- Ole Miss fell to 10-5 overall (0-2 SEC) this season after falling at home to Florida, 59-55, Thursday night.
- Senior Nikki Byrd (14.5 ppg) and sophomore Valencia McFarland (13.2 ppg) lead Ole Miss in scoring.
- Byrd recorded her 15th career double-double (and 10th this season) against Florida with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Byrd recorded five consecutive double-doubles from Nov. 18 to Dec. 12. She is the first player in the SEC this season to record double-digit double-doubles.
- Sophomore Kenyotta Jenkins recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and a career-high 10 rebounds in a loss to Florida.
- Byrd (10.5 rpg) and sophomore Pa'Sonna Hope (4.1 rpg) lead the team in rebounding.
- Byrd is 14th in the nation in rebounding in the NCAA stats released on January 6 and is currently ranked first in the SEC.
- Head coach Renee Ladner is in her fifth season at the helm. She has a career record of 68-70 overall and 21-41 in SEC play.

REBELS TRAVEL TO VANDERBILT

Ole Miss will open the road portion of its SEC schedule on Sunday when the team travels to Vanderbilt for a 2 p.m. game. The road game will mark the Rebels' first game on the road since a win at Lipscomb on December 16. The Rebels (10-5 overall, 0-2 SEC) are 7-3 at home this season and 3-2 on the road. The team has won as many games this season (10) as the team won all of 2010-11 (10-19).

ABOUT OLE MISS

Ole Miss is 10-5 overall this season and 0-2 in SEC play after falling to Florida, 59-55, on Thursday night. The Rebels are led by Nikki Byrd (14.5 ppg, 10.5 rpg) and Valencia McFarland (13.2 ppg, 84 assists). Sophomore Pa'Sonna Hope is second on the team in rebounding, averaging 4.1 rebounds per game. Head coach Renee Ladner is in her fifth season at the helm.

OLE MISS VS. VANDERBILT

Vanderbilt leads the all-time series, 24-15. The Rebels and Commodores went 1-1 last season with each team winning on their home floor. In Nashville, Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 13-3 and Ole Miss' last win in Nashville was a 77-73 Rebel win in 1987.

A LOOK AT VANDERBILT

The Commodores are ranked 24th this week in the AP Poll and 21st in the Coaches Poll. Vanderbilt is 12-2 overall and 0-1 in SEC play after falling in its conference opener, 65-55, at South Carolina. The Commodores are led by Christina Foggie (17.1 points per game) who leads four players in double figures. Stephanie Holzer (7.2 rebounds per game) leads the team in rebounding. As a team, Vanderbilt averages 78.2 points per game while holding its opponents to 55.7 points per game. The Commodores are first in the nation in three-point field goal percentage, shooting 43.0 percent.

OLE MISS - VANDERBILT CONNECTIONS

Current Vanderbilt assistant coach Kim Rosamond spent five years as an assistant coach at Ole Miss starting in 1998. She was also a four-year letterwinner for the Rebels from 1995-98.

game winning streak from 11/18-12/3 and a four-game winning streak from 12/16-12/29 ... Ole Miss shot a season-best 57.1 percent from the floor (32-56) in a win over Cleveland State ... The Rebels scored a season-high 41 points in the second half at Lipscomb while holding the Bisons to 18 points in the second half ... Nikki Byrd has doubled her rebound and scoring averages from last season and is averaging a career-high 14.5 ppg and a career-high 10.5 rpg ... Ole Miss' game against Central Michigan marked the first time this season the Rebels led at the half but lost the game ... Prior to the Central Michigan game this year where Ole Miss allowed 61 boards, the Rebels hadn't allowed 60+ rebounds since 2003 ... From Nov. 18 to Dec. 3, Ole Miss has held four of its five opponents to 53 points or under ... Nikki Byrd has scored a team-high 26 points this season while also recording a team-high 17 rebounds ... Seven of Ole Miss' games this season have been decided by nine points or less ... Valencia McFarland and Nikki Byrd have started each game for Ole Miss ... Ole Miss held South Alabama without a player scoring in double figures marking the first time since November 19, 2006 that the Rebels did not allow

a player on an opposing team to score in double figures.

