SERIES HISTORY WITH VANDERBILT

Georgia leads the all-time series with the Commodores 118-108 in records dating back to 1897. However, Vanderbilt has won the last nine series, going 22-5 in that stretch.

Georgia's last series win came in 2008 when the Bulldogs clinched the SEC title in Nashville, taking the series 2-1 and ultimately would advance to the CWS Finals.

Vanderbilt had won 12 games in a row over the Bulldogs before Georgia posted a 1-0 win in Athens last year. Freshman **Cam Shepherd** delivered a solo home run as **Chase Adkins** and eventual VU first round pick Kyle Wright were locked in a pitchers duel. Adkins went eight innings and **Kevin Smith** took care of the ninth as the Bulldogs snapped the streak against the Commodores with a two-hit shutout.

TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ After three weekends of league play, Georgia (22-7, 7-2 SEC) and top-ranked Florida are co-leaders in the SEC. Dating back to last season, the Bulldogs have won six straight SEC series with the most recent one over then #15 Texas A&M. At 7-2 in the SEC, this is Georgia's best start since 2009 when it began 7-2.

◆ After winning 15 of its last 17 games including a strong SEC start, Georgia now appears in all four Top 25 polls this week and is No. 8 in the NCAA's latest RPI. Last week, Georgia made its debut at No. 23 in *Collegiate Baseball's* (CB) Top 30 and No. 24 in the *USA Today Coaches Poll (USA)*. Georgia was not in the top 25 polls of *Baseball America (BA)* or *D1Baseball (D1)*. This week, Georgia is No. 8 (CB), No. 16 (D1), No. 17 in *USA* and No. 21 (BA). Georgia's remaining schedule features 22 out of 26 games against ranked foes.

◆ The week began with a 4-0 shutout of Georgia Tech (17-12) on Tuesday in Athens. Up next, the Bulldogs head to Nashville for an SEC series against No. 16 Vanderbilt (17-12, 5-4 SEC) that starts Thursday on ESPNU at 7 p.m. ET. The final two games of the series will be televised on SECN+.

Georgia will face Tech two more times this season with the other two meetings in Atlanta (April 24 on Tech's campus; May 8 at SunTrust Park to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta). Georgia swept Tech last year, winning all three meetings for the first time since 1984. Tech was coming off a three-game sweep of Miami (Fla.).

◆ The Bulldogs pitching staff has registered four shutouts in its last six games and boast an ERA of 3.40. The Bulldogs are averaging 7.3 runs a game while batting .291 and a .977 Fielding Percentage. Georgia checks in sixth in the SEC in batting and seventh in fielding. In four games last week, Georgia fielded .993, making just one error. In SEC action this year, Georgia is fielding .985.

◆ Offensively, Georgia has been led by senior outfielder **Keegan McGovern** (.356-10-31), sophomore third baseman/pitcher **Aaron Schunk** (.301-0-18; 1-0, 0.66 ERA, 3 SV, 13.2 IP, 1BB, 17K), junior designated hitter **Michael Curry** (.358-6-33) and junior second baseman **LJ Talley** (.316-2-14). McGovern ranks among the top 10 in the SEC in numerous offensive categories including in runs scored (37), walks (25), home runs (10), RBI (31) and slugging percentage (.721) while Curry is second in RBI (33). Sophomore **Cam Shepherd** is batting .231 but ranks second in doubles (10) and has 24 RBI and 21 walks. Curry, Talley and redshirt freshman **Mason Meadows** (.300-2-15) are all hitting over .300 in SEC action including .371 by Curry.

◆ Georgia's SEC rotation this season has featured senior **Chase Adkins** (3-0, 4.76 ERA) in game one and a pair of true freshmen in **Emerson Hancock** (3-1, 3.29 ERA) and **Ryan Webb** (1-2, 3.64 ERA) for games two and three. Hancock's status for this weekend's SEC start will be determined later this week after injuring an ankle against the #15 Aggies. He had pitched 3.1 scoreless innings with five strikeouts before leaving the game with the injury. However, sophomore **Tony Locey** (5-0, 2.96 ERA) came on for Hancock and picked up the win to clinch the series against #15 Texas A&M. Locey answered the call by tossing 3.2 scoreless frames with four strikeouts in a 3-0 shutout. In the SEC, Locey is 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 9.1 innings. Locey pitched two innings in Tuesday's win with four Ks while junior LHP **Kevin Smith** (4-1, 4.71 ERA) got the win with 4.1 scoreless frames and 9 Ks.

