Johnson has the potential to score, if his high school career is of any indication. The Lewisburg, Tenn., native averaged 27.3 points, 10.0 rebounds, and 8.0 assists in his senior season at Marshall County High School, where he departed as the school's all-time leading scorer. |
| 832 | Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 832 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented. |

Starters

Juniors Rod Odom and Kyle Fuller, sophomores Kedren Johnson and Shelby Moats, and freshman Kevin Bright started in both games for the Commodores in the exhibition season.

Notes

Kedren Johnson paced the Commodores in the two exhibition games with an 18.5 points per game average. He also averaged 5.0 rebounds per game. Vanderbilt had three other players average double figures in the exhibition games - forward Rod Odom, who averaged 14.5 points, forward James Siakam, who averaged 11.0 points, and guard Kyle Fuller, who averaged 10.5 points per game.

Fuller led the team with nine assists in the two games. He also averaged five rebounds per game.

Vanderbilt shot 44.9% from the floor in the two games, but could only muster 22% from beyond-the-arc. Odom led the Commodores from three, making four-of-eight (50%).

The Commodores outrebounded their two exhibition opponents by an average of 15.5 rebounds per game (42 to 26.5).

Vanderbilt shot 69.5% from the charity stripe in the two games.

The Commodores averaged 13.0 turnovers per game in the two games. Point guard Kedren Johnson had eight in the first game against St. Xavier, but only turned it over one time against Delta State.

The stellar performance of the exhibition season came from redshirt sophomore James Siakam, who came off of the bench against St. Xavier and tallied a double-double in the first half with 10 points and 11 rebounds and ended the contest with 22 points and 17 rebounds, 11 offensive, in 27 minutes of action. Before the game, Siakam had only six career points in 25 total minutes.

MEMORIAL MAGIC - THE HOME TO VANDERBILT HOOPS SINCE 1952

HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 61ST SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 61st season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 850 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renowned for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.
