THROWING UP ZEROS: Vandy pitching has permitted just six runs in its last 36 innings (four games) while posting a 1.50 ERA and limiting foes to a .163 average.

- ★ Opponents have scored runs in three innings over the last four contests, averaging 1.5 runs per game.
- ★ During that stretch, Vandy posted a 25 scoreless-inning streak, the longest for a Commodore staff since 32 consecutive from March 13-20, 2011.

REVIEWING THE RPI: Vandy is No. 4 nationally in the RPI, jumping 11 spots following a weekend sweep of Florida.

- ★ The Dore's are 8-3 against opponents in the RPI top 50. Vandy's eight wins vs. Top 50 opponents is tied for third nationally with UCLA.
- ★ Lipscomb enters Tuesday at No. 215. The Dore's are 7-0 vs. opponents ranked between 151-297.

LATER GATOR: Vanderbilt is coming off its first sweep of Florida since 2007. The Dore's outscored the Gators 34-6.

- ★ Vandy's 34 runs were the most in an SEC series since scored 48 against Alabama, May 18-20, 2017.
- ★ The Dore's batted .351 in the three games and trailed for just one inning, coming in the third on Saturday.
- ★ The series victory was the Commodores' 50th at Hawkins Field since the start of the 2011 season.

PITCHING PROWESS: Vandy pitching enters Tuesday third nationally with 11.2 strikeouts per nine innings.

- ★ The Dore's have struck out 10-plus batters in 16 of their 24 games including 10 on Saturday vs. Florida.
- ★ In its visit to First Tennessee Park last Tuesday, Vanderbilt fanned 15 Belmont batters, its most since having as many on March 8 against Illinois State.

IN THE RANKINGS: Vanderbilt jumped ahead two spots to No. 6 in the D1Baseball.com rankings on Monday.

- ★ The Commodores have remained in the top 10 throughout the season including five weeks at No. 1.

SENIOR SLUGGER: Senior **Ethan Paul** has been on a tear as the Commodores' seven-hole hitter this season.

- ★ Paul paced Vandy with seven RBIs in the Florida series.
- ★ Paul is the team leader with 12 multi-hit games and is tied for first with eight multi-RBI games.

TABLE SETTERS: Vanderbilt's top of the order -- **Cooper Davis**, **Austin Martin** and **JJ Bleday** -- has batted .380 (100-for-263) with 3.16 runs/game and 2.16 RBIs/game.

- ★ Martin leads the SEC in batting average (.434). Bleday is fifth in total bases (60) and Davis is ninth in hits per game (1.41).

2018 REWIND: Vandy advanced to its seventh NCAA Super Regional in the last nine seasons before falling one win shy of reaching the College World Series. The Dore's won 10 of their final 14 games and finished ranked No. 18.

24 DOWN: Vandy's 19-5 start is its best through 24 games since beginning its 2016 campaign, 20-4. The Dore's finished that season with 47 victories.

- ★ Vanderbilt's .321 average is its highest through 24 games since batting .322 through as many in 2011.
- ★ The Commodores 13-3 record in March is their best since posting the same record through 16 in 2015.

AGAINST LIPSCOMB: Vanderbilt and Lipscomb meet for the 79th time in the history of the programs on Tuesday.

- ★ Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 55-23 but was one-hit by the Bisons in a 5-1 loss a season ago.
- ★ The Commodores are 19-3 against Lipscomb under head coach **Tim Corbin** (2003-present).
- ★ The squads have met at least once each of the last six seasons (2013-present) including at the 2015 NCAA Nashville Regional (9-1, Vanderbilt win).

MR. 700: Head coach **Tim Corbin** captured his 700th win at Vanderbilt with Saturday's 14-2 victory vs. Florida.

- ★ Corbin secured his 800th career win March 10 with a 9-1 result vs. Illinois State, becoming just the 26th active head coach to reach the milestone.
- ★ Corbin is in his 22nd year as a head coach. He has 700 wins at Vanderbilt and 106 at Presbyterian.

OUT OF THE GATE: Vandy has scored in the first inning in 12 of its 24 games including six of the last 12.

- ★ The Dore's are 11-1 when scoring in the first inning.
- ★ **JJ Bleday** delivered a one-out, RBI-double in the first inning on Thursday against No. 14 Florida.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Vanderbilt ranks first in the SEC in on-base percentage (.424) and triples (11). The Dore's are second in batting average (.321), hits (268) and scoring (8.5).

