• Old Dominion is coming off a 66-51 shoot out loss at Western Kentucky where the two teams combined for 1,243 total yards

• ODU is on the road for the third-straight week to take on an SEC school for the first time in school history, Vanderbilt, on Saturday, Nov. 1 at 7 p.m. EST.

• The Monarchs have lost four-straight since beating defending Conference USA Champions Rice, 45-42. It was ODU's first-ever conference game. Rice has not lost since that game.

• Senior quarterback Taylor Heinicke passed for a season-high 471 yards on 27-of-40 passes and three touchdowns at WKU.

• True freshman running back Ray Lawry started for the first time last week at WKU, and rushed 25 times for 148 yards and four touchdowns. All were career highs and the four touchdowns tied the school record for touchdowns in a game with Thomas DeMarco. It was Lawry's third multi-touchdown game of the year.

• Senior wide receiver Antonio Vaughan caught six passes for a career-best 220 yards, the second highest single-game total in school history. His shortest catch of the game was 19 yard touchdown catch. Vaughan is tied for third in the country in touchdown catches with nine.

• Sophomore Melvin Vaughn led ODU with eight receptions for 94 yards and a touchdown. Both numbers are career highs.

• ODU Head Coach Bobby Wilder is 49-19 in his six years in Norfolk. The former Maine offensive coordinator led ODU to FCS playoff berths in 2011 and 2012 along with a CAA Championship in 2012.

• Old Dominion will play a full Conference USA schedule for the first time in school history in just the sixth season since it restarted football in 2009. The Monarchs are eligible for the C-USA Championship and berth in the C-USA Championship game played on Saturday, Dec. 6.

• Senior quarterback Taylor Heinicke returns for his senior season for the Monarchs. Heinicke passed for 4,022 yards and 33 touchdowns as a junior after winning the Walter Payton Award as the top player in the FCS as a sophomore. He is one of just 18 Division I QB's to pass for 10,000 yards and rush for 1,000 and was the first Division I quarterback in Virginia to pass for 10,000 or more career yards.

Bobby Wilder
Head Coach
Maine, 1987
49-19 (Five Years)

When he was hired on February 13, 2007, Bobby Wilder's goal was to "AIM HIGH" in everything he did in resurrecting the Old Dominion football team from a 69-year absence. Wilder has grown the football program from the best FCS start-up program to FBS in just five years. ODU plays its first full season in FBS in 2014, playing 11 FBS teams for the first time in school history.

ODU will play its first Conference USA season in 2014 and when the Monarchs host Eastern Michigan on Sept. 13, it will mark the first FBS home game in school history. Continuing the theme of firsts, the Monarchs will host Middle Tennessee on national TV Friday, Sept. 26, the first ODU game not played on a Saturday.

In 2013, the Monarchs began their transition to FBS and Conference USA, playing five FBS opponents, the first five in school history. ODU finished the season 8-4, completing its first unbeaten season at home going 6-0, and defeating Idaho 59-38 to deliver the programs first victory over an FBS school. For the second-straight season, the ODU offense averaged more than 40 points a game, averaging 42.3 points per game, which would have ranked seventh among FBS schools.

Since restarting its football team in 2009, Old Dominion has compiled a four-year total of 38 wins and only 10 losses while twice advancing to the FCS Playoffs.

Wilder led the Monarchs to a school-record 11-2 record in 2012.

Under Wilder's tutelage, the Monarchs led the FCS in scoring offense, total offense and passing offense in 2012 as the Monarchs won the Colonial Athletic Association Championship in its final season in the FCS. In the always tough CAA, ODU defeated four ranked opponents and was ranked in the top-10 all season.

ODU earned the No. 4 national seed in the FCS Playoffs, advanced to the quarterfinals and ranked No. 6 in the final The Sports Network and coaches polls.

Old Dominion featured 10 student-athletes on the CAA All-Conference team including the Offensive Player of the Year in quarterback Taylor Heinicke. Heinicke's honors continued to roll in, earning six All-America honors, while also winning the Dudley Award given to the top division I player in Virginia and the Walter Payton Award for the top player in the FCS.

Top honors were not just awarded to Wilder's players, as Wilder was named American Football Monthly Coach of the Year and also the CaptainU Coach of the Year.

