NOTABLES

- **BREAK FROM LEAGUE PLAY:** The Longhorns play their final non-conference game of the season on Saturday morning as part of the Big 12/SEC Challenge presented by SONIC. This year marks the first time all 10 games in the Big 12/SEC Challenge will take place on one day.
- **IBEH ON A ROLL:** Senior center **Prince Ibeh** has averaged 12.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 6.0 blocks in the last two games. He recorded 7 points, 7 rebounds and a career-high 7 blocks at No. 3/3 Kansas last Saturday, before posting a career-high 17 points, 10 boards and 5 blocks on Tuesday against TCU.
- **ROACH'S CAREER NIGHT:** Freshman guard **Kerwin Roach, Jr.** had the finest offensive performance of his career in Tuesday's win against TCU. Roach set career highs in points (22), FT made (10-of-15), steals (3) and minutes (29) and tied his career high in rebounds (5) and FG made (6-of-9).

BIG 12 / SEC CHALLENGE PRESENTED BY SONIC

- Saturday's game is part of the 10-game Big 12/SEC Challenge Presented by SONIC. This marks the third year of the event.
- This year marks the first time ALL 10 games in the Big 12/SEC Challenge will take place on one day.
- The Big 12 has won the event in each of the first two seasons, posting a 6-4 edge in 2014 and a 7-3 advantage in 2013.
- The Big 12 is 41-27 (.603) in the last two conference challenge series it has played (vs. Pac-10, SEC) dating back to 2007.

VANDERBILT SERIES INFO

- Saturday's contest marks the eighth meeting between Texas and Vanderbilt.
- The Commodores hold a 4-3 lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 55-49 Texas victory in the opening round of the All-College Tournament in Oklahoma City on Dec. 27, 1950.
- **During the inaugural Big 12/SEC Challenge, Texas posted a 70-64 victory against Vanderbilt in Austin on Dec. 2, 2013.**

HORNS AT HOME

- UT is in its 39th season of play at the Frank Erwin Center. The Longhorns have registered an all-time record of 473-110 (.811) in the building.
- **Texas is 201-27 (.882) at the Erwin Center in the last 14 seasons (dating to the start of the 2002-03 season).**

TCU GAME NOTES

- Texas has won 14 consecutive home games against the Horned Frogs.
- UT has won 12 of the last 13 and 16 of the last 18 meetings in the series against TCU.
- The Longhorns forced 19 turnovers and held TCU to 54 points on 33.3% FG shooting (18-of-54), including a 3-of-13 (.231) mark from three-point range.
- UT posted a 20-8 advantage in points off turnovers and a 36-20 advantage in points in the paint.
- The Longhorns hit 24-of-36 free throws, while TCU went 15-of-22 from the stripe.
- **Prince Ibeh** set career highs in scoring (17 points), FG made (6-of-11) and FT made (5-of-6) and was one shy of his career high in rebounds (10).
- **Ibeh** posted a double-double (17 points, 10 rebounds) for the first time this year and second time in his career (122 games).

He reached double figures in scoring for the first time this season and fifth time in his career. Ibeh reached double figures in rebounds for the second time this year and third time in his career. He also recorded 5 blocked shots and has posted 12 blocks in the last 2 games.

- **Kerwin Roach, Jr.** set career highs in points (22), FT made (10-of-15), steals (3) and minutes (29) and tied his career high in rebounds (5) and FG made (6-of-9). He topped the 20-point mark for the first time in his career (20 games). Roach reached double figures in scoring for the fourth time this season and the second time in Big 12 play (8 games).
- **Isaiah Taylor** posted 7 assists against just 1 turnover and has recorded 39 assists against just 8 turnovers in 8 Big 12 games.

BUILDING A RESUME

- Texas sports a **2-1 mark against AP Top 10** teams this season with wins against No. 3 North Carolina (84-82 on Dec. 12) at home and at No. 6 West Virginia (56-49 on Jan. 20).
- The Horns are **3-1 this year against AP Top 20**, adding a 94-91 home OT win against No. 17 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- Overall, UT is 3-2 against AP Top 25 opponents this season.