JENKINS RECORDS FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Kenyotta Jenkins recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and a career-best 10 rebounds in a loss to Florida on January 5. She also recorded a career-high three blocks against Florida. This season, she recorded a season-high 12 points in a win over SELA.

CAREER NUMBERS WATCH

Senior forward Nikki Byrd is on pace to score over 900 career points and grab over 700 career rebounds. To date, she has recorded 725 career points (218 this year) and 569 career rebounds (158 this year). Byrd is averaging 14.5 points per game and 10.5 rebounds per game this season.

Sophomore point guard Valencia McFarland is on pace to end her sophomore year with a total of over 750 career points and over 280 career assists. McFarland has recorded 569 career points (198 this year) and 207 career assists

(84 this year). This season, she is averaging 13.2 points per game and 5.6 assists per game.

BYRD RANKED 14TH IN THE NATION IN REBOUNTING

In the latest NCAA stats released January 6, senior forward Nikki Byrd is 14th in the nation in rebounding, averaging 10.5 rebounds per game. The NCAA stats will be released again on Monday, January, 9. Byrd is also ranked 15th in the nation in field goal percentage (57.3%) and third in double-doubles (10). Byrd has been ranked no higher than 14th in the nation in rebounding every week this season the national stats have been released.

MCFARLAND NEARING A TOP-20 RANKING NATIONALLY IN ASSISTS

In the latest NCAA stats released January 6, sophomore point guard Valencia McFarland is 21st in assists, averaging 5.6 assists per game. She is also ranked 32nd nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.05).

BYRD RECORDS 15TH CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior Nikki Byrd recorded her 15th career double-double in a loss to Florida with 13 points and 11 rebounds. It is her 10 double-double of the season. From Nov. 18 to Dec. 3, Byrd recorded five consecutive double-doubles to become the first player to record five consecutive double-doubles since Arminite Price in 2007.

With her 10th double-double of the year, Byrd becomes the first player since Arminite Price in 2006-07 to record at least 10 double-double in

a season. Byrd is also the first player in the SEC this year to record double-digit double-doubles.

Byrd, along with junior Courtney Marbra and sophomores Pa'Sonna Hope, Valencia McFarland, and Kenyotta Jenkins are the five active players with double-doubles.

MCFARLAND LEADS TEAM IN ASSISTS...AGAIN

Sophomore Valencia McFarland, who has led the team in assists in 12 games this season, has 84 assists in 15 games for an average of 5.6 assists per game. She has recorded at least five assists in 21 career games for Ole Miss. This season she has recorded double-digit assists in two games with 10 against Cleveland State and a career-high 11 in a win over SELA. As a freshman, she finished the year with a team-leading 123 assists.

OLE MISS IN THE SEC STATS

As of January 5, Ole Miss is second in rebounding offense (44.3), second in defensive rebounds (26.9) and fifth in assists (14.5 apg). Individually, Nikki Byrd is fifth in scoring (14.5 ppg) and Valencia McFarland is 10th (13.2 ppg). Byrd is first in rebounding (10.5 rpg) and fifth in field goal percentage (57.3). McFarland is first in minutes played (36.2 mpg), second in assists

BYRD IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Senior Nikki Byrd has scored in double figures in 16 consecutive games dating back to last season. She has scored in double figures in all 15 games this season and has the longest active streak of scoring in double figures on this season's roster.

HAMETH RECORDS CAREER HIGH IN BOARDS

Senior Whiney Hameth recorded a career-high and team-best nine rebounds in Ole Miss' loss to LSU on January 1. Hameth grabbed eight defensive and one offensive rebounds in 30 minutes of play. The guard is fourth on the team in rebounding, averaging 3.9 rebounds per game.

REBELS END NON-CONFERENCE PLAY STRONG

Ole Miss won a total of 10 of its 13 non-conference games including the final four games of

the non-conference season. The 10 wins marks the third time under fifth-year head coach Renee Lander that the team finished its non-conference schedule with at least 10 wins. The 10 wins to date this season matches the entire win total from the 2010-11 season when the team finished the year 10-19.

BLOCK PARTY

As a team, Ole Miss recorded its third game of the year with at least five blocked shots as the team recorded six blocks in a loss to Florida on January 5. Against SELA, Nikki Byrd became the first Ole Miss player to record five blocks in a game since 2008. For the season, Ole Miss has recorded 67 blocks with Byrd leading the way with 17 while Kenyotta Jenkins has recorded 13 and Pa'Sonna Hope has recorded 10. The Rebels recorded a season-high nine blocks in a win at Lipscomb.

