### TALKING POINTS

- Last time out:** Sophomore guard Jayden Nunn poured in a career-high 24 points and led a late run as VCU rallied past Kennesaw State 64-61 on Nov. 26. Nunn scored 12 second-half points as the Rams rallied from nine points down for the win. Sophomore guard Nick Kern hit a go-ahead free throw with 16.1 seconds left for VCU. The Rams were playing their fourth straight game without point guard Ace Baldwin Jr., who is recovering from surgery to insert two screws into a bone in his right (non-shooting) wrist. Sophomore guard Jamir Watkins also played just six minutes against Kennesaw State while dealing with a bone bruise in his knee. Both players are day-to-day.
- This is the fourth all-time meeting between these two schools. Vandy leads 2-1, but the Rams scored a 48-37 win last season in Nashville.
- Johns has quickly distinguished himself as a Ram. Johns, who is averaging a team-high 12.3 points and 6.7 rebounds, topped double figures in his first five games of the season -- the first Ram to do so in his first five VCU games since Wil Fameni in 2006-07.
- Junior guard Josh Banks, who averaged just 7.6 minutes and 1.6 points per game last season, has provided a lift for the Rams off the bench the past four games. In those contests, Banks is averaging 6.5 points and 18.8 minutes per game, while shooting 4-of-10 from three.
- VCU's defense appears elite again. The Rams currently rank 31st nationally (out of 363 teams) in defensive efficiency (91.8). VCU also ranks 13th in defensive turnover percentage (26.5), 22nd in steal percentage (13.7) and 52nd in effective field goal percentage (45.2).
- VCU has finished 33rd nationally or better in turnover percentage in 10 of the past 11 seasons. The Rams finished in the top 10 in seven of those seasons, including first three times. The Rams are currently 13th in that category. VCU opponents average 18.7 turnovers per game.
- The Rams are taking advantage of the "charity stripe" this season. VCU currently ranks 11th nationally in free throw attempts and 15th in makes per game. The Rams ranked 205th and 215th in those categories last season. Nearly 29 percent of VCU's points this year have come at the line, the third-highest rate in the country.
- The Rams welcome seven newcomers in 2022-23, including transfers Brandon Johns Jr. (Michigan), Zeb Jackson (Michigan) and David Shriver (Hartford), who all expect to play a prominent role, as well as four freshmen.
- The Rams were selected third in the 2022 A-10 Preseason Poll. VCU owns the A-10's highest winning percentage (.704) since joining the league prior to the 2012-13 season. The Rams are 121-51 in regular season play in ten seasons. The Rams have claimed one A-10 Tournament crown (2015) and captured regular season titles in 2016 (shared) & 2019.
- VCU will aim to replace the loss of 2021-22 First Team All-Atlantic 10 selection Vince Williams Jr., who was selected in the second round of the 2022 NBA Draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

# HEAD COACH MIKE RHOADES

## SIXTH SEASON • 106-55 AT VCU (350-183 OVERALL)



Mike Rhoades was named the 12th head coach in VCU history on March 21, 2017. It's Rhoades' second go-around with the Rams. As an assistant and associate head coach with VCU from 2009-14, he helped the Rams kick off an unprecedented run of seven straight NCAA Tournament appearances. He's already set the Rams on a course to reach greater heights.

In just his second season in 2018-19, Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament, as well as their first Atlantic 10 Conference outright regular

season championship. VCU's 25 total wins, including 16 conference victories, tied program regular-season marks. For his efforts, he was named Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year and Richmond Times-Dispatch State Coach of the Year, and was a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 following a 19-7 campaign in which the Black and Gold reached the A-10 Championship Game. In five seasons, 10 Rams have been named to All-Atlantic 10 Conference Teams, including 2021 A-10 Player of the Year Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland, as well as first team selections Marcus Evans, Justin Tillman and Vince Williams Jr.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw back-to-back players selected in the NBA Draft, first when Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and later when Williams was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who all played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant for the Black and Gold, have all reached the NBA as professionals.