IMPRESSIVE ROAD VICTORY AT WVU

- With its 56-49 victory at No. 6/7 West Virginia (Jan. 20), UT recorded its first true road win against an AP Top 10 opponent since a 74-63 win at No. 2 Kansas on Jan. 22, 2011.
- The Longhorns posted their first true road win against an AP Top 25 opponent since a 74-60 victory at No. 24 Baylor on Jan. 25, 2014.
- West Virginia entered the game with an 8-0 home record and a +33.5 scoring margin in home games (including a 74-63 win against then-No. 1 Kansas). WVU also entered the contest averaging 91.1 points per game at home.
- WVU entered the game leading the nation (Division I) in steals (11.4 per game) and turnovers forced (20.7 per game). West Virginia registered only 3 steals and 8 forced turnovers in Wednesday's game. Prior to Wednesday's contest, WVU had posted at least 7 steals in every game and had forced at least 14 turnovers in every game.

SIGNIFICANT VICTORY AGAINST UNC

- With its 84-82 win against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12), UT recorded its first victory against an AP Top 5 opponent since a 74-63 win at No. 2 Kansas on Jan. 22, 2011.
- The Longhorns registered their first home win against an AP Top 5 opponent since a 73-68 victory against No. 2 Oklahoma on Feb. 21, 2009.

CARDIAC HORNS

- The Longhorns won at Stanford (Dec. 19) on a made basket in the closing seconds for the second time in a three-game span. In both contests, UT's opponent in both games made a basket to tie the score with under 10 seconds remaining.
- **Javan Felix** hit a jumper as time expired to beat No. 3/3 North Carolina 84-82 at home on Dec. 12.
- **Isaiah Taylor** went coast-to-coast and hit a running floater high off the glass with 1.1 seconds left for the victory at Stanford (Dec. 19).

YEAR ONE OF THE SHAKA SMART ERA

- **Shaka Smart** was introduced as the 24th head basketball coach at The University of Texas on April 3, 2015.
- The 38-year-old Smart spent the previous six seasons at Virginia Commonwealth University, leading the Rams to an overall record of 163-56 (.744) and five NCAA Tournament appearances including the 2011 Final Four.
- **The 163 wins tied Smart for the second-highest number of total victories during the first six years of a head coaching career in NCAA history** (Brad Stevens, Butler; 166-49 in 2008-12).
- VCU and Duke are the only two programs in the country to have posted at least 26 wins in each of the past six seasons.
- VCU is one of only 11 schools in the nation to earn an NCAA Tournament bid in each of the past five years (Cincinnati, Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Louisville, Michigan State, North Carolina, Ohio State, San Diego State and Wisconsin).

FIVE CORE VALUES OF TEXAS BASKETBALL

- Upon Smart's arrival at Texas, he laid out his five core values for the Texas Basketball program:
- **APPRECIATION:** We see every opportunity as a gift.
- **ENTHUSIASM:** We are passionate and excited about our process for success.
- **COMPETITIVENESS:** We aggressively pursue excellence.
- **TEAMSHIP:** We commit fully to aligning ourselves with the team.
- **ACCOUNTABILITY:** We are responsible for our team and ourselves.

A CONSISTENT DANCER

- Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 16 of the last 17 and 24 of the last 27 years.
- UT has made a total of 32 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (35-35 record).

FIVE-MAN SENIOR CLASS

- Texas is led by a five-man senior class that includes: guards **Javan Felix** and **Demarcus Holland**, forward **Connor Lammert** and centers **Prince Ibeh** and **Cameron Ridley**.
- These five players have combined to play in a total of 599 games (322 starts) entering Saturday's contest.

PROTECTING THE ROCK

- **The Longhorns lead the league in fewest turnovers per game (9.0 per game) in Big 12 play.**
- UT had a streak of **five** consecutive games in which it committed less than 10 turnovers. Texas had 6 turnovers at TCU (Jan. 9), 5 in the OT win vs. #17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12), 8 vs. Oklahoma State (Jan. 16), 8 at No. 6/7 West Virginia (Jan. 20) and 8 at No. 3/3 Kansas (Jan. 23).

- **This marked the first time UT has had a streak of five consecutive games with less than 10 turnovers since at least the start of the 1993-94 season** (Texas Media Relations still researching prior to that year).
- UT's starting backcourt of **Isaiah Taylor** and **Javan Felix** have combined for a 138-to-56 (2.5-to-1) assist-to-turnover ratio.

TAYLOR GETTING THE POINT

Junior **Isaiah Taylor** is in his third year as the starting point guard. He has played in 79 career games (all starts) and has reached double figures in scoring 59 times, including 13 times of 20-plus points.

