WE ARE "ETSU"

The ETSU Department of Intercollegiate Athletics would like to ask both the print and broadcast media to honor our request to be called "ETSU" throughout the 2019 season. East Tennessee State in first reference is acceptable, but subsequent references should be ETSU. On TV graphics, please use ETSU. Our full nickname is the Buccaneers, but "Bucs" is also encouraged.

NEW LOOK BUCS

The Bucs had a large turnover in players this past season, bringing in 25 newcomers to join 10 returners. Sixteen of the newcomers are freshman, eight are junior transfers and one is a sophomore transfer.

HOW SWEEP IT IS

ETSU has swept its first three weekend series against Iona, Wagner and LIU-Brooklyn, marking ETSU's first time sweeping three consecutive opponents, according to available records dating back to 1983.

With three wins over Iona to open the season, ETSU Baseball earned its first season-opening three game sweep since 2005 against Niagara. After sweeping Iona and Wagner the first two weekends, ETSU picked up its first back-to-back weekend sweeps since 2016 over VMI and Samford.

THREE WINNING SEASONS?

After recording winning seasons each in 2017 and 2018, the Bucs will look to make it three winning seasons in a row for the first time since the 1981-83 seasons. In those years, ETSU went 44-17, 34-19 and 20-18, respectively. In 2017, ETSU finished 30-29 and in 2018 began the Joe Pennucci era with a 28-25 mark.

SERIES HISTORY

The Bucs and Commodores will meet for the fifth time in history, as Vanderbilt holds a 4-0 lead in the all-time series.

ETSU lost a two-game set in 1995, dropped a close 5-4 contest in 2003 and last faced No. 2 Vandy during the 2013 NCAA Tournament in the Nashville regional — ETSU's last appearance in an NCAA Regional while a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference.

SPEED KILLS

The Bucs ranked 10th in the nation in stolen bases with 19 through eight games. Eight different players have swiped a base this year, led by Ethan Cady with six. Furthermore, ETSU has only been caught stealing four times in 24 attempts. The Bucs had 44 steals last season.

BEAM AND SMITH NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL SOUTHERN CONFERENCE TEAMS

Sophomore outfielder David Beam (Knoxville, Tenn.) is poised for a solid spring, as he was named first team all-conference by the coaches. As a freshman, Beam batted .283 in 38 appearances and was one of three Bucs to have an on-base percentage above .400 — finishing at .401. Beam batted .292 in 19 conference appearances last season.

Junior infielder Cullen Smith (Lebanon, Tenn.) was chosen to the all-conference second team after ending 2018 on the second team. Smith hit .295 last year in 46 starts, while tying for the team lead with eight stolen bases. The junior reached base in 27 straight games near the end of last season, the second-longest streak on the team.

KICKING INTO 'GREER'

Junior catcher Jackson Greer was named SoCon Player of the Week for opening weekend as ETSU faced Iona. Greer batted in the cleanup spot and three hole for the first time in his career this weekend and finished 5-for-12 with a grand slam, a two-run bomb, a run-scoring triple and nine RBI. He leads the Bucs with four HRs, 16 RBI and a .775 slugging pct.

COVERING THE MAP

ETSU Head Coach Joe Pennucci jokingly told the media this past offseason that he would "travel to Pluto" to get the right player for his team. Staying in North America, Pennucci added players from 11 states/districts/provinces for this season's roster.

FROM HILLTOPPERS TO BUCS

The Bucs may be wide-spread this year, but still have two prominent pitchers locally from Johnson City in redshirt-senior Daniel Sweeney and junior transfer Landon Knack. The Science Hill High School graduates both started the 2018 season as weekend starters and each have sub-3.00 ERA's so far.

FROM THE CONCRETE JUNGLE TO THE SMOKY MOUNTAINS

Coach Pennucci put his Stony Brook roots to use for his schedule in year two, welcoming New York/New Jersey schools Iona, Wagner, LIU Brooklyn and NJIT from his former stomping grounds in Long Island. ETSU has faced these four opponents a combined five times, with four matchups against Wagner and one against LIU Brooklyn.

