ABOUT ARKANSAS

- Arkansas ranks second in the SEC for field goal percentage defense (all games). The Razorbacks are holding opponents to .345 from the floor. Arkansas is first this week in three-point field goal defense at .250. Opponents are 59-236 from beyond the arc.
- Calli Berna ranks third in the SEC (all games) in assists with 6.1 per game.
- Sarah Watkins leads the SEC (all games) shooting .891 from the line. Watkins is 57-for-64. She is 15th in the court from the line.
- Arkansas is tied for third in SEC only games in scoring defense holding opponents to 55.7 percent.
- Arkansas leads the SEC in offensive rebounds this week averaging 16.0 per game.
- In SEC only games, Calli Berna is third in assists (6.0 apg), Sarah Watkins is fourth in free throw shooting (.933), Quistelle Williams is second in offensive rebounds (4.3 per game), and Berna is first in minutes played (39.3)
- Head coach Tom Collen is 323-139 (.699) overall in all games in 15 seasons.
- Collen is 106-69 in six seasons at Arkansas (100th vs. Pepperdine). He is the third coach with 100 wins in program history.
- Collen has taken Arkansas to three postseason appearances (WNIT, 2009, 2011; NCAA Second Round, 2012).
- Sarah Watkins has had 11 games in double figure scoring this year
- Quistelle Williams has nine games in double figure scoring this year...Williams had double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds at Tulsa...Posted a career-best 18 points against MVSU...Third double-double of career with 10 points and 11 rebounds versus CSU....Fourth with 13 points and 12 boards against LSU.
- Senior Sarah Watkins (second-team) and sophomore Calli Berna (all-freshman team) were both All-SEC selections in 2012.
- Sarah Watkins became the 26th player in program history to score at least 1,000 career points. She finished the LSU game with eight points for 1,175 career points in 113 games. She ranks 18th in program history.
- Sarah Watkins ranks tied for 19th in career rebounds with 533 in 113 games.
- Sarah Watkins ranks second in career blocked shots with 178.
- Sarah Watkins is the 17th player in program history to reach the 1,000 point, 500 rebound plateau.
- Arkansas has won 10 tips (Tulsa, Hawai'i, Pepperdine, Furman, MVSU, NSU, CSU, Auburn, TAMU, LSU).
- Arkansas is 12-1 when leading at half (lost to Auburn)... 1-0 when tied and 0-2 when trailing at half.
- Arkansas has had 10 games with at least three players scoring double figures.
- Arkansas has scored 70+ points 10 times this year...80+ five times...90+ twice this year.
- Arkansas is 209-77 in 20 seasons in Bud Walton Arena.
- Arkansas is 43-1 in non-conference games at Bud Walton under Tom Collen (loss to Missouri December 2007).
- Arkansas has won 29 consecutive non-conference games in Bud Walton.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

The University of Arkansas women's basketball team earned their first SEC win on Thursday, defeating the LSU Tigers 63-54 at Bud Walton Arena. The Razorbacks were propelled by a career high 14 points by senior Erin Gatling, and Quistelle Williams' third double-double of the season. Arkansas improved to 13-3, 1-2 SEC. Making her first start at Arkansas, Gatling displayed a strong shooting touch all night. She made her first four shots, including a career high in three pointers made with three. Gatling finished the game with 14 points, and added two steals and two assists. Senior Sarah Watkins continues to lead the team with 13.2 points per game followed by junior Keira Peak with 12.4 ppg and 6.4 rebounds per game. Senior Williams is also in double figures with 10.3 ppg and leads Arkansas with 6.9 rpg this year.

GATLINGS STEPS IN AND STARS

Against LSU, Erin Gatling became the third different player to start at the shooting guard spot this season. The senior, who was making her first career start at Arkansas, responded with a career high 14 points. Gatling made her first four shots, including a career high three made three pointers. She also added two steals and two assists. Gatling (Van Buren) combined with point guard Calli Berna (Fayetteville) to give the Razorbacks and all-Arkansas native backcourt. The duo combined for 21 points, 10 assists, four steals, and four rebounds. The scoring represented the highest total from the starting guards since the opener, when Berna scored a career high 22 points and Kelsey Hatcher added nine points against Jackson State.

DOUBLING UP

Quistelle Williams had 13 points and a career high 12 rebounds against LSU, giving her three double-doubles this season and four for her career. Williams and Keira Peak are tied for the season high with three double-doubles, while Sarah Watkins has the most career with seven. Williams has three games with double digit rebounds this season, recording a double-double each time.