In 2011, the Monarchs concluded the year at 10-3 overall and ranked No. 10 in The Sports Network/Fathead.com and FCS Coaches Final Polls, the fastest climb to the top-10 of any start-up program. In their first season of conference play in the Colonial Athletic Association, considered by many the toughest FCS conference in the nation, ODU went 6-2 against league opponents. Picked to finish 10th in the CAA Preseason Poll, ODU ended the year in a tie for second place in the CAA, a conference which sent five teams to the post-season. The Monarchs were among those five teams advancing to the FCS playoffs where they defeated MEAC Champions Norfolk State in first round action and advanced to the second round of the playoffs against Georgia Southern in one of the most thrilling games of the Division I Football Championships.

The 2011 season also brought a host of accolades for the program. In addition to 11 Monarchs being honored as All-CAA student-athletes, senior defensive lineman Ronnie Cameron was named the CAA Defensive Player of the Year. Cameron and punter Jonathan Plisco brought home numerous All-America honors and freshman quarterback Taylor Heinicke was the runner-up for The Sport Network's Jerry Rice Award as the FCS' top freshman and was honored as the College Football Performance Awards' National Performer of the Year.

Additionally, Wilder was named College Sports Madness' National Coach of the Year and he finished third in voting for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year Award.

Prior to his arrival at ODU, Wilder served on the Maine staff for the past 17 years and was promoted to assistant head coach and offensive coordinator in 2000 before moving to associate head coach in 2001.

As coordinator, Wilder orchestrated a balanced attack. The Black Bears averaged 29.1 points per game in 2004, and scored 29 or more in seven of 11 games. Wilder helped tutor running back Marcus Williams, who rushed for 1,077 yards during his senior season, which moved him into first place in school history for career rushing yards. Maine also threw the ball a lot during the campaign as eight different receivers each had double-digit receptions. Ron Whitcomb was at the head of the passing attack as his completions (213) and attempts (350) were the fourth most in a single season since 1950. His 22 touchdown tosses were tied for third most since 1950. Overall, the offense averaged an impressive 5.2 yards per play.

Wilder was named the Assistant Coach of the Year by the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston in 2004, which is presented annually to the top assistant coach in New England.

In 2003, the Black Bears had over 2,000 yards rushing and passing with 4,142 total yards. The ground game was anchored by Williams and the passing game was in the hands of then-freshman Ron Whitcomb, who was named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Year as he posted 2,428 yards - the fifth most in a season at Maine.

A 1987 graduate of Maine with a degree in physical education, Wilder captained the Black Bears to the Yankee Conference Championship his senior year. An All-New England quarterback in 1985, he left Maine as the school's all-time leading passer with 4,493 yards, and is currently sixth behind Mike Buck, Emilio Colon, Fein, Eaton and Whitcomb on the career passing list. A 1982 graduate of Madison High School in Madison, Maine, Wilder was a highly recruited quarterback his senior year. He opted to attend Maine and in his sophomore year and led the Black Bears to their first of five consecutive winning seasons.

Upon graduation, Wilder served as a graduate assistant coach for two seasons under Jack Bicknell at Boston College, where he earned his master's degree in educational administration in 1990.

Wilder and his wife, Pam, live in Norfolk with their sons, Derek (18) and Drew (13).

Hauling Them In

Zach Pascal had three catches for 54 yards in the loss at Western Kentucky.

Pascal is fifth in Conference USA with 40 receptions and third with 563 receiving yards.

For his career, Pascal has 81 receptions for 1,098 yards and 11 touchdowns.

Hauling Them In (Part Two)

Senior Antonio Vaughan had a record-setting day in the loss at Western Kentucky, catching six passes for a career-high 220 yards, the second most receiving yards in school history. His 36.6 yards per catch set a school record as his shortest reception went for a 19 yard touchdown.

Vaughan is seventh in the league in receptions and leads C-USA with 653 receiving yards.

In his four years at ODU, Vaughan has 204 catches for 2,901 yards and 30 touchdowns. He holds school records in both receptions and receiving yards, and is tied with Nick Mayers with 30 receiving touchdowns.

Put Me in Coach

Backup quarterback David Washington started the first game of his career at NC State, at wide receiver. With ODU losing several receivers over the summer, Washington moved to receiver and has performed well in practice. He caught his first career pass in the win at Hampton, and caught his first TD at NC State. He joins Antonio Vaughan as the only two Monarchs to throw, catch and run for a touchdown.

Washington had four receptions for 36 yards at W. Kentucky.

The Other Vaughn

Sophomore Melvin Vaughn had a career day at WKU, registering eight catches for 94 yards and a touchdown. In the first seven games, Vaughn had 10 catches for 103 yards.

