### Fast Facts On The Bulldogs

- \*No. 18 Georgia (16-6, 2-1 SEC) owns a 2.55 ERA, a .285 Batting Avg., and a .978 FLDG.%
- \*Georgia played 21 of its first 22 games at home, capping it with a 7-1 thrashing of #15 Ga. Tech.
- \*Georgia is 5-1 since getting swept by red-hot UCLA (15-4). Last week, UGA won the UT series 2-1.
- \*Junior 3B **Curt Powell** leads the squad with a .377 average. He is 5-for-13 in his last four games.
- \*Senior SS **Kyle Farmer** (.333-2-15) leads the SEC with 12 doubles.
- \*Freshman LF **Hunter Cole** (.317-3-12) hit .600 (9-for-15) with 2 HRs and 6 RBI last week. In his SEC series debut, he batted a team-best .556 (5-for-9) with a HR, 2 RBI and 3 BB against the Vols.
- \*Georgia has four combined shutouts and been shut out twice. Both losses came on one swing, a one-out, two-run home run in the 4th inning...to No. 16 UCLA (Trevor Brown off Alex Wood while Adam Plutko tossed a CG with 11Ks); UT (Davis Morgan off Michael Palazzone while five UT pitchers limited UGA to six hits).
- \*Georgia is 4-1 in one-run games with three walk-offs (PC, WIU, KSU).
- \*Georgia's 23-6 win over Alcorn State (March 14th) marked the Most Runs in a game by an SEC team this year while Georgia and UT combined for the Most Hits (28) and Total Bases (40) on March 17.

### Vanderbilt Series

In records dating back to 1950, Georgia leads the series with Vanderbilt 95-77. Last year in Athens, then No. 3 VU won the series 2-1. Georgia won game one 5-4 behind a complete game from **Michael Palazzone** but lost the next two 9-3 and 17-7. At the SEC Tournament, VU posted a 10-0 win. The 2010 series in Nashville was limited to one game (VU 17-5) due to historic flooding.

The 2012 Commodores are off to a slow start at 7-14 overall and 0-3 in the SEC. They were preseason ranked No. 10 featuring six returning starters off their 2011 CWS club. Last weekend, they were swept by top-ranked Florida in Gainesville, falling 10-2, 5-1 and 8-2. The Gators are 20-1. Then this past Tuesday, VU lost a 5-3 decision to Evansville who is 14-7. VU made five errors in the contest. The Commodores are batting .265 with a 5.23 ERA and fielding .951. Junior OF Mike Yastrezemski is the team's leading hitter at .362-3-15 while junior SS Anthony Gomez is next at .361-0-21. The probable rotation will be sophomore LHP Kevin Ziomek (2-2, 4.23 ERA) and freshman RHP Tyler Beede (0-3, 7.71 ERA) and Sunday's starter is TBA. Beede was the only first round draft pick not to sign in last year's draft. He was the No. 21 overall selection (Toronto Blue Jays).

**Did You Know?**

\*For the second year in a row, Georgia is on pace to set a school record for **Fielding Percentage**. Currently, they are at .978, last year's mark was .974.

\*All 12 of Georgia's home runs this season have come in Wins

\*The school record for shutouts in a season is 13 by the 1908 Southern Champions. The modern record is 8 by the 2006 club. The 2012 Bulldogs already have 4 combined shutouts.

\*Georgia played **21 of its first 22 games at home** this season, the lone road date was a neutral site contest on March 6 at Coolray Field in Lawrenceville, Ga. Georgia went 16-6 in this opening stretch.

\*Redshirt sophomore LHP **Alex Wood** fanned a career-high 14 in eight shutout innings of a 4-1 win over Western Illinois on March 2 to earn SEC Pitcher of the Week Honors. It was the most strikeouts by a Bulldog since 2006 when Brooks Brown blanked Tennessee 3-0.

**Malooof The Key To The Bullpen In 2011: Finished 3rd Nationally With 18 Saves**

Georgia begins the 2012 season without its closer in **Tyler Malooof**, who is sidelined with a lat injury (strained muscle in his right side). He was one of the nation's top closers in 2011. He finished 18-for-19 in save opportunities including converting his first 16 chances. His lone miss came against #3 Vanderbilt on May 21st. Malooof's tally tied the school record (Joshua Fields, 2008 MLB 1st Round Pick of Seattle). The SEC record is 21 held by Blake Taylor (South Carolina, 2002).

A 6-1, 185-pound native of Winder, Ga., Malooof did not pitch in 2010 and logged just 2.2 innings as a freshman in 2009. Due to injuries/illness, 2011 marked his first full season since his junior year at Norcross High School. One of his best series last year came against #24 Miss. State. He registered saves in all three games to help Georgia post its first SEC sweep since 2009. For his efforts against MSU, he was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week on April 4. He tossed 2.1 innings, did not allow any hits, runs or walks and struck out one. Like a lot of closers at any level, he was not very effective in non-save situations. This accounted for his 7.16 ERA.