Prior to returning to Richmond, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice. As head coach of the Owls from 2014-17, Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls history. Rice advanced to the second round of the College Basketball Invitational that season.

Rhoades assumed the reins at Rice in 2014-15 and led the school to an immediate five-win improvement. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

An astute eye for talent, Rhoades recruited Conference USA Rookie of the Year and 2016-17 First Team selection Evans, a Chesapeake, Va., native and landed Arizona State transfer Egor Koulechov, who ranked fifth in C-USA in scoring in 2016-17, two players who helped spark Rice's dramatic turnaround.

In 18 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades has produced a 346-181 record, a winning percentage of .656.

Rhoades' ties to Central Virginia date back 20 years, including his five seasons at VCU. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. During his tenure, VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship.

As a Ram, Rhoades recruited and molded elite-level talent. He played a pivotal role in the signing and development of future NBA players Weber, Graham and Daniels during his stint on Broad Street, and numerous others have enjoyed successful professional careers overseas.

In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at

Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Va. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003.

Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons. He was named ODAC Coach of the Year in three straight seasons from 2001-03, coached three ODAC Players of the Year, five ODAC Freshmen of the Year, as well as 17 First and Second Team All-ODAC selections. In 2003, he was named NABC South District Coach of the Year and State Coach of the Year by the Richmond Times-Dispatch. He began his coaching career at age 23 as an assistant at Randolph-Macon in 1996 under long-time head coach Hal Nunnally. The Yellow Jackets posted winning records in all three seasons with Rhoades on staff before he was elevated to head coach in 1999 at age 25.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania, and led his squad to a 66-59 overtime win over NYU in the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship Game. The entire team was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in October 2014, the 20th anniversary of the title.

The guard was named USA Today D-III National Player of the Year in 1995 and twice earned All-America honors. He graduated with a degree in history in 1995. He left as the school's all-time scoring leader and still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey was later retired.

Rhoades also earned his masters from VCU's Center for Sport Leadership in 2002.

The Mahanoy City, Pa. native and his wife Jodie have two sons, Logan, and Chase, and one daughter, Porter.

## THE RACE BEGINS

VCU was selected third in the Atlantic 10 Conference's Preseason Poll, the league announced in October ahead of its annual media day at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y. The Rams, who finished 14-4 in league play a year ago, received 370 points in a poll of A-10 coaches and media members. Dayton was tapped as conference preseason favorite, garnering 22 of 29 first-place votes and 428 points, while Saint Louis was second with seven first-place votes and 411 points. Loyola Chicago (315) and George Mason (300) rounded out the top five. The Rams were picked fourth in the 2021 poll and eventually placed second in the A-10 standings.

## WITH HONORS

Two Rams were given Atlantic 10 Conference Preseason awards. Junior point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. was named the A-10's Preseason First Team. The 6-1 lefty was an Atlantic 10 Second Team pick in the spring following a sophomore campaign in which he averaged 11.4 points, 5.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game. Baldwin was also selected to the league's Preseason All-Defensive Team.

In addition, sophomore guard Jayden Nunn was also named Preseason Third Team. The 6-4 combo guard burst onto the scene in 2021-22 and averaged 8.6 points and 2.5 rebounds per game, while shooting .360 (32-of-89) from 3-point range. Nunn's rookie campaign included a 21-point effort against 22nd-ranked UConn at the Battle 4 Atlantis, as well as an 18-point effort at Wake Forest in the second round of the Postseason NIT. Nunn was named to the league's All-Rookie Team in 2021-22.

## TRANSFERS OF POWER

The Rams have reloaded through the transfer portal. VCU welcomes three

transfers for the 2022-23 season: Senior forward Brandon Johns Jr. and junior guard Zeb Jackson from Michigan, as well as senior sharpshooter David Shriver from Hartford.