- **Taylor leads the team in scoring (15.8 ppg), assists (4.9 apg) and minutes (30.7 mpg) through the first 20 contests.**
- He has reached double figures in scoring 15 times this year, including five 20-point games and one 30-point effort.
- Taylor registered 19 points (8-of-16 FG) in 33 minutes during the home loss to Connecticut (Dec. 29).
- He recorded a game-high 26 points (11-of-17 FG, 3-of-3 FT) and 6 assists in 38 minutes at Stanford (Dec. 19).
- Taylor registered 18 points (7-of-12 FG, 2-of-4 threes) and 5 assists in 26 minutes against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12).
- He had a game-high 21 points (4-of-8 FG, career-high 13-of-17 FT) and 6 assists in 37 minutes against UT Arlington (Dec. 1). All of his points came in the second half and overtime.
- He posted 18 points (7-of-14 FG) and 8 assists against just 1 turnover in 32 minutes against Michigan at the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 27).
- Taylor tallied 27 points (12-of-15 FT) and added 7 rebounds in 28 minutes against Washington in China (Nov. 13).

TAYLOR BETTER IN BIG 12 PLAY

In eight Big 12 contests, **Isaiah Taylor** is averaging 16.8 ppg while hitting 45.1 percent (46-of-102) from the floor and 82.6 percent from the FT line (38-of-46). **Taylor has a 39-to-8 assist-to-turnover ratio (4.9 ratio) in league play.**

- He tallied a game-high 17 points (5-of-11 FG, 6-of-8 FT), a season-high 3 steals and 4 assists against just 1 turnover in 32 minutes against K-State (Jan. 5).
- Taylor posted a career-high 35 points (11-of-22 FG, 13-of-14 FT) and 6 assists against just 1 turnover in 37 minutes at Texas Tech (Jan. 2).

TAYLOR EARNS BIG 12 HONOR

Isaiah Taylor was named the **Phillips 66 Big 12 Conference Player of the Week (Jan. 18)**. In UT's two wins, Taylor averaged 23.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists in 36.0 minutes per contest. He converted 16-of-26 (.617) field goals, including 3-of-6 (.500) three-pointers, and 11-of-13 (.846) free throws while posting 10 assists against just 2 turnovers.

- **Taylor is the fourth Longhorn this season to earn one of the league's weekly accolades**, joining Player of the Week selections **Javan Felix** (Dec. 14) and **Cameron Ridley** (Dec. 21) and two-time Newcomer of the Week honoree **Eric Davis, Jr.** (Nov. 30 and Dec. 14).
- He recorded a game-high 28 points (11-of-17 FG, 2-of-3 threes, 4-of-5 FT), 6 rebounds and 6 assists against just 1 turnover in 41 minutes during the home overtime win against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- Taylor registered a game-high 18 points (5-of-9 FG, 7-of-8 FT), 2 rebounds and 4 assists against just 1 turnover in 31 minutes during the 74-69 home victory against Oklahoma State (Jan. 16).

TAYLOR REACHES 1,000-POINT MILESTONE

By converting a free throw with 37.0 seconds left in the first half at TCU (Jan. 9), **Isaiah Taylor became the 36th player in program history to record at least 1,000 career points**. He has 1,073 points in 79 career games played (13.6 ppg). Taylor was the second Longhorn to join the 1,000-point club during the 2015-16 season (**Javan Felix** topped 1,000 points on Dec. 15 vs. Appalachian State).

TAYLOR'S CAREER DAY

Isaiah Taylor had the finest offensive performance of his collegiate career at Texas Tech (Jan. 2). He posted a career high in scoring (35 points) and tied his career high in free throws made (13-of-14). His previous career high was 27 points (twice). **The 35 points marked the highest UT individual scoring total since Kevin Durant had 37 (four times in 2006-07 season).**

THE FELIX FILE

Senior guard **Javan Felix** is in his fourth season in the backcourt rotation. He has played in 119 career games (66 starts). In his career, Felix has reached double figures in scoring 56 times, including eight 20-point performances.

