Freshman post player Damian Jones had an outstanding freshman campaign, and was named to the All-SEC Freshman team by the league's coaches to prove it. He averaged 11.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per contest, scored in double figures in 20 games last year, and had five double-doubles on the season. The big man from Baton Rouge, La., also blocked 43 shots in his freshman campaign, which tied him for ninth on the single-season Vanderbilt all-time list.

Vanderbilt has made a 3-pointer in 896 consecutive games, a streak which began at the inception of the 3-point line in 1986-87. The Commodores rank second only to UNLV for the longest streak in Division I basketball. Vanderbilt, UNLV and Princeton are the only three schools in college basketball to have made at least one 3-pointer in every game played since the 3-point line was implemented.

Head Coach Kevin Stallings, the school's all-time winningest coach, returns for his 16th season with the Commodores and 21st overall as a head coach. Stallings has 292 career wins at Vanderbilt and 415 overall as a head coach. He has seven 20-win seasons in the last 10 seasons, with six NCAA tournament appearances and two Sweet 16's (2004 and 2007). Stallings has the most 20-win campaigns in Vanderbilt history.



Jones comes to coach the Commodores after spending a successful four year stint at Louisiana Tech, which included a historic run in Ruston in which he helped guide the Bulldogs to a record 56 wins in the last two seasons. |

HISTORIC MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM IN 63RD SEASON

Storied Memorial Gymnasium is in its 63rd season as the host venue of Vanderbilt basketball. The SEC's most historic hoops setting has played host to more than 850 men's contests as well as the 1984 and 1991 SEC Tournaments and 40 men's and women's NCAA Tournament contests (since the early 1980s).

As the oldest gymnasium in the SEC, Memorial Gymnasium is renowned for its end zone benches, raised floor and unique atmosphere. It was dedicated in 1952 as a memorial to all Vanderbilt men and women who served in World War II. It was built by the late master architect Edwin Keeble, who was commissioned to build a combination gymnasium/concert hall.