Johns played four seasons at Michigan, where he helped the Wolverines to three NCAA Tournament appearances, including two Sweet 16s and an Elite Eight. A veteran of 117 games, including 25 starts, Johns averaged 10.0 points and 4.3 rebounds, while shooting .500 in four NCAA Tournament starts in 2020-21.

Jackson ranked 71st in ESPN's Top 100 of the 2020 recruiting class and was a

four-star prospect before embarking on two seasons at Michigan. The lefty figures prominently in the Rams' 2022-23 plans.

Shriver spent the 2021-22 campaign at Hartford, where he averaged 10.7 points and shot .413 from 3-point range.

### A BOOST FROM WITHIN

VCU is anticipating a spark from the return of redshirt sophomore guard Jamir Watkins, who missed the entire 2021-22 season with a torn ACL in his left knee.

The 6-foot-7 Watkins averaged 7.2 points per game as a freshman in 2020-21 as he helped the Rams reach the A-10 Championship Game.

### A DEFENSIVE ACE

Ace Baldwin Jr. will likely serve as the tip of the spear for VCU's defensive efforts. Last season he piled up 61 steals in 24 games, an average of 2.54 per game, which ranked third nationally.

### IN OUR DEFENSE...

## FRESH FACES

VCU welcomes four freshman in 2022-23: Alphonzo “Fats” Billups, Christian Fermin, Toibu “Tobi” Lawal and Obinnaya “Obi” Okafor.

Billups and Fermin were both early signees with stellar high school pedigrees. A 6-foot-7 wing, Billups was ranked 94th nationally in ESPN’s Top 100 of the class of 2022. Fermin, a 6-10 center, was ranked the No. 2 player in Pennsylvania the 16th-ranked player at his position nationally in his class by 247Sports.

## WHERE THE PROS GO

VCU has produced an NBA Draft pick in each of the past two seasons. Nah’Shon “Bones” Hyland was a first-round selection (26th overall) of the Denver Nuggets in the 2021 NBA Draft. He averaged 10.1 points and shot .366 from 3-point range as a rookie last season. In the 2022 Draft, the Memphis Grizzlies used a second-round pick (47th overall) to select Vince Williams Jr., who was an All-Atlantic 10 Conference

First Team honoree in 2022.

In Mike Rhoades’ VCU tenures as an assistant coach and as head coach, he’s helped send seven players (Hyland, Williams, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber, Treveon Graham and Larry Sanders) to the NBA. Justin Tillman also spent a 10-contract with the Atlanta Hawks in 2021-22 but did not enter a game. He was a G-League First Team selection in 2022.

## STILL FEELS LIKE HAVOC

Call it what you want, VCU’s defense has been elite under Rhoades. Last season, the Rams ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency (88.8), as well as fourth in defensive turnover percentage (24.7) and ninth in effective field goal defense (.444).

The Rams have finished in the top 10 nationally in turnover percentage in each of the past four seasons and in the top 10 in defensive efficiency in three of the past four.

## 136: WINS VS. THE A-10

VCU is 136-59 (.697) against Atlantic 10 opponents, including A-10 Tournament games, since it joined the league prior to the 2012-13 season, most in the confer-

ence. The Rams reached the A-10 Championship Game in each of their first five seasons in the league and captured the title in 2015 over Dayton.

## 496: WINS SINCE 2001-02

A 6-foot-8, 175-pound wing, Foster is a logical fit for VCU's pressing attack, which favors long, athletic players on the wings. On the offensive end, the Bronx, N.Y. native has developed into a dangerous perimeter scorer and ball handler.

Foster starred for Cardinal Hayes High School for four seasons under Coach Joe Lods. As a senior in 2021-22, Foster averaged 16 points and six rebounds per game, while leading the Cardinals to a State Championship and a 26-3 record. Cardinal Hayes finished the year ranked No. 7 nationally by MaxPreps. He will prep this season at defending National Champion Putnam Science Academy in Connecticut.