- **Felix is tied for the team lead in steals (17) and ranks second (among active players due to Ridley's injury) in scoring (11.0 ppg) while hitting a team-best 40.0% (36-of-90) from three-point range.**
- He has reached double figures in scoring 13 times this season.
- **In five games against AP Top 25 opponents, Felix is averaging 13.4 ppg while hitting 8-of-16 (.500) threes and 11-of-12 FT.**
- He has posted a 2.1 assist-to-turnover ratio (41 assists, 20 turnovers) while averaging 26.3 minutes per game this year.
- Felix registered 12 points (5-12 FG) and 6 assists against just 1 turnover in 30 minutes at No. 3/3 Kansas (Jan. 23).
- He recorded a game-high 17 points (2-3 threes, 7-8 FT) in 29 minutes at No. 6/7 West Virginia (Jan. 20), scoring the last 9 points of the game to seal the victory.
- Felix tallied 13 points in 27 minutes in the home overtime victory against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- He registered a team-high 16 points (7-of-12 FG) and 3 assists without a turnover in 33 minutes at TCU (Jan. 9).
- Felix recorded 14 points (4-of-4 FT) and 4 assists against just 1 turnover in a season-high 36 minutes against K-State (Jan. 5).
- **He registered a season-high 25 points (three shy of career high), including the game-winner at the buzzer, in the victory against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12).** He converted 9-of-14 FG, including 5-of-7 threes in 35 minutes.
- Felix recorded 18 points (7-of-15 FG) and 3 assists against 1 turnover in 35 minutes against UT Arlington (Dec. 1).
- He posted 13 points (4-of-7 FG, 3-of-4 threes), 4 assists without a turnover and 3 steals in 18 minutes against Washington at the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 26).

FELIX JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

With his 3-pointer at the 4:04 mark of the first half in the win against Appalachian State (Dec. 15), **Javan Felix became the 35th player in program history to record at least 1,000 career points**. He has 1,117 points in 119 games played (9.4 career ppg).

THE FELIX BUZZER BEATER ... DID YOU KNOW?

- **Javan Felix's** game-winning shot at the buzzer against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12) marked the first true "buzzer beater" (shot counts with no time remaining on the clock) by a Texas player since **Cameron Ridley's** put-back as time expired in the NCAA Second Round (round of 64) vs. Arizona State (87-85) on March 20, 2014 in Milwaukee.
- It marked the first buzzer beater by the Longhorns at the Erwin Center since **Jonathan Holmes** sank a 3-pointer as time expired to beat Kansas State (67-64) on Jan. 24, 2014.

FELIX EARNS HONORS

- **Javan Felix** earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Co-Player of the Week honors (Dec. 14) for his performance against No. 3/3 North Carolina. This marked Felix's first career Big 12 weekly award.
- In addition to the league accolade, Felix claimed **Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week** (Dec. 15) honors

by the USBWA. He was nominated for the weekly award and chosen by a representative of the USBWA board of directors from a list of Division I conference players of the week. Felix also was named **National Player of the Week** (Dec. 14) by Andy Katz of ESPN.com.

- For the week, Felix averaged 14.0 points and 2.5 assists per game while converting 10-of-18 (.556) field goals, including 6-of-11 (.545) from three-point range.

LAMMERT PLAYING LARGE

Senior forward **Connor Lammert** is in his fourth season in the frontcourt rotation. He has played in all 123 career games (59 starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring 15 times and in rebounds seven times and has two double-doubles.

- **Lammert leads the team** (among active players due to Ridley's injury) **in rebounding (5.9 rpg) and ranks second in blocks (11) and minutes (26.7 mpg) while averaging 6.4 ppg through the first 20 contests.**
- **In UT's nine games played without the injured Cameron Ridley**, Lammert leads the team in rebounding (6.9 rpg) and ranks third in scoring (6.9 ppg) in 27.7 mpg. **He has led or tied for the team lead in rebounds in four of the nine contests.**
- He recorded career highs in scoring (15 points) and 3-pointers made (5-of-7) in 30 minutes at No. 3/3 Kansas (Jan. 23).
- Lammert registered 11 points (3-of-7 threes), 4 rebounds and 1 block in 30 minutes against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- He recorded a season-high 11 rebounds (two shy of career high) and tied his career highs in steals (2) and minutes (35) at TCU (Jan. 9).
- Lammert posted 12 points (4-of-6 FG, 3-of-5 threes), 9 rebounds and 3 steals in 27 minutes against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Nov. 21).

PRINCE'S PRESENCE

Senior center **Prince Ibeh** is in his fourth season in the frontcourt rotation. He has played in 122 career games (15 starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring five times and in rebounding three times and has recorded two career double-doubles.