On March 26, Georgia made its 2018 debut in the national top 25 polls. The Bulldogs were No. 23 in *Collegiate Baseball's* (CB) Top 30 and No. 24 in the *USA Today Coaches Poll* (USA). Georgia was not in the top 25 polls of *Baseball America* (BA) or *D1Baseball* (D1).

For the week of April 2, Georgia shot up to No. 8 (CB), No. 16 (D1), No. 17 (USA), No. 19 (NCBWA) and No. 21 (BA).

*The No. 8 ranking is the highest since 2009 when the Bulldogs reached No. 1 during the regular season for five weeks for the first time in school history. Georgia's appearance in the BA poll was its first since March 26, 2012.

*Georgia's remaining schedule features 23 out of 27 games against ranked foes.

LATE-INNING OPTIONS

After the first three weekends of play when the starting rotation remained the same, Georgia made a change. As it did last year down the stretch, left-hander **Kevin Smith** moved to the bullpen. He gets the call in the later innings.

For the final five SEC series in 2017, Smith was available out of the bullpen for the first two games, and then if he didn't pitch, he would start Sunday. In this role, he picked up his first career save in a 1-0 win over Vanderbilt and then went 1-0 with a save in a series road win over then No. 4 Kentucky when he did make a Sunday start.

In his career as a reliever, Smith is 4-1, 2.55 ERA, 2 SV in 22 appearances. In 35.1 IP, he has allowed 13 runs (10 ER) with 17 BB and 42 Ks.

Starting with the Toledo series (March 9-10), Georgia went with freshman **Ryan Webb** in the final game. Senior RHP **Chase Adkins** went from Sunday to Friday and freshman RHP **Emerson Hancock** remained on Saturday. This will be Georgia's rotation for the SEC opener against Alabama.

The top option to close now is sophomore RHP/3B **Aaron Schunk** after his performance against The Citadel on March 6. In just his second career appearance including his first this year, Schunk filled up the strike zone, tossing 2.2 scoreless and hitless innings with four strikeouts. Then against Toledo on March 10, Schunk earned his first career victory, pitching the final three innings of a 7-6 win in 10 innings. He notched two saves in the sweep of South Carolina (March 23-25) and his latest came in a shutout of #15 Texas A&M (March 30).

Schunk started the first 37 games at third base last year before a broken thumb ended his campaign. He made just one appearance on the mound last year, allowing one hit to Mercer on Feb. 21.

Schunk, who was recruited as a two-way player, has started all 28 games at third base this season and is batting .303-0-17. Also of note, he had a career-best 16-game hitting streak that ended March 23.

Along with Webb, Georgia's other late-inning options this season have included sophomore **Zac Kristofak** (1-1, 2.25 ERA, 2 SV), senior **Blake Cairnes** (1-0, 3.38 ERA) and sophomore **Will Proctor** (2-2, 3.77 ERA, 2SV). Proctor was a position player for the Bulldogs last year, appearing in 46 games with 38 starts at second base. He batted .241-3-17. In an exit meeting after the season with Coach Stricklin, Proctor asked about the possibility of pitching in 2018. He worked on it in summer baseball back home in California and continued the transition in fall practice. This season, he has seen action as a pitcher only, making 11 relief appearances for a total of 14.1 innings.

2018 WEEKLY RECAPS

(Week 1) Georgia showed resiliency in coming back to win a series over Ga. Southern. The Bulldogs erased a 7-2 deficit in the opener to win 22-9 and then dropped game two 8-3 despite leading 2-0 for the first six frames. In the series finalé, Georgia led 2-0 until surrendering three runs in the 8th and came back in the 9th for a 4-3 walk-off.

(Week 2) In its first road game of the year, Georgia erased a 4-3 deficit with an 11-run outburst in the sixth inning to post a 14-4 victory. Then, the Bulldogs swept Charlotte to move their record to 6-1. It was Georgia's first sweep since 2016 (Lipscomb).