Changing of the Guard

Due in part to injuries and other reasons, the ODU offensive line has had four different starting lineups in six games this year. That however, has not effected the groups work, as ODU has run the ball for 152.4 yards per game. Senior center Josh Mann and sophomore guard Tyler Compton are the only two to have started every game. Compton has started four at right guard, and one at left guard. True freshman Darius Garcia has started the last four games at right tackle.

2014 Captains

ODU Head Coach Bobby Wilder named five captains for the 2014 season, the most in an a single-season for the six-year program.

Antonio Vaughan, Taylor Heinicke, Andre Simmons, Eriq Lewis and Josh Mann earned the honor. Heinicke is a three-time captain while this is the second-straight year for Simmons. Vaughan, Lewis and Mann are first-time captain.

On the Run

In his first career start, true freshman Ray Lawry recorded his third-straight 100-yard game with 25 carries for 148 yards and four touchdowns. The carries and yards are career highs while his four touchdowns tied the ODU single-game record with former quarterback, Thomas DeMarco.

Ray Lawry rushed for over 100-yards to lead the Monarchs offense in the loss at UTEP. He carried just 13 times for 117 and two touchdowns. His 9.0 average per carry was the second highest in school history

True freshman Ray Lawry rushed for a career-high 131-yards last week against Marshall. His 8.2 average per carry is the third highest in school history.

Lawry is ninth in C-USA in rushing and has 74 attempts for 551 yards and 11 touchdowns, which is the third most in a single-season in school history. Lawry's 11 rushing touchdowns are the third most in the country by a freshman, behind just Jarvion Franklin of Western Michigan (19) and Royce Freeman of Oregon (13). All three players are true freshmen.

About the Monarchs

- Old Dominion's home field of Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium, which holds 20,118, has sold out all 39 of its games to date, including all home games in 2013. ODU fans purchased more than 14,000 season tickets for the 2014 season. The Monarchs are 30-9 all-time and went 6-0 last season in front of the home crowd.

- Junior quarterback Taylor Heinicke put together one of the best single seasons among FCS quarterbacks of all time. Heinicke became the first FCS quarterback to throw for more than 5,000 yards in a single season (5,076). The Atlanta, Ga. native tossed an FCS best 44 touchdown passes and ran for 11 more for an FCS best 55 TD's.

- The Monarchs made history on September 5th, 2009 when a three-year dream became a reality. On May 31, 2006, the ODU board of visitors voted to add football and 1,293 days later, the Monarchs kicked off their first season of Division I FCS play. ODU played an 11-game schedule, including seven home dates at the \$24.8 million renovated Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

- Old Dominion started out as a two-year branch campus of William and Mary in 1930. ODU had a football program from 1930-41. The program was disbanded due to a rule not allowing freshman to play anymore.

- ODU has an enrollment of just over 24,600, and is best known for education, business and engineering majors.

- Notable ODU alumni consists of: Ben Bailey (Cash Cab), Kent Bazemore (NBA, Atlanta Hawks), Anne Donovan (Two-Time Basketball Olympian, Head Coach in WNBA), Jay Harris (ESPN Anchor), Justin Verlander (MLB, Detroit Tigers), Nancy Lieberman (Women's Basketball), Brandon Vera (UFC), Oliver Purnell (DePaul Men's Basketball Coach).

ODU vs. Hampton Recap

ODU Takes Down Hampton In Season Opener, 41-28

NORFOLK, Va. – Gerard Johnson rushed for 137 yards and Taylor Heinicke tossed three touchdowns as Old Dominion University football opened the season with a 41-28 victory over Hampton at Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

After holding a 28-14 halftime lead, ODU took just 1:38 to score in the second half as Heinicke hit Zach Pascal for a 41-yard touchdown to give ODU a 35-14 lead.

Hampton countered with a two-yard TD run from Eric Carter but ODU bounced back with an eight-yard touchdown run by Cam Boyd, his second of the day to make the score 41-21.

The Pirates came back once again as Jaylian Williamson tossed a screen pass to Jorrian Washington that went for a 75-yard touchdown reception and closed the gap to 41-28.

Hampton followed by recovering a pooch kick down the left sideline that was recovered by Rayshad Riddick. HU drove to the Monarch five yardline before Richie Staton sacked Williamson, and forced and recovered a fumble to give ODU the ball back.

After an ODU punt, Hampton drove inside the ODU 10 again, but Isaiah Worthy recovered a Carter fumble to once again give ODU the ball back.

ODU got on the board first as Cam Boyd capped an 11 play, 66-yard drive with a 14-yard touchdown run.