MARQUEE MATCHUPS

This season, ETSU will continue its traditional rivalry against in-state rival Tennessee with a home-and-home. The Bucs also traveled to Virginia Tech for its first midweek Feb. 19 before later the team later hosts the Hokies in Johnson City on April 10.

The Bucs also added a couple of top contenders to its schedule for road midweek games, including preseason No. 1 and SEC favorite Vanderbilt on March 6 and ACC contender No. 14 Clemson on Feb. 26.

JUNIOR HEAVY LINEUP

With only three seniors — all pitchers — ETSU has used at least six juniors in every lineup, including Jake Lyle, Ethan Cady, Cullen Smith, Jackson Greer, Noah Hill and Cade Gilbert. Tyler Cox started in Game One to make out a seven-junior lineup.

BACK IN THE MIX

Despite a new-look squad, the Bucs were picked fourth in the SoCon preseason coaches poll behind only Samford, UNCG and Mercer, edging Wofford. In the media poll, ETSU was picked to finish fifth behind Wofford with the top three the same as the coaches poll.

SENIOR TRIFECTA

Only three seniors highlight the ETSU roster in 2019, all three of which are RHPs. The list includes fifth-year Buc Daniel Sweeney, Friday ace Micah Kaczor and primary closer James Giambalvo.

GIAMBALVO NAMED TO STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCHLIST

Senior closer James Giambalvo was one of 75 pitchers named to the initial Stopper of the Year preseason watchlist, an award given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Baseball. Last season, Giambalvo had six saves and a 3.38 ERA through 37.1 innings, racking up 38 K's.

NOTHING WILD

This season, ETSU's pitching staff has put an emphasis on control while also having defensive-minded backstop Jackson Greer behind the dish. ETSU has only thrown two wild pitches through 11 games so far.

HOW DOES THIS ROSTER SIZE UP TO THE LAST 30 SEASONS?

ETSU's new look roster includes the most incoming talent the program has seen in the last 30 seasons. The 35-man roster is also the second-largest in that 30-year span.

MILLS FAMILY LEGACY

Junior left-handed pitching transfer Hooper Mills comes from a pipeline of baseball talent, as his father, Mike Mills, had a seven-year career with the Toronto Blue Jays and San Diego Padres organizations from 1983-89 — playing as high as AAA. His cousin, Heath Slatton, made it as high as AAA in the San Francisco Giants organization from 2013-17.

SUPER SIXTH

Through 52 games last season, ETSU outscored opponents 47-14 in the 6th inning. The first 6th inning run allowed that year came at Tennessee in the second meeting, snapping a 16-game shutout streak to open 2018. No team scored more than three runs in the sixth inning on ETSU, with the only three-run sixth inning coming in ETSU's final regular series at Wofford.

IMMACULATE INNING

Last season, redshirt-senior RHP Daniel Sweeney used nine pitches against UNC Asheville to record three strikeouts — the nation's first known immaculate inning that season. Tulane's Will McAffer was the only other reported player to record one in the 2018 campaign.

SIX PACK OF HOMERS

In the series opener last season vs. Furman, ETSU jacked six homers to compile a season-high 15 runs in a 15-2 win. The six homers tied an all-time ETSU record for home runs in a single game. The feat has now been accomplished five times, last done on May 11, 2010 vs. UNC Asheville... Eight years from the EXACT DAY.

BUCS PARTNER WITH BRISTOL MOTOR SPEEDWAY

For the second year in a row, the ETSU baseball team and nearby Bristol Motor Speedway partnered together as the Bucs performed workout drills on the racetrack last November.

Last year, the baseball team split into four groups as part of the two-week "Buc Challenge," where each group would compete in drills in a point-based competition. Four of the drills took place at BMS.

This fall, ETSU head coach Joe Pennucci re-implemented the Buc Challenge after a successful first year. Instead of a two-week challenge, the offseason program started in September and will cultivate over two months. Bristol Motor Speedway is one of the final checkpoints.

"We love coming to Bristol Motor Speedway," Pennucci said. "We can't thank the people here enough for us to be able to come out here — especially for me to cruise around here in the pace car and for the guys to push it, slinging some tires around and having a good time."