- **Ibeh leads the team** (among active players due to Ridley's injury) **in blocks (38) and ranks second in rebounding (4.7 rpg) this season.**
- 36 of his 89 rebounds have come on the offensive glass.
- Ibeh missed the UTSA game (Dec. 8) with a lower back injury.

IBEH'S ROLE INCREASES SINCE RIDLEY INJURY

Prince Ibeh moved into the starting lineup after Cameron Ridley suffered his foot injury (Dec. 27). In those nine games, Ibeh leads the team in blocks (29) and ranks second in rebounding (6.6 rpg) while averaging 5.3 points in 24.0 minutes per game.

- **In the last two contests, he has averaged 12.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 6.0 blocks in 33.0 minutes per game.**

- Ibeh set career highs in scoring (17 points), FG made (6-of-11) and FT made (5-of-6) and added 10 rebounds (one shy of career high) and 5 blocks in 31 minutes against TCU (Jan. 26). He registered his first double-double of the year and second of his career.
- He recorded a career-high 7 blocks along with 7 points (3-4 FG) and 7 rebounds in a career-high 35 minutes at No. 3/3 Kansas (Jan. 23). The 7 blocks were the most against a Kansas team since Anthony Davis (Kentucky) had 7 on Nov. 15, 2011.
- Ibeh had 9 rebounds (4 offensive) and 7 points (3-of-3 FG) in 27 minutes against K-State (Jan. 5).
- He tallied 10 rebounds in 20 minutes at Texas Tech (Jan. 2).
- Ibeh had 5 blocks in 18 minutes against Connecticut (Dec. 29).

DAVIS MAKES INSTANT IMPACT

Freshman guard **Eric Davis, Jr.** was tabbed the No. 45 prospect in the nation by ESPN following his senior year. A Jordan Brand All-American and finalist for Mr. Basketball in the state of Michigan as a senior, he led Saginaw Arthur Hill HS (Saginaw, Mich.) to a 24-4 mark and trip to the Class A state championship game while averaging 25 points, 7 assists and 6 rebounds per game.

- **Davis ranks third on the team** (among active players due to Ridley's injury) **in scoring (8.1 ppg) while converting 27-of-78 (.346) from three-point range and 27-of-35 (.771) free throws in 22.0 minutes per game.**
- He has reached double figures in scoring eight times in the first 20 contests.
- **In five games against AP Top 25 opponents this year, Davis has averaged 13.0 ppg while converting 24-of-43 (.558) field goals, including a 12-of-21 (.571) mark from 3-point range.**
- He registered 13 points (6-of-11 FG, 1-of-2 threes) and 5 rebounds in 21 minutes at No. 3/3 Kansas (Jan. 23).
- Davis recorded 12 points (4-of-4 FT) and 5 rebounds in 21 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 16).
- He tallied 14 points (5-of-9 FG) and 4 rebounds in 25 minutes in the home overtime win against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- He registered 16 points (6-of-10 FG, 4-of-5 threes) and 4 rebounds in 29 minutes during the home win against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12).
- Davis posted 11 points (3-of-5 threes), 4 rebounds and 5 assists against just 1 turnover in 23 minutes against UTSA (Dec. 8).
- He registered a team-high 15 points (5-of-8 FG, 1-of-2 threes) in 22 minutes against Washington (Nov. 26).
- Davis posted a season-high 19 points (6-of-10 FG, 4-of-7 threes) in 28 minutes against No. 25/nr Texas A&M (Nov. 25).

DAVIS EARNING HARDWARE

- **Eric Davis, Jr.** earned his second **Phillips 66 Big 12 Newcomer of the Week (Dec. 14)** accolade this year for his performances against UTSA and No. 3/3 North Carolina. For the week, Davis averaged 13.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game while converting 9-of-17 (.529) field goals, including a 7-of-10 (.700) mark from three-point range.

- Davis also earned **Phillips 66 Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honors (Nov. 30)**, averaging a team-best 15.3 ppg while converting 15-of-24 (.625) field goals, including 7-of-13 (.538) from three-point range, during UT's three contests at the Battle 4 Atlantis.