FRESHMEN CONTRIBUTIONS

A trio of freshmen has made contributions for the Razorbacks this season - redshirt freshman Joey Bailey and true freshmen Dominique Wilson and Melissa Wolff. Wolff's role has increased lately since a season / career best 15 points in a road win over Furman. In her last six games Wolff has averaged 18.3 minutes, and has recorded 5.3 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, including a career high 11 rebounds at Auburn. She also has recorded five steals and four blocks in those games. Wilson has made five starts at guard already, stepping in at the shooting guard spot five times in the past nine games. Bailey has also provided a lift off the bench, getting back to action after taking a medical redshirt after playing eight games last season.

RAZORBACKS VERSUS RANKED TEAMS

Arkansas has played three games against ranked teams this season - at home against No. 17 Kansas and No. 24 Texas A&M, and in Hawaii against No. 13 Oklahoma. In those games, they have been led by their key players stepping up with strong performances. Keira Peak had a career high 30 points against the Sooners, and averages 17 points and 6.67 rebounds against ranked teams. Calli Berna has been sharp on both ends against ranked teams, averaging 11 points, 4 rebounds, 5.3 assists, and 2.67 steals. Sarah Watkins has averaged 13 points in three games against ranked opponents, including 19 points versus Texas A&M.

PEAK PLAYS ON

Keira Peak got off to a hot start this season, exploding for a career high 30 points against No. 13 Oklahoma and being named MVP of the Waikiki Beach Marriott Classic by scoring 70 points over three games. Since then, she has settled into a consistent pace both on the scoreboard and on the glass. She has recorded seven points and four rebounds in ten consecutive games. Peak is second on the team in both scoring (12.4 points per game) and rebounding (6.4 rebounds per game).

ABOUT TOM COLLEN

When Tom Collen answered the call to return to the University of Arkansas, he knew he was coming home.

The seventh head coach in Razorback history, Collen served as the first assistant head coach during the mid-1990s.

His recruiting work led to one of the greatest moments in Arkansas history - the 1998 Final Four.

His recruits were the key to a golden age of women's basketball at Arkansas in the mid-to-late 1990s. It would be the same process in the 21st century, and Collen got to work immediately.

The fall signees for the Class of 2008 put the Razorbacks among the top 25 in recruiting.

By January 2008, Collen had the current Razorbacks in The Associated Press Top 25. That made Collen only the ninth coach in women's college basketball history to take three different programs into the AP rankings, and he had done it in only 10 seasons.

In his five seasons with the Razorbacks, Collen has coached six all-Southeastern Conference selections including SEC Co-Freshman of the Year C'eira Ricketts and the SEC's Sixth Player of the Year Charity Ford.

His Arkansas teams have produced one WNBA draft selection, nine All-SEC selections, five league community service team picks and several SEC Players of the Week and made four postseason appearances.

Arkansas || Five Seasons (2007-present) || 93-66 (.585)

Returned to Arkansas as head coach, and had an immediate impact with a top 25 recruiting class. His first Razorback team broke the school record for consecutive wins with a 15-0 start and AP ranking before season-ending injuries took the roster down to nine scholarship players.

BALANCED LEADERS

This season Arkansas has had a variety of different players step up to lead the team in scoring and rebounding. Eight different players have led Arkansas in points this season – led by Sarah Watkins who has had the team lead six different times. There have been eight different leading rebounders this season – led by Keira Peak who has paced the team six different times.

THE SEC OPENERS

Arkansas has struggled in SEC openers winning just four since joining the league in 1992. The Razorbacks are 4-18 in SEC openers; 1-12 in SEC road openers and 3-7 in SEC home openers.

Arkansas is 0-6 in SEC openers under current head coach Tom Collen losing to No. 11 LSU, at Kentucky, Florida, at No. 22 Florida, at No. 17/15 Georgia and at Auburn.

The Razorbacks are 1-5 under Collen in SEC home openers. The lone win came in 2010-11 when Arkansas, ranked No. 25 at the time, defeated No. 10/11 Kentucky 78-67. The losses have come at the hands of No. 11 LSU, LSU, Florida, No. 6/7 Tennessee and No. 24 Texas A&M.

THE BRIGHT SIDE OF THE OPENERS

Arkansas started the year 0-4 in the SEC last season and went on to win a program-best 10 conference games. Arkansas posted it's best-ever finish in the SEC, went into the SEC Tournament as a four-seed and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament despite the tough start.

ABOUT SARAH WATKINS

Sarah Watkins slipped over the 1,000 point career scoring plateau with a 25-point effort in a win at Hawai'i in Honolulu. Watkins, a Germantown, Tenn., native, begin the 2012-13 season with 962 points. She scored 211 points in 16 games moving to 1,175 in 112 career games. Watkins became the 27th player in program history to score at least 1,000 career points for the Razorbacks. As a freshman, Watkins scored 176 points. She upped that to 458 points as a sophomore and had 330 last year as a junior.

