#### Quickly

★ Winners of three in a row, the Commodores take on Stanford in the championship game of the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

★ Vanderbilt is 12-5 all-time against this year's field.

★ 2-0 vs. BYU; 3-0 vs. Hawai'i; 2-1 vs. Liberty; 0-0 vs. Northern Iowa; 0-3 vs. Stanford; 2-1 vs. USF, 1-0 vs. Wyoming

#### Series and Hawai'i Info

★ Vanderbilt is 0-3 in the all-time series versus Stanford.

★ The Dores fell to Stanford in regular season games on Dec. 29, 1954 and Dec. 30, 1988.

★ Last time the two sides met was March 24, 2015, a 78-75 Vandy loss in the NIT quarterfinals.

★ This is Vandy's first trip to the state of Hawai'i since 2015, a runner up finish to Kansas at the Maui Invitational.

★ It is Vanderbilt's seventh visit to the The Aloha State (1986, 1988, 1995, 2001, 2009, 2015).

★ The Commodores are 5-2 in Honolulu and 11-7 in the state of Hawai'i.

★ Vandy head coach Jerry Stackhouse was played against Hawai'i while playing at North Carolina. As a sophomore, Stackhouse and the No. 1 ranked Tar Heels secured an 88-76 win at the Stan Sheriff Center on Dec. 22, 1994. North Carolina went on to make the 1995 Final Four. It was the first year of existence for the Stan Sheriff Center.

#### Pippen Ain't East

★ All-America candidate Scotty Pippen Jr. scored his 1,000th career point on Dec. 18 versus Austin Peay.

★ The junior guard is the 50th Commodore to reach 1,000 career points.

★ Vandy's all-time leading scorer is Shan Foster - 2,011 points.

★ Pippen leads the SEC with 18.1 points per game.

#### Last Time Out

★ Scotty Pippen Jr. scored Vandy's last 16 points in a 69-67 win over BYU in Thursday's Diamond Head Classic semifinals.

★ Vandy's defense forced 19 turnovers and is averaging 20 turnovers forced per game in the Diamond Head Classic.

★ The Dores trailed by as many as seven points in the first half.

★ The game featured 13 ties and six lead changes.

★ Myles Stute posted 14 points and a career-high seven rebounds in the win.

#### Dore Notes

★ Vandy has forced 15 or more turnovers in eight games. The Dores have three games with fewer than 10 turnovers.

★ Vandy has had four different players score at least 20 points in a game this season - tied for the second-most in the nation. Scotty Pippen Jr. (5x), Jordan Wright (once), Tyrin Lawrence (once) and Myle Stute (once).

★ Vanderbilt has used just three starting lineups this season. Last season, Vanderbilt used 18 different starting lineups in its 25 games (14 different Commodores started at least one game).

★ Jordan Wright has the longest active games started streak for Vanderbilt at 27 in a row.

★ Trey Thomas has Vandy's longest active games played streak at 37 (every game over the past two seasons).

#### In the Nation

★ Vanderbilt ranks in the top 50 in the nation for these statistical categories.

★ Scoring Defense - 38th - 60.7 ppg

★ FG percentage defense - 50th - 39.1 percent

★ Turnover margin - 24th - 4.6

#### QMB

★ Over this last three games, Quentin Millora-Brown is averaging 8.6 points per game and 11 rebounds per game.

★ After posting a double-double against Austin Peay with 13 points and 14 rebounds, Millora-Brown followed up with nine points and nine rebounds versus Hawai'i. He pulled down 10 boards to go with four points in the win over BYU.