ROACH'S RESUME

Freshman guard **Kerwin Roach, Jr.** was tabbed the No. 34 prospect in the nation by Rivals.com and No. 47 by ESPN following his senior season. He averaged 20.7 points, 4.8 assists and 3.0 steals per game while pacing North Shore HS (Houston, Texas) to a 27-7 mark as a senior. Roach led his team to the Class 5A state title in his junior year. He also competed in track and field and won back-to-back Class 5A state championships in the triple jump as a junior and senior.

- Roach is tied for fourth on the team (among active players due to Ridley's injury) in scoring (6.4 ppg) in 17.2 minutes per game during the first 20 contests.
- He has reached double figures in scoring four times this year, including one 20-point effort.
- **Roach set career highs in points (22), FT made (10-of-15), steals (3) and minutes (29) and tied his career high in rebounds (5) and FG made (6-of-9) against TCU (Jan. 26).**
- He recorded 11 points (6-of-8 FT), 3 rebounds and 2 steals in 21 minutes against Oklahoma State (Jan. 16).
- Roach tallied 14 points (6-of-7 FG, 2-of-2 threes), 3 assists and 2 steals in 20 minutes at Stanford (Dec. 19).
- He recorded 14 points (4-of-5 FG) and 4 assists against 1 turnover in 22 minutes against UTSA (Dec. 8).
- His first-half dunk in the UT Arlington game was named the "Top Play" in ESPN SportsCenter's Top10 on Dec. 1. **It also earned ESPN's "Best Dunk of the Year" for 2015.**
- His first-half dunk in the Appalachian State contest was named the No. 8 play in ESPN SportsCenter's Top10 on Dec. 15.

CLEARE BACK ON THE COURT

Junior forward **Shaquille Cleare** (pronounced: CLAIR) sat out the 2014-15 season due to NCAA transfer rules, after spending his freshman and sophomore years at Maryland (69 games played). He was a high school teammate of UT guard **Isaiah Taylor** during Cleare's senior season (Taylor's junior year) at The Village School in Houston. Cleare was tabbed as the No. 30 prospect in the nation by ESPN following his senior year in high school.

- **Despite averaging just 10.9 minutes per game, Cleare ranks fourth on the team** (among active players due to Ridley's injury) **in rebounding (2.8 rpg).**
- 22 of his 55 rebounds have come on the offensive glass.
- **In UT's nine games played without the injured Cameron Ridley, he is averaging 4.3 ppg and 3.1 rpg in 13.1 mpg while hitting 15-of-25 (.600) field goals.**
- Cleare recorded season highs in points (8), rebounds (7) and minutes (23) at TCU (Jan. 9).
- He had 5 points and 6 rebounds (3 offensive) in 12 minutes against Connecticut (Dec. 29).
- Cleare had 5 points (5-of-6 FT) and 5 rebounds (three offensive) in 18 minutes against Washington in the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 26).
- He recorded 6 points (3-of-3 FG) and 5 rebounds in 16 minutes against No. 25/nr Texas A&M at the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 25).

MACK ATTACK

Freshman guard/forward **Tevin Mack** was tabbed the No. 48 overall prospect in the country by ESPN following his senior year. The South Carolina 3A co-Player of the Year as a senior, he averaged nearly 30 points and 9 rebounds per game while pacing Dreher HS (Columbia, S.C.) to an 18-7 record and the third round of the state playoffs.

- **He ranks sixth on the team** (among active players due to Ridley's injury) **in scoring (5.7 ppg)** despite playing just 14.4 minutes per contest.
- Mack has reached double figures in scoring three times this year, including one 20-point effort.
- He recorded 14 points (3-of-8 threes, 3-of-4 FT) in 20 minutes against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- **Mack registered a game-high 20 points (6-of-13 FG, 5-of-9 threes, 3-of-4 FT) and 6 rebounds in 23 minutes against Connecticut (Dec. 29).** He set career highs in points, rebounds and three-pointers made.
- He recorded 17 points (7-of-11 FG) in 24 minutes against UTSA (Dec. 8).

YANCY EMERGES

Junior guard **Kendal Yancy** is in his third season in the backcourt rotation. He has played in 85 career games (36 starts). In his career, Yancy has reached double figures in scoring 11 times.