MCFARLAND RECORDS FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Valencia McFarland recorded her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 assists in a win over Cleveland State on December 21.

OLE MISS IN SEC OPENERS

Ole Miss fell to 2-3 in SEC openers under Renee Lander after a 83-44 loss to LSU on January 1 to open SEC play. The Rebels fell to 2-1 under Ladner at home when opening conference play. Last season Ole Miss came back from an 18-point deficit to defeat Vanderbilt, 72-67, in the Rebels' SEC opener.

SINGLETARY RECORDS CAREER HIGH IN WIN

Freshman Amber Singletray recorded a career-best 15 points in her first career start in a win over Murray State. She also recorded career bests in field goals (six) and three pointers (3).

MCCRAY CONSISTENT FOR REBELS

Freshman Danielle McCray has played in all of the team's games this season and has made six starts. She recorded a career-high 12 points in a win over Cleveland State. For the year, she is averaging 5.1 points per game and 3.5 boards per game. McCray has recorded at least five points in eight games this year and at least five rebounds in six games.

MCFARLAND RECORDS SEVENTH CAREER 20-POINT GAME

Sophomore Valencia McFarland recorded her seventh career 20-point game with 23 points against Lipscomb. She tied her career high with 24 points against Central Michigan this season she also scored 24 points in a win versus Illinois last season. McFarland recorded four 20-point games last season.

REBELS IN DOUBLE FIGURES

For the season, Ole Miss players have recorded a total of 30 double-digit scoring games. Nikki Byrd leads the team with 15 double-digit scoring games while Valencia McFarland has recorded nine. Maggie McFerrin, Amber Singletary and Kenyotta Jenkins have each recorded two while Whitney Hameth has recorded one.

REBELS COME BACK FROM DOUBLE-DIGIT DEFICITS

In three games this season, Ole Miss has come back from double-digit deficits to win. Ole Miss trailed by 12 to North Florida but came back to win, 68-59, while the Rebels trailed by 13 at UMass before coming back to win, 72-67. Most

recently, Ole Miss trailed by 13 at Lipscomb before posting a 72-57 win.

Over the last two seasons, Ole Miss has come back from double-digit deficits seven times to win, including four times during the 2010-11 season.

TWO PLAYERS AVERAGING DOUBLE FIGURES

Senior Nikki Byrd and sophomore Valencia McFarland are leading the team in scoring this season. Byrd is averaging 14.5 points per game while McFarland is averaging 13.2 points per game. Byrd scored a career-best 26 points at UMass while McFarland tied her career high with 24 points in an overtime loss to Central Michigan.

BYRD, HOPE LEAD TEAM IN REBOUNDS

Senior Nikki Byrd and sophomore Pa'Sonna Hope are leading the team in rebounds. Byrd is averaging a team-leading 10.5 rebounds per game and as of January 5, is one of two players in the SEC to average double digits in rebounds. Hope is averaging 4.1 rebounds per game. Hope grabbed a season-high 11 rebounds at Lamar while Byrd recorded a season-high 17 at UMass.

MCFARLAND LOGGING MINUTES

Sophomore Valencia McFarland has played 38 minutes in six of the team's games this season, 44 in an overtime game against Central Michigan and 40 in a win at Lipscomb. For her career, she has played in 27 career games with 38 or more minutes.

BYRD PLAYS IN 100TH CAREER GAME

Senior Nikki Byrd played in her 100th career game on December 14 against Central Michigan. She has played in at least 29 games over each of her first three years at Ole Miss and is the team's active leader in career games played. Byrd has started all games this season.

CLOSE WINS, CLOSE LOSSES

This season, Ole Miss has had eight games, including the first five, decided by nine points or less. Ole Miss has posted two wins by nine points (North Florida, South Alabama) and one loss (at Lamar). The Rebels have also posted one win by eight points (at SEMO), two wins by five points (at UMass and vs. Murray State), one loss by three points and one loss by five points (Florida). Over the last two seasons, Ole Miss has recorded a combined 26 games that were decided by nine points or less.

were decided by nine points while the team finished the year with 16 games decided by nine points or less going 8-8 in those games. In 2010-11, the Rebels went 6-4 in games decided by five points or less. In those games with their narrowest margin of defeat coming versus Arizona (72-70) and their narrowest margin of victory coming versus Gonzaga (53-52). Ole Miss also recorded a two-point win (61-59) at Florida and a three point loss versus Arkansas (56-53).