The Pirates knotted the score at seven early in the second quarter as Jayilan Williamson connected with Marcus Hampton for a five-yard touchdown pass.

Old Dominion retook the lead as Heinicke hit Pascal for a five-yard touchdown pass to complete a 67-yard drive for a 14-7 Monarch lead.

Fellonte Misher gave the offense possession at the HU 31-yardline with an interception while Gerard Johnson ran for a 31-yard score on the next play for a 21-7 ODU lead.

Pascal caught his second touchdown of the game from Heinicke, this one from 19-yards out for a 28-7 ODU lead.

Hampton responded with an 11 play, 62-yard drive as Williamson hit Twarn Mixon from six yards out as time expired in the first half to cut the lead to 28-14.

Heinicke was 29-of-40 with three touchdowns and 281 yards. Pascal had eight grabs for 99 yards while Antonio Vaughan had five catches for 79 yards and a TD. Andre Simmons led ODU with nine tackles while Fellonte Misher had eight.

Washington completed 32-of-45 passes for 407 yards and three touchdowns while Riddick had 11 catches for a career-best 119 yards.

ODU at NC State Recap

ODU Falls Short at NC State, 46-34

RALEIGH, N.C. – Old Dominion led 21-18 at halftime but NC State scored 28 second half points to defeat the Monarchs 46-34 Saturday night at Carter-Finley Stadium.

Late in the third quarter, Ray Lawry scored his third rushing touchdown of the night to give ODU a 28-25 lead but the Wolfpack answered with a 16-yard Jacoby Brissett touchdown pass.

Matt Dayes added a 10-yard TD run to make it 39-28 NC State before Taylor Heinicke hit Antonio Vaughan for a nine-yard touchdown pass to cut the lead to 39-34 with five minutes remaining.

ODU tried an onside kick but could not recover, as NC State's Shadrach Thornton added a 23-yard touchdown to make the final score 46-34 NC State.

Thornton opened the second half scoring with a two-yard run to give NC State the lead at 25-21 but ODU answered with Lawry's run.

The Monarchs got on the board first, taking the opening drive 75-yards in 10 plays capped by a five-yard touchdown pass from Heinicke to David Washington. Gerard Johnson ripped off a 20-yard run on a third and one while Ray Lawry had a 19-yard run on the drive.

The following drive, NC State drove to the ODU 15, but a Poncho Barnwell sack knocked the Wolfpack back and they had to settle for a 33-yard field goal by Niklas Sade.

Rodman Noel intercepted a Heinicke pass after the Wolfpack field goal and Shadrach Thornton scored from two-yards out to put NC State on top 10-7.

Old Dominion followed with a Ray Lawry one-yard touchdown run on 4th and goal to cap a 14 play, 75-yard drive. Cam Boyd and Heinicke had key first down runs on the drive.

The Monarchs built the lead to 21-10 as Lawry scored his second rushing touchdown of the day, this one a two-yard run to cap a 10 play, 91-yard drive. Heinicke completed a pair of passes to Zach Pascal on the drive while Lawry added a 15-yard run to highlight the drive.

NC State finished the half with an eight play, 80-yard drive as Matt Dayes caught a seven-yard pass from Brissett. The Wolfpack converted the two-point play to cut the lead to 21-18.

ODU vs. Eastern Michigan Recap

Defense Leads ODU Past EMU, 17-3

NORFOLK, Va. – The Old Dominion University defense held Eastern Michigan to just 215 yards while Ray Lawry and Antonio Vaughan scored touchdowns to push the Monarchs past EMU 17-3.

The three points allowed by ODU is the lowest in school history and the 215-yards allowed is the fourth-lowest. D.J. Simon led the way with 11 tackles, while TJ Ricks added 10, both numbers are career-highs. Chris Smith, Terrell Reid and Poncho Barnwell also recorded sacks.

With just under eight minutes to play and holding a 10-3 lead, Antonio Vaughan took a punt and returned it 46-yards to put the Monarchs on top 17-3 and give the Monarchs some breathing room.

Eastern Michigan got the ball back with three minutes to play but Poncho Barnwell sacked Rob Bolden, forcing a fumble that Andrew Everett recovered to clinch the game.

ODU got on the board first as Ray Lawry ran up the middle for a 55-yard touchdown to finish a seven play, 80-yard drive. The run was the longest of Lawry's career.

The Monarchs took the 7-0 lead into the break, as the ODU defense held EMU to just 113 first half yards.