- ★ Vandy has scored five-plus runs 19 times and 10-plus runs 10 times. The Dore's have produced double-digit hit outings in 16 games.

DE-FENSE: Vandy leads the SEC and ranks fifth nationally with a .982 fielding percentage.

- ★ In 2018, Vandy set a new school record and finished fifth nationally with a .981 fielding percentage.
- ★ The Dore's have posted a fielding percentage of .975 or better in five of the last six years.

LET'S PLAY TWO: Due to inclement weather, Vandy has played three doubleheaders this season. That is the most regular season twin bills since playing as many in 2006.

- ★ It is also the most doubleheaders hosted at Hawkins Field (2002-present) in a single season.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Vanderbilt's current streak of 13 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the longest in the SEC and the third-longest nationally, trailing only Florida State (41) and Cal State Fullerton (27).

NO. 4, MR. TIM CORBIN: Head coach **Tim Corbin** is in his 17th season (2003-present) at the helm. Corbin has led the Commodores to 14 NCAA Tournaments, eight Super Regionals, three College World Series, one national championship (2014) and one runner-up (2015).

- ★ Corbin is 700-347-1 (.668) at Vandy and became the program's all-time winningest coach with a 9-4 victory on March 4, 2018 against Houston.
- ★ Under Corbin, 40 players have been named an All-American including 11 who have received first-team recognition.
- ★ In the Corbin era, 22 players have gone on to play in the Major Leagues, the most in the SEC since 2003.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: Vanderbilt's freshman class was ranked No. 2 nationally by Baseball America.

- ★ Six players appeared on the 2018 BA500, which ranks the best 500 players in the draft class.
- ★ Eight freshmen made their collegiate debuts on opening weekend. **Justyn-Henry Malloy** registered a pinch-hit RBI single and **Sterling Hayes** scored a run among notables.

DORES ON TOP: In Sept. 2017, D1Baseball.com recognized Vanderbilt as the No. 2 program nationally in the publication's bi-annual Top 100 rankings.

- ★ The list is designed to assess the overall health of programs in the current era with the ultimate goal of identifying "the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye towards the next five to 10 years."
- ★ The Commodores were ranked the nation's top program in D1Baseball's inaugural rankings (2015).

WELCOME TO THE HAWK: The Commodores have been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002. Vanderbilt boasts a 450-161-1 (.736) all-time record at its home including a 343-102-1 (.770) mark since the start of the 2007 season.

- ★ The Dores won 6-of-7 regular season three-game home series in 2018 and have won 50-of-63 three-game sets at The Hawk since 2011.

SENIOR LEADERS: Vandy's five-member senior class is its largest since carrying seven in 2008. The class includes OF **Walker Grisanti**, 1B **Julian Infante**, SS **Ethan Paul**, RHP **Patrick Raby** and UTL **Stephen Scott**.

- ★ The unit has helped Vandy to 133 victories, three NCAA Regionals and two Super Regionals. The unit is looking for its first trip to the College World Series.

VETERAN PRESENCE: Vanderbilt returns eight positional starters and four starting pitchers from last season.

- ★ Offensively, 2019 returners contributed 80.5% of runs scored, 82.6% of hits, 82.7% of extra-base hits, 82% of RBIs and 72% of stolen bases in 2018.
- ★ Returning pitchers totaled 90% of starts, 85.7% of wins, 80% of innings pitched and 77% of strikeouts.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION: Vandy led the nation as four student-athletes were named to the 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American Team. **Philip Clarke**, **Pat DeMarco**, **Mason Hickman** and **Austin Martin** -- all returning for 2019 -- were recognized for their efforts.

FIRST FOR FIRST ROUND PICKS: Vanderbilt leads the SEC with 22 MLB first-round draft picks (including first-round supplemental picks). Vandy is one of two universities to produce multiple No. 1 picks with **David Price** in 2007 and **Dansby Swanson** in 2015.

FAR AND WIDE: The 2019 roster features players from 14 different states as well as one (**Cooper Davis**) from Ontario, Canada. In total, 12 players hail from Tennessee and another eight call Florida home.

- ★ Three Commodores are from Ohio while two players are represented from California, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York.

MAJOR LEAGUE DORES: In total, 13 former players made a MLB appearance in 2018, a mark that ranks second nationally and first in the SEC.

- ★ The Dores led the nation with seven pitchers who made an MLB start and eight with an appearance.
