QUICK HITTERS

- ★ Vanderbilt moved to 34-49 all-time in the SEC Tournament with the win over Georgia, and advanced to the finals of the SEC Tournament for the first time since 1951. Vanderbilt won their only finals appearance, 61-57, over Kentucky.
- ★ The Commodores swept the season series with Ole Miss, 2-0, with the win Saturday.
- ★ VU moves to 13-6 with starting lineup of Brad Tinsley, John Jenkins, Jeffery Taylor, Lance Goulbourne, and Festus Ezeli.
- ★ In two SEC Tournament games, Vanderbilt is allowing an average of 47.0 points per game, and opponents have shot only 36.0% from the floor and 20% from three.
- ★ In the second half of the two VU tournament games, Vanderbilt is outscoring its opponent by an average of 16.3 points and the Commodores are shooting 50.9% from the field.
- ★ The Commodores are now 18-5 in games in which leading at the half.
- ★ The Commodores, who entered the game shooting 40% from three in all games and 42.3% in league games only, have only converted on 27.8% of its shots from three.
- ★ Vanderbilt outrebounded Ole Miss, 36-29, including 12-4 on the offensive glass. The Commodores outscored the Rebels, 9-4, in second-chance points.
- ★ VU outscored Ole Miss, 16-9, in points off of turnovers.
- ★ The Commodores only committed 11 turnovers against Ole Miss, and 19 in two games at the SEC tournament.
- ★ The Commodores sport the leading scorer in all games and in SEC games only in John Jenkins at 20.0 and 19.3 ppg, respectively, and the league's second-leading scorer in all games (16.3) and in SEC games only in Jeffery Taylor (16.8). Jenkins also paces the league and nation in threes made at 3.9 per game.
- ★ Vanderbilt moved to 4-0 on neutral floors with win over Ole Miss.

MORE ON THE KENTUCKY SERIES

(UK Leads 4-3 at SEC Tourney)

★ Kentucky leads the overall series 135-43, including a 79-14 advantage in Lexington, 49-26 lead in Nash-ville and 6-3 edge at neutral sites

★ UK swept the season series, winning at Memorial Gym on Feb. 11, 69-63, and claiming the meeting at Rupp Arena, 83-74, on Feb. 25

★ Kentucky eliminated Vanderbilt from the 2003 SEC Tournament, 81-63 on March 14 in the last tournament meeting

★ Vanderbilt's 43 wins against Kentucky rank second most among SEC members behind only Tennessee (64)

★ Kevin Stallings is 9-18 against Kentucky.

MORE NOTES FROM WIN OVER OLE MISS

- John Jenkins led three players in double figures with 23 points. Jenkins was 7-16 from the field and 5-13 from three. Brad Tinsley scored 12 points and Lance Goulbourne added his sixth career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds.
- Jenkins now has 126 made threes in 2011-12, and has the second-best single season total in Vanderbilt and SEC history. Shan Foster had 134 threes in 2007-08.
- He has now scored in double-digits in 66 consecutive games and made a three-point basket in 53 straight.
- Jenkins has made three or more threes in 28 games this year.
- Tinsley added his second consecutive 12-point game.
- Goulbourne's 10 points was his fifth double digit scoring game in the last six contests. His 12 rebounds also led the team. Goulbourne has 15 career double-digit rebounding games.
- Jeffery Taylor and Festus Ezeli, VU's second and third leading scorers this season, combined for only two points in the win over Ole Miss.
- Goulbourne added three steals.

VANDERBILT ATHLETIC SUCCESS IN 2011

During the 2011 calendar year, Vanderbilt was one of only eight schools in the country, and one of two in the SEC, that had its baseball team and men's and women's basketball teams in the NCAA Tournament and its football team qualify for a bowl game. Georgia is the other school from the SEC to accomplish the feat. Other schools that join Vanderbilt include Florida State, Kansas State, North Carolina, Texas, future SEC member Texas A&M, and UCLA.

3-POINT STREAK CONTINUES THROUGH 25TH SEASON; VU ONE OF THREE TEAMS TO HIT A TREY IN EVERY GAME SINCE 1986-87 SEASON

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 829 consecutive games, a streak which began at the incep-
tion of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV (839) for the longest
streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton (725) are the only three schools in
college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line
was implemented.