Midway through the third quarter, the EMU defense forced another stop, Vaughan returned a punt 51-yards for a touchdown, however, a holding penalty gave ODU the ball on the Eagles 37. Gerard Johnson rushed four times for 16-yards and Heinicke completed a pass to Vincent Lowe for 12 to set up a 26-yard Ricky Segers field goal to put the Monarchs on top 10-0.

Eastern Michigan put in Rob Bolden at quarterback following the field goal, and he drove the Eagles to the Monarchs' 22 yardline before settling for a 43-yard Dylan Mulder field goal.

The ODU defense continued to make stops, leading to Vaughan's key punt return touchdown.

Heinicke finished 17-of-30 for 187-yards, while Gerard Johnson carried 19 times for 85-yards. Lawry rushed for times for 69-yards, and his 55-yard TD. David Washington had four receptions for 23-yards while Vaughan had two receptions for 54-yards.

Bronson Hill led EMU with 16 rushed for 78-yards while Bolden added 31-yards on 12 carries. Brogan Roback was 9-of-17 for 56-yards.

ODU at Rice Recap

ODU Wins Historic First C-USA Game, 45-42 Over Rice

HOUSTON, Texas - Ricky Segers kicked a 25-yard field goal with no time left, as Old Dominion University Football pulled out a 45-42 victory at Rice in the Monarchs' first Conference USA game in school history.

Taylor Heinicke hit Zach Pascal for a 45-yard pass down the left sideline on the final drive to out ODU down to the Rice 15, and following a Gerard Johnson run Segers kicked the game-winner.

With ODU leading 42-35, Rice drove 80-yards to tie the score with a seven-yard run by Darik Dillard.

The Monarchs pulled out to a 35-14 lead early in the third quarter as Heinicke connected for an 18-yard touchdown with Zach Pascal.

Rice closed the game with a Driphus Jackson to Luke Turner touchdown pass and again at 35-28 as Dillard rushed for a four-yard score.

ODU pushed the lead back to 42-28 with a four-yard toss from Heinicke to Antonio Vaughan, but Dillard carried in from two-yards out to cut the score to 42-35. Rice followed that up with Dillard's third TD to set up the final ODU drive.

Heinicke passed for 430 yards and five touchdowns to lead the Monarchs while Pascal had six catches for 111 yards.

The win is ODU's third against an FBS team and the Monarchs start out 1-0 in Conference USA.

ODU got on the board first as Heinicke capped a seven play, 75-yard drive with a five-yard touchdown run, his first touchdown run of the year.

The Owls tied the score on their first possession as Driphus Jackson hit Zach Wright for a 31-yard touchdown pass.

The Monarchs came right back to retake the lead with an eight play, 75-yard drive as Heinicke connected with Melvin Vaughn for a 22-yard touchdown pass.

Rice tied the score at 14 with a 12 play, 86-yard drive with a one-yard run from Luke Turner.

Old Dominion came back after a nice stop from the defense, and drove 94-yards in seven plays as Heinicke hit Antonio Vaughan for a 45-yard touchdown pass on 4th and 8 to give ODU a 21-14 lead.

Heinicke tossed his third touchdown pass of the first half with 22 seconds left on a 44-yard strike to Nick England to put the Monarchs up 28-14.

Heinicke finished 27-of-43 for 430 yards and five scores and also rushed for 36-yards and a touchdown.

David Washington had five catches for 99-yards while Vaughan had five catches for 76-yards and two touchdowns.

ODU vs. Middle Tennessee Recap

ODU Falls to Middle Tennessee in First Friday Night Game, 41-28

NORFOLK, Va. – Middle Tennessee jumped out to a 24-0 lead with 7:01 to play in the second quarter as the Blue Raiders defeated the Old Dominion Monarchs 41-28 on Friday night at Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

This marked the first Friday night football game for the Monarchs and also the first Conference USA home game in school history. Full social media coverage can be found at www.odusports.com/storify.

Middle Tennessee jumped out to the 24-0 lead, but the Monarchs came back to cut the lead to 31-21 on Antonio Vaughan's third touchdown catch of the day, a 4-yard score from Taylor Heinicke.

The Blue Raiders followed by pushing the lead to 38-21 by converting a third and 13 as Austin Grammer connected with Marcus Henry for a 53-yard touchdown pass.

ODU came back to cut it to a 10-point lead again as the Monarchs capped a seven play, 74-yard drive in under two minutes as Heinicke hit true freshman Marques Little for a four-yard touchdown pass, the first touchdown of Little's career.

