the first player in school history to win medalist honors at an NCAA regional when she carded a career-best 5-under 208 to win the NCAA Central Regional on May 12. The Orlando, Fla., native and First Team All-Southeastern Conference performer has ranked among the Top 10 players in the nation throughout the year. Concolino has nine Top 10 finishes in 11 events as a sophomore. She will be making her first appearance at the NCAA Championship after missing the invite as an individual by one stroke last year at the NCAA East Regional. She leads the Commodores with a 72.23 stroke average.

Seniors **Kristen Svicarovich** and **Chris Brady** are the only current Commodores with experience at the NCAA Championship. Svicarovich has made two previous appearances: tying for 69th place (15-over 303) as a freshman when Vanderbilt participated as a team in 2004 and tying for 16th place (12-over 296) a year later after qualifying as an individual. Brady tied for 28th place (6-over 294) as a freshman with the Commodores.

Golf Digest magazine's 2006 College Golf Guide ranked the Vanderbilt women's program fourth in the nation. As the top program in the Southeastern Conference, Vanderbilt earned elite status for its coaching, facilities, academics and player growth.

Svicarovich is enjoying her best season as a Commodore with a career-best five Top 10 finishes. She currently ranks second on the team with a 74.68 stroke average. Brady has carded five Top 20 finishes this season.

Other Commodores competing this week at the NCAA Championship include junior **Liebelei Lawrence** and freshman **Brooke Goodwin**. Both have posted three Top 20 finishes this season.

Eight teams and the top two individuals from non-qualifying teams have advanced from each of the three NCAA regionals to compete at the NCAA Championship.

VANDERBILT'S HISTORY AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Vanderbilt is making its fourth appearance at the NCAA Championship, its first since 2004. The magical season of 2004 witnessed the Commodores winning medalist honors at both the SEC Championship and the NCAA Central Regional before finishing fifth the NCAA Championship (at 28-over 1180).

Vanderbilt also reached the NCAA Championship in 2002 (18th place) and 2003 (14th place).

The top finish by a Vanderbilt individual came in 2004 when **Sarah Jacobs** -- the Commodores' current volunteer assistant coach -- tied for sixth.

• Sophomore **Jacqui Concolino** just missed qualifying for the NCAA Championship a year ago as a freshman. She tied for 10th place with an even par 216 at the NCAA East Regional, finishing one stroke shy of the NCAA Championship.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS & NOTES

• Vanderbilt sophomore **Jacqui Concolino** continues to enjoy another All-America year. The Florida native became the first Commodore in school history to win medalist honors at an NCAA regional when she posted a 5-under par 208 at the NCAA Central Regional on May 14. It marked her ninth Top 10 finish in 11 events this season.

A First Team All-SEC selection, Concolino enters her first NCAA Championship appearance with a 72.23 stroke average and ranks as one of the nation's top women's collegiate golf players. She has carded 16 rounds of golf at par or better this season.

• Vanderbilt has had a player named First Team All-SEC for a school-record five consecutive seasons. Last year, Concolino became the first freshman in program history to earn first-team recognition.

• Commodore senior **Kristen Svicarovich** was named Second Team All-SEC. She is enjoying her best season as a Commodore with five Top 10 finishes. She tied for fourth at the Arizona Wildcat Invitational with a 3-over par 216. Svicarovich is a four-time selection to the Dean's List and a three-time

honoree to the SEC Academic Honor Roll. She graduated magna cum laude from Vanderbilt on Friday and will attend the University of Texas in the fall after earning a fellowship to pursue her Master's and doctorate in transportation engineering.