- Yancy started and tied a season high with 7 points (3-of-3 FG) in 17 minutes at No. 6/7 West Virginia (Jan. 20).
- He recorded 5 points (2-of-3 FG, 1-of-2 threes) and a season-high 7 rebounds (one shy of career high) in a season-high 21 minutes against No. 17/18 Iowa State (Jan. 12).
- Yancy posted a season-high 7 points (3-of-6 FG, 1-of-2 threes) in 14 minutes against Appalachian State (Dec. 15).
- He suffered a concussion in the first half against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Nov. 21). He did not play in any of UT's three games at the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 25-27).

HOLLAND IS THE GLUE

Senior **Demarcus Holland** is in his fourth season in the backcourt rotation. The unquestioned team leader and "glue guy," he has played in 122 career games (86 starts). Holland has reached double figures in scoring 22 times and in rebounds three times.

- Holland missed the first game of his collegiate career at TCU (Jan. 9), as he attended the funeral of his grandmother (Mammie Holland) in Tyler, Texas. She passed on Jan. 5. He returned to the lineup for the Iowa State game (Jan. 12).
- He is a nominee for the 2016 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The fourth annual award honors college basketball student-athletes who are making a positive impact in their communities.
- A Big 12 All-Defensive Team selection as a sophomore in 2013-14, Holland has earned the team's Most Outstanding Defensive Player award in each of his first three seasons.

RIDLEY INJURY UPDATE

Senior center **Cameron Ridley** suffered a **fractured left foot** during practice on Dec. 27. **He had surgery in Austin on Dec. 29 and will be out indefinitely.**

- Ridley has played in 113 career games (96 starts) and reached double figures in scoring 41 times and in rebounds 26 times. He has posted 18 career double-doubles.

- **Prior to suffering the injury (first 11 games), Ridley led the team in rebounding (10.0 rpg) and blocks (37, 3.4 bpg) and ranked second in scoring (12.7 ppg) and minutes (26.0 mpg) while converting 60-of-95 (.632) field goals.**
- He has five double-doubles this year and has reached double figures in scoring nine times and rebounds seven times.
- Ridley earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week (Dec. 21) for his performances against Appalachian State (Dec. 15) and Stanford (Dec. 19). He averaged 14.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 6.5 blocks per game while hitting 14-of-26 (.538) field goals in two wins.
- In UT's 67-55 win against Appalachian State (Dec. 15), **Ridley** was just one blocked shot shy of becoming the **second player in program history** (Reggie Freeman had 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists at TCU on Feb. 11, 1996) to record a triple-double. Ridley recorded 19 points, 11 rebounds and a school single-game record 9 blocks.
- He set a **UT single-game record** with **9** blocked shots in the home win against Appalachian State (Dec. 15). This topped the previous mark of 8, shared by Chris Owens (8 vs. California on Nov. 15, 2000) and Chris Mihm (8 at Massachusetts on Feb. 5, 2000).
- Ridley posted a double-double with 12 points and 13 rebounds (6 offensive) in 33 minutes against No. 3/3 North Carolina (Dec. 12).
- He recorded a double-double with 13 points (4-of-6 FG) and 11 rebounds (5 offensive) in 23 minutes against Washington at the Battle 4 Atlantis (Nov. 26).
- Ridley posted a double-double with 14 points (6-8 FG) and 14 rebounds (tied a career high) in 23 minutes against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Nov. 21).
- He is just 61 points shy of reaching the 1,000-point milestone. He has 939 points in 113 games played (8.3 career ppg).

UT INKS PAIR DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

James Banks (Decatur, Ga.) and **Jacob Young** (Houston, Texas) signed National Letters of Intent to play basketball next season at The University of Texas during the early signing period. The duo will join the Longhorns for the 2016-17 season.

- **Banks** (6-10, 235), a center from La Lumiere (pronounced: Lah-loo-mair) School (La Porte, Ind.) who plays under head coach Shane Heirman, is ranked as the No. 45 overall prospect in the nation by Scout.com and the No. 56 overall and sixth-ranked center in the nation by ESPN. He averaged 23 points and 14 rebounds per game in his junior season while playing for Mount Vernon Presbyterian School (Atlanta, Ga.).

- **Young** (6-1, 175), a guard from Houston's Yates High School who plays under head coach Greg Wise, is ranked as the No. 85 overall prospect and 13th-best shooting guard in the nation by Scout.com and the No. 91 overall recruit by Rivals.com. He earned class 5A all-state honors from the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABC) as a junior while leading Yates to an 18-9 overall record and a trip to the regional semifinals of the state tournament. In his sophomore year, Young helped pace Yates to a 24-7 mark and a trip to the Class 4A state championship game.