MT drove 37-yards for a 29-yard Cody Clark field goal to make the score 41-28 and the final score of the night.

Neither team scored in the first half, but MT tallied 24 unanswered points by the 7:01 mark. ODU scored for the first time at the 2:37 mark when Heinicke found Vaughan for a 27-yard touchdown to go into the intermission down 24-7.

The Monarchs scored first in the third quarter to cut the deficit to 10 when Heinicke found Vaughan for the second time at the 7:01 mark. Middle Tennessee answered with a score of it's own to go up 31-14 with 4:55 left in the quarter.

Heinicke went 29-for-44 for 362-yards and four touchdowns while also running for 16-yards. Zach Pascal led ODU with eight receptions for 110-yards while Vaughan finished with seven catches for 105-yards and three touchdowns. Martez Simpson led the defense with 11 tackles while TJ Ricks had nine tackles, two tackles for loss and a forced fumble.

Austin Grammer threw for two touchdowns, going 25-for-30 on the night and rushed for 67 yards. Jordan Parker picked up 158 yards on the ground on 31 carries. Marcus Henry made four catches for 83 yards for MTSU. Chris Brown netted seven tackles and Shubert Bastien recorded 2.5 sacks.

ODU at WKU Recap

WKU Outlasts ODU, 66-51

BOWLING GREEN, Ky. – Taylor Heinicke passed for 471 yards and Ray Lawry rushed for four touchdowns, but Juwan Gardner intercepted a pass that slipped out of Heinicke's hands and returned it 94 yards as Western Kentucky hung on to defeat Old Dominion University football 66-51 Saturday afternoon at Smith Stadium.

ODU cut the WKU lead to 56-51 on a 39-yard touchdown pass from Heinicke to Antonio Vaughan.

On the following drive, WKU was going in for a score but Richie Statton forced a fumble that Fellonte Misher returned to the 25-yardline.

The Monarchs drove to the WKU three-yardline, but Heinicke's pass slipped out of his hands and Gardner returned it 96-yards for the decisive touchdown.

Trailing 42-30 at the break, ODU received the ball to open the second half and drove 70-yards capped by a 17-yard Lawry touchdown run.

Kylen Towner followed with a 94-yard kickoff return for WKU but ODU responded as Lawry plowed in from four-yards out to make the score 49-44.

Leon Allen scored from 12-yards out to put the Hilltoppers on top 56-44.

WKU got on the board first as Leon Allen capped a seven play, 73-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown run.

Heinicke connected with Antonio Vaughan for a 44-yard completion to set up a 41-yard Jarrett Cervi field goal to make the score 7-3. The field goal is the first of Cervi's career.

The Hilltoppers took a 14-3 lead following an interception from Cam Thomas, Doughty hit Antwane Grant for a six-yard touchdown pass.

Following an ODU punt, Doughty tossed a 45-yard touchdown pass to Joel German for a 21-3 WKU lead.

The Monarchs responded with an 11 play, 83-yard touchdown drive capped by Ray Lawry's 12-yard touchdown run. The key play of the drive was Heinicke's 17-yard pass to Melvin Vaughn on fourth and five.

The ODU defense forced a fumble that was recovered by Aaron Young and the offense marched 44-yards capped by a one-yard run from Lawry, his second of the game. Heinicke connected with Lawry for 31-yard on 4th and nine to set up the touchdown.

WKU followed with an 16-yard touchdown pass from Doughty to Grant for a 28-16 WKU lead.

The Monarchs came right back on the first play of the drive Heinicke hit Vaughan for 45-yards and then connected with Vaughan for a 19-yard touchdown pass to make the score 28-23 WKU.

Taywan Taylor caught a 34-yard touchdown pass to complete a two-play drive for Western Kentucky for a 35-23 lead.

ODU turned in an 11 play, 89-yard drive as Heinicke tossed a 28-yard pass to Melvin Vaughn to cut the lead to 35-30.

WKU scored one more time to end the half as Doughty hit Jared Dangerfield for a 19-yard touchdown pass for a 42-30 WKU halftime lead.

Heinicke was 27-of-40 for 471-yards and three touchdown passes while Lawry carried 25 times for 148-yards and four touchdowns.

Melvin Vaughn set career highs with eight catches for 94 yards while Antonio Vaughan caught six passes for a career-best 220 yards, the second most receiving yards in school history.

Doughty was 23-of-26 for 371-yards and five touchdowns while Leon Allen rushed for 182-yards and two touchdowns. Jordan Dangerfield led WKU with eight catches for 95-yards.