In addition to scoring, Watkins is a solid rebounder. She has 533 career boards reaching the 500 milestone with her eighth rebound against Mississippi Valley State. She is the 21st player to go over the 500 career rebounding mark. Watkins became the 17th player in program history to go over 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds.

WATKINS CAN BLOCK SHOTS

Watkins is also pretty good at blocking shots. She currently ranks second in program history with 178 career blocks. Delmonica DeHorney (87-91) holds the school record with 235 career blocked shots. Watkins blocked five shots against Coppin State, a season-best, and one off her career best of six set a couple of times, most recently against No. 25/22 Vanderbilt last year.

FINE FROM THE PINE

Senior Sarah Watkins has been the starter at the post for much of her career at Arkansas. Early this season, however, Watkins has found herself with limited minutes due to foul trouble. She has fouled out twice and had two other games with four fouls this year. As a result, Collen did not start Watkins against Hawai'i and the senior answered with a career-best tying 25 points against the Rainbow Wahine, 14 in the win over Oregon and 12 in the win over TSU. She has been coming in off the bench ever since. Watkins is averaging 15.2 ppg off the bench.

A WOLFF ON THE FLOOR

Melissa Wolff posted a season/career-best with 15 points in Arkansas' 35-point road win over Furman. Arkansas came off of finals this week and Wolff lead four players in double figures with 15. Her five field goals made tie her season/career-best. Her five free throws and six free throw attempts are season/career-bests and two steals ties her season/career-best. Wolff has scored in double-figures twice this year and has played in every game averaging 18.0 minutes per game this season. Wolff posted a career-best 11 boards at Auburn,

Arkansas ranks 15th in the country this week in scoring margin with a +18.0 mark. The Razorbacks have outscored opponents 1157-869 this season. The Razorbacks are 20th in the country in assist-turnover ratio with a 1.09 average and 19th in turnover margin with a 6.0 average. Arkansas ranks 18th in the country in three-point field goal defense allowing just 25.0 per game and are 31st in the nation in scoring offense (72.3 ppg) and 33rd in field goal percentage defense (34.5) this week.

ARKANSAS INDIVIDUALS IN THE NCAA STATS

Sophomore Calli Berna ranks seventh in the country this week in assist turnover ratio, averaging 2.77 margin. Berna is 20th in the country in assists per game with 6.1 per contest and she is 76th in the nation with 2.75 steals per game this week. Senior Sarah Watkins ranks 15th in the country shooting 89.1 percent from the free throw line.

WATKINS 13TH; PEAK T14TH IN THE SEC

Senior Sarah Watkins leads Arkansas and ranks tied for 13th in the SEC averaging 13.2 points per game this season. Watkins has scored 211 points - 77 twos and 57 points from the free throw line this year. Junior Keira Peak is 20th in the SEC this week in scoring. The Clyatteville, Ga., native averages 12.4 points per game. Peak has scored 199 points -- 74 field goals, 16 threes and 35 free throws -- in 16 games.

The Razorbacks are tough defenders against the three point shot as well. They rank first in the SEC allowing just 25.0 percent of shots from beyond the arc. Arkansas has allowed 59 of 236 attempts this year.

TIED FOR THIRD IN ASSISTS/TURNOVERS

Arkansas ranks tied for third in the SEC in assist/turnover ratio this week. The Razorbacks check in with a 1.1 a/t ratio with 249 assists and 228 turnovers. The Razorbacks also rank fifth in the SEC in turnover margin (+6.0).

ABOUT VANDERBILT

- Vanderbilt is 12-4, 2-1 in the SEC. They are unbeaten at home this season at 7-0, have won 12 straight home games, and are 25-2 at home over the past two seasons.
- The Commodores are led by the duo of Tiffany Clarke and Christina Foggie. Clarke leads the team with 15.8 points per game and 8.0 rebounds per game, while Foggie is right behind her with 15.1 points per game.
- In their previous game, a 64-48 loss to South Carolina, Foggie reached the 1,000 point plateau for her career.

Arkansas has had 14 wins in a single season at Bud twice including the team's 14-2 mark last year. The Razorbacks set a record with a 15-4 mark in Bud Walton in the 1998-99 season.

RAZORBACKS ON TV

The Razorbacks have seven regular season games scheduled for television this season. Arkansas hosted Kansas, Dec. 6 and Missouri Feb. 17 in games that air on COX in a regional market.