NAVY SEAL TEAM TRAINING

- After using Navy SEAL training for his final four years at VCU, Shaka Smart and strength/conditioning coach **Daniel Roose** brought the program to Texas.
- All players and members of the UT coaching and support staff took part in a three-day training session in late September.
- The goals of the training session were to improve communication, leadership and team-building.
- **John McGuire**, who spent 10 years as a Navy SEAL and the past 17 years organizing training sessions incorporating some of the same rugged regimens, led the training.

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

- Texas Basketball has received public recognition awards for its multi-year NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last six years (2010-15). The awards are given to teams scoring in the Top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sport. **UT has earned a perfect 1,000 score in each of the last six multi-year APR reports.** In addition, Men's Basketball has posted perfect 1,000 APR single-year scores in EVERY season dating back to 2005-06 (nine straight years).
- Six Texas players earned a spot on the 2015 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team. **UT's five first-team selections were the top mark in the conference.** Texas and West Virginia paced the league with six total selections. **Demarcus Holland, Prince Ibeh, Connor Lammert, Tarale Murry and Isaiah Taylor** were named to the First Team, while **Kendal Yancy** was selected to the Second Team.

THREE-POINT STREAK

The last time Texas did not convert a three-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC-Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc on that day. **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 845 consecutive games.** In fact, UT has converted at least one three-pointer in 973 of 979 games since the trey was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season. The Horns have failed to attempt at least one three-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988; at TCU, 69-55 win).

- **Shaquille Cleare's** father, Brian, played basketball at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma (Chickasha, Okla.). He wears jersey No. 32 to honor his father, who also wore No. 32 during his collegiate playing days. Cleare was high school teammates with **Isaiah Taylor** at The Village School (Houston), when Cleare was a senior and Taylor was a junior.
- **Eric Davis'** father, Eric Sr., played football at Saginaw Valley College (1992-94). His uncle, Tony Davis, played basketball at the University of Minnesota.
- **Javan Felix** is oldest of four children (has three younger sisters). The Felix family was forced to relocate to Atlanta for four months while Javan was in sixth grade due to Hurricane Katrina (August 2005). The family was able to return to New Orleans in January 2006. Felix has interest in becoming an NBA General Manager following his playing career.
- **Demarcus Holland** moved to Dallas from Tyler when he was in the second grade. He has one older brother, Derrick, Jr., and three younger brothers, Craig, Desmond and Devon.
- **Prince Ibeh** was born in London and lived there for his first five years. He moved with his family to Amarillo, Texas at age five and lived there until he was 10 years old. The family then moved to Dallas when Prince was 10. His parents (Francis and Charity) lived in Mbaise, Nigeria before moving to London in 1987. Prince's middle name is Chinenye (pronounced KEN-yay). The name in Nigerian means "god's gift." Prince has three older brothers and one younger sister.
- **Connor Lammert** has an older brother, Clark, who played basketball at Texas Tech (2012-15). His father, Dean Lammert, played basketball at Texas A&I University (now called Texas A&M University-Kingsville) from 1980-83. His mother, the former Christi Scherrey, played volleyball at Texas A&I University from 1979-82.
- **Tevin Mack's** brother, Jermaine Washington, played basketball for two seasons at the University of Nevada (2003-05). In Washington's senior year, Nevada defeated Texas in the 2005 NCAA First Round.
- **Kerwin Roach's** father, Kerwin Sr., played basketball at Texas Southern University. Kerwin is an elite triple jumper who plans to compete for Texas in the outdoor season. He won back-to-back 5A state championships in the triple jump for North Shore HS as a junior (2014) and senior (2015). Roach also set a Nike Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays meet record with a jump of 50-8.00 (15.44 meters) in April 2015 on the UT campus.
- **Isaiah Taylor's** uncle, Terrell Lowery, played basketball at Loyola Marymount (1989-92). As a sophomore on the 1990 LMU squad that advanced to the "Elite Eight" in the NCAA Tournament, Lowery also played professional baseball, including stints with the Chicago Cubs (1997-98), Tampa Bay Devil Rays (1999) and the San Francisco Giants (2000).
- **Kendal Yancy's** brother, Terrel Harris, played basketball at Oklahoma State and went on to play professionally with the Miami Heat (2011-2013) and New Orleans Hornets.