JENKINS, TAYLOR MAKE FIRST-TEAM ALL-SEC, TAYLOR MAKES ALL-DEFENSIVE TEAM

Junior guard John Jenkins and senior forward Jeffery Taylor were named as first-team All-SEC
selections by the league's coaches, and Taylor was also named to the All-SEC Defensive Team.

The award is Jenkins' second first-team selection (other was in 2011), and his fourth end-of-
the-year honor from the SEC. Jenkins was named to the All-Freshman team in 2010 and was also
named the league's sixth man of the year in 2010.

Taylor's first-team honor is his first of his Vanderbilt career. The senior forward was named to
the All-Freshman team in 2009, and the All-SEC second team in 2010 and 2011. Taylor's selection
to the All-Defensive team is the third time he has been named to the team. He joins Mississippi
State's Jarvis Varnado as the only player to be named to three teams.

VANDERBILT VS. NUMBER ONES

Vanderbilt has a 7-16 all-time record against teams ranked #1 in the Associated Press poll, and a 1-0 record on neutral floors. Ironically, Vanderbilt's only win over a number one-ranked opponent on a neutral floor came in the Commodores' last trip the SEC Finals in 1951.

RECORD AGAINST KENTUCKY WHEN WILDCATS ARE #1

The Commodores have faced Kentucky 16 times when the Wildcats were number one, and have a 4-12 record against UK in those games. VU is 3-5 in games played at Memorial, 1-0 in neutral site games, and 0-7 in games played in Lexington.

JEFFERY TAYLOR QUICK FACTS

- ★ Jeffery Taylor is third on Vanderbilt's all-time scoring list and leads all active scorers in the SEC with 1,852 career points.
- ★ Taylor finished the season second in league games only in 3FG % at 48.8 (39-80)%.
- ★ Taylor also finished third in the SEC in league games only in threes made (2.4).
- ★ Taylor is the only player in school history to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounds, and steals.

COACH STALLINGS WINS 20 GAMES FOR SEVENTH TIME IN NINE YEARS

Vanderbilt head coach Kevin Stallings won his 20th game against South Carolina on February 22, marking the seventh time in the last nine years he has accomplished the feat. Stallings is now Vanderbilt's all-time leader in 20-win seasons. The Commodore mentor is in his 13th season and is Vanderbilt's second winningest coach in Commodore history with 257 career victories. Overall, Stallings is in his 18th season and has a career record of 380-220.

20-WIN SEASONS AND THE SEC

The Commodores' seven 20-win seasons in the last nine years is only third to Florida, who has had nine, and Kentucky, who has had eight. Other school totals: Miss. St. (6), Tennessee (5), Ole Miss (4), S. Carolina (4), LSU (3), Alabama (3), Arkansas (3), Auburn (1), Georgia (1).

THREE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

Brad Tinsley scored 16 points against Monmouth and became the 43rd person to eclipse the 1,000-point barrier, and the second VU player this season to accomplish the feat. John Jenkins recently surpassed the 1,000-point mark to become the 42nd player earlier this year against Cleveland State. Jeffery Taylor is the third player in this year's starting lineup who has 1,000 points - he became the 41st player in Vanderbilt history to surpass the 1,000-point barrier last season.

The 'Dores are the only team in the SEC with three 1,000-point scorers.

VANDERBILT AND THE SEC

Vanderbilt is in its 78th season in the Southeastern Conference and has a career record of 652-639 against current members of the SEC.

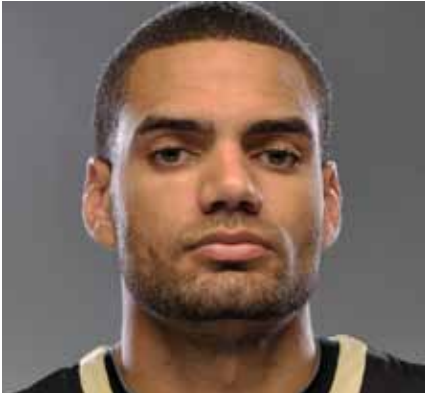