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 50 POINTS

This season, Ole Miss has held two of its opponents under 50 points. The Rebels beat South Alabama 54-45 and beat SEMO, 51-43. This marks the first time since the 2008-09 season that Ole Miss held opponents to fewer than 50 points at least two times during the season. The 2008-09 team held opponents to fewer than 50 points six times.

51 POINTS GETS OLE MISS THE WIN

Ole Miss recorded 51 points in its 51-43 win at SEMO on November 21. Ole Miss scored its 50th point of the game with 18 seconds left on a free throw from Amber Singletary. Had Ole Miss scored just 50 points, it would have been the first time in nearly 28 years that the Rebels would have scored 50 points but posted a win. Ole Miss scored fewer than 50 points in a 46-45 win over Auburn on January 25, 1984 which marked the last time Ole Miss scored fewer than 50 points but won the game.

REBELS IN NOVEMBER

Ole Miss won five games in November this season marking the fourth time in the past six years that Ole Miss finished the month of November with five wins.

LADNER GETS 60TH CAREER WIN

Fifth-year head coach Renee Ladner recorded her 60th career win with a 54-45 victory over South Alabama on November 18, 2011. She recorded her 50th career win at Ole Miss last season with the Rebels' 69-60 win over Sam Houston State in the championship game of the Inn at Ole Miss Classic. Ladner is the fourth all-time winningest coach in Ole Miss history with 68 wins. Currently she trails Carol Ross (2003-07, 77 wins); Ron Aldy (1997-2003, 79 wins); and Van Chancellor (1978-1997, 439 wins).

REBELS SIGN TWO IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Ole Miss has signed Quindella Ford and Destinie Gibbs to National Letters of Intent in November. Ford is a 5-7 senior guard at Pontotoc High School

in Pontotoc, Miss., and was named to the Clarion-Ledger's Dandy Dozen in November. As a junior, she attended 1A Okolona and averaged 27.8 ppg.

Gibbs is a 5-11 wing from Oxford, Ga. She is a four-star recruit and is ranked by ESPN HoopGurlz as the 23rd best wing player in the 2012 class. As a junior, she averaged 16 points and six rebounds a game at McEachern High School.

OLE MISS IN SEASON OPENERS

Ole Miss improved to 4-1 in season openers under Renee Ladner and is now 32-6 all-time after beating North Florida to open the season. The Rebels have won their last four season openers and have not lost a season opener at home since 1998.

NEWCOMERS SEE TIME IN SEASON OPENER

Three of Ole Miss' newcomers saw playing time in the Rebels' season-opening win. Danielle McCray made her first career start while Tia Faleru and Amber Singletary each saw time off the bench.

MCFARLAND NAMED TO ALL-SEC TEAM

Sophomore point guard Valencia McFarland was named to the All-SEC Second Team by the media the SEC announced in October. McFarland was also named to the All-SEC Coaches Second Team in November.

MCFARLAND PLAYS WITH TEAM USA

Sophomore point guard Valencia McFarland played in the Pan American Games with Team USA in October. McFarland set a Team USA Pan Am Games record with seven steals against Argentina. She played in three of the team's four games and averaged 2.7 points, 2.0 rebounds in 14.3 minutes per game.

OLE MISS' NEWCOMERS RANKED AS A CLASS

The Rebels' incoming class of freshmen for 2011-12, Danielle McCray, Monique Jackson, Gracie Frizzell, Amber Singletary and Tia Faleru, are the 45th best incoming class in the nation this year as ranked by ESPN HoopGurlz. Ole Miss' incoming class is ranked higher than conference foes Arkansas and Auburn.

HAMETH, HOPE RETURN FROM INJURY

Senior Whitney Hameth and sophomore Pa'Sonna Hope have both been cleared to play this season after missing time with knee injuries.

Hameth missed all of last season with a knee injury. As a sophomore in 2009-10, she played in 11 games and averaged 4.4 points and 1.2 rebounds per game.