(Week 3) Georgia began a stretch of seven games in eight days with a combined two-hit shutout of Wofford 5-0 in Athens Tuesday. The Bulldog collected a season-high five doubles and sophomore Tim Elliott provided six strong innings with seven Ks. Wednesday's game with Ga. State was rained out. Georgia was swept by College of Charleston in a three-game series. The Bulldogs were a combined 0-for-13 with runners in scoring position in the first two games and then saw the Cougars rally for three runs in the eighth in the series finale to complete a sweep.

(Week 4) Georgia wrapped up its five-game swing in Charleston with CSU on Monday and The Citadel on Tuesday. Against CSU, Georgia allowed four unearned runs in the ninth capped by a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch for a 5-4 walk-off loss. The Bulldogs rebounded against The Citadel, pounding out 15 hits (14 singles and a grand slam) in a 9-4 win. The Bulldogs swept a three-game home series from Toledo including a Saturday doubleheader due to rain in the forecast. Georgia capped the sweep with a 7-6 walk-off in 10 innings thanks to a sacrifice fly from LJ Talley.

(Week 5) The Bulldogs hammered KSU 15-3 in midweek action as Cam Shepherd and Michael Curry hit grand slams to extend the team's winning streak to five games. Georgia dropped a 10-9 decision in 13 innings in the SEC opener at Alabama before bouncing back to win the series with identical 6-5 victories, scoring early and holding off rally attempts by UA.

(Week 5) Georgia crushed Ga. State 12-2, using an 11-hit attack including two home runs by Keegan McGovern (3-3, 4R, 5RBI). Georgia swept USC, outscoring them 22-8 while posting a 2.67 ERA and .991 FLDG%.

(Week 6) Georgia blanked Charleston Southern 7-0 for its second straight shutout. Then, the Bulldogs play claimed a series 2-1 over #15 Texas A&M. The season-long win streak reached nine games before falling this past Saturday.

(Week 7) Georgia shut out rival Ga. Tech 4-0 in Athens Tuesday. Up next, they face #16 Vanderbilt in Nashville.

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN

**UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA'S

Since arriving at UGA, Stricklin, 46, has created an atmosphere of excitement around the program, starting with the current student-athletes, extending to former lettermen and to Georgia baseball fans around the state. He has organized numerous lettermen functions to help reunite former players and steered the \$12 million Foley Field Revival project that was completed prior to the 2015 season. He has engaged the fan base with the annual First Pitch banquets featuring Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Phil Niekro and Chipper Jones and most recently Bulldog legend and Major Leaguer Gordon Beckham and Atlanta Braves standout Jeff Francoeur.

Georgia's recruiting classes have steadily improved under Stricklin, according to *Perfect Game USA* national rankings. In fact, the class that made its debut in 2017 was ranked No. 3 nationally. Additionally, the Bulldogs have excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.08 GPA for the fall semester of 2016 and then 19 Bulldogs made the 2017 SEC Academic Honor Roll.

The 2017 season saw the Bulldogs advance to the SEC Tournament after an impressive finish to the regular season, going 8-3 over the final 11 games. During this stretch, the Bulldogs claimed a road series over then No. 4 Kentucky, captured a series over No. 6 Mississippi State and then won another road series over No. 30 South Carolina. It marked the first time since 2001 that Georgia tallied three consecutive SEC series wins over ranked teams. Georgia started as many as six freshmen during the year and 10 newcomers saw action on the mound as the Bulldog ended the year with a 25-32 record.

Stricklin helped organize the first game open to the public at SunTrust Park to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta as the Bulldogs faced Missouri on April 8. The crowd of 33,025 at SunTrust was the second biggest in college baseball history. A month later, Georgia returned to SunTrust for the 15th annual Spring Baseball Classic For Kids and defeated Georgia Tech in front of nearly 24,000 to sweep the season series for the first time since 1984.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series, was hired to lead the UGA program on June 3, 2013. A 23rd-round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins before embarking on a coaching career.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (15) and Keaton (10), and a son, Cale (13).
