### TIPOFF

- ◀ Grambling State and Vanderbilt will be meeting for the second time, the first since 2010 when the Commodores won 92-59 on November 24, 2010 in Nashville
- ◀ The Tigers enter the contest off its most lopsided victory of the season, a 72-39 beatdown to Incarnate Word
- ◀ Grambling State's win over UIW was the first for head coach Donte' Jackson in three meetings and the schools first-ever victory over the Cardinals
- ◀ Vanderbilt will also meet Alabama A&M, its only other HBCU opponent, on December 22
- ◀ The Commodores are 13-0 against members of the SWAC and 34-1 all-time against HBCU opponents, with the lone loss coming to Howard
- ◀ Grambling State has already had a signature win this season as the Tigers defeated Colorado 84-73 in the SWAC/Pac-12 Legacy Series
- ◀ Vanderbilt is the lone SEC school on the schedule for Grambling State as the Tigers have already played two Pac-12 schools (Colorado and Arizona State), have a date with ACC foe Virginia Tech and Big Ten member Wisconsin left on its non-conference slate
- ◀ The Commodores defeated Wofford, 65-62, on Dec. 3 and will meet Pitt on Dec. 7
- ◀ Carte'are Gordon leads three GSU players in double figures, averaging 14.0 points and 8.4 rebounds per game
- ◀ Grambling State is averaging nearly 68 points per game and is shooting better than 43 percent from the floor

### MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Grambling State must be requested through GSU's official website. To begin the process, visit [www.gsutigers.com/media](http://www.gsutigers.com/media). Only media covering the Tigers on a consistent basis and on assignment will be considered for season credentials. A lost season credential will result in credentials being issued on a game-by-game basis as available.

### PLAYER INTERVIEW AVAILABILITY

All interviews with Grambling State student-athletes should be coordinated through the Athletic Communications Office. During the season, GSU players are available after practices. No interviews will be conducted during practice. Telephone and/or Zoom interviews may be arranged by contacting Brian Howard in the Athletic Communications Office. ALL interview requests should be made at least 48 hours in advance. GSU's first-year players (true freshmen) are not available for interviews.

### COACH INTERVIEW AVAILABILITY

Interviews with head coach Donte' Jackson should also be arranged through the Athletic Communications Office. Head Coach Donte' Jackson is available for interviews throughout the week, after practices and after the conclusion of games. Telephone interviews with the head coach can be arranged by contacting the Athletic Communications Office. As with the student-athletes, interview requests should be made at least 48 hours in advance.

### PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

Grambling State's men's basketball practices are primarily closed to the public and media with limited exceptions (media will be notified in advance of those dates). The first portion of the workouts (generally the first 15-20 minutes) is open to photographers. Again, media will be

notified in advance of those opportunities.

Members of the media planning to shoot practice should contact the GSU Athletic Communications Office in advance to confirm arrangements and practice times.

### PRACTICE LOCATION

The Tigers practice inside the Fredrick C. Hobdy Assembly Center and inside the men's gymnasium.

**DONTÉ JACKSON** enters his sixth season at the helm at Grambling State University.

In his first season, Jackson guided the Tigers to their first SWAC Regular Season Championship in nearly 30 years (1988-1989). During the regular season, Grambling State enjoyed the nation spotlight as being one of the teams in NCAA Division I with the longest winning streak, which got as high as 11 games before a loss to Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

Jackson, which saw the team finish at 17-14 overall and 13-5 in SWAC play, earned several accolades, including SWAC Coach of the Year, NABC District 23 Coach of the Year and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year honor. In addition, Ivy Smith, Jr. was selected to the All-SWAC First Team, BOXTOROW All-American Team and a NABC District 23 Second-Team honoree.

His second season saw more success as the Tigers went 17-17 overall, finishing 10-8 inside SWAC play. Grambling State picked up a non-conference victory over Niagara in the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic and headed into conference play winning two of its final non-conference games, which included victories over Portland and Southeastern Louisiana. GSU wrapped up his second season with a trip to the Collegeinsider.com Tournament, a first for the program, as the Tigers fell, 74-73, to UT-Texas Rio Grande Valley.

In the 2019-2020 season, Jackson's third, the Tigers again reached the 17-win plateau, going 17-15 overall and 11-7 in conference play. Grambling State scored the most points in the Jackson era on November 8, a 147-52 victory over Ecclesia College. GSU also earned non-conference wins over Southwestern Louisiana and Louisiana-Monroe. The Tigers ended the year in the conference tournament, falling to Texas Southern in the quarterfinals.

During Jackson's fourth year, Grambling State played a shortened season due to COVID

as the Tigers went 12-12 overall and 9-6 in the SWAC. A 78-61 non-conference victory over Louisiana-Monroe highlighted the team's success before conference play tipped off. GSU reached the SWAC Tournament Semifinals for the second time in three years, falling to Prairie View A&M.

In the 2021-2022 season, Jackson's squad went 12-21 overall and 9-6 in the SWAC. Notably, Grambling State's highlighted non-conference win came at the Boost Mobile HBCU Challenge Hosted by Chris Paul, a 74-59 victory over Morgan State. The Tigers concluded the year by reaching the SWAC Tournament semifinals for the third time in the Jackson era, falling to eventual champion Texas Southern.

Prior to GSU, Jackson spent three seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, Ala.

In his first season at Stillman, the Tigers finished 17-10 overall and 13-6 in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) en route to a first-place regular-season finish in the conference. The Tigers were especially tough at home, ending the year with an 11-1 mark.

Jackson's second year was Stillman's most decorated season in school history. The Tigers finished 27-6, won the 2016 SIAC Championship Tournament and earned a berth in the NCAA tournament, where they defeated West Georgia in their first-round game. Jackson was named SIAC Coach of the Year, as well as BOXTOROW National Coach of the Year. Additionally, his team produced the SIAC Player of the Year, as well as Newcomer of the Year.

In June 2016, he was named interim athletics director and spent the year leading both the athletics department and the men's basketball team. Despite the added duties, Jackson's team performed very well on the court. The Tigers surpassed 20 wins for the second consecutive season (22-5) and had a 10-2 record at home. Stillman led the nation in margin of victory, defeating opponents by an average of 28.6 points per contest. The Tiger offense, which averaged 86.7 points per game, finished second in the country in field goal percentage (52.6%).

Prior to Stillman, Jackson led the men's basketball program at Central State University (CSU) in Wilberforce, Ohio for four seasons. He took over the program in 2010 after serving as an assistant coach at CSU for seven seasons.

During his tenure as head coach at CSU, he went 68-42 and averaged 17 wins each season, including a 19-9 mark during the 2011-12 campaign. While serving as an assistant coach at CSU, he helped guide the Marauders to an NCAA tournament appearance and three Independent Conference Association regular-season titles. The team went 125-61 during those seven seasons.

Jackson graduated from CSU in 2003 with a bachelor's of science in education, and in 2008, he earned a master's of science in educational leadership. He was a three-year letterwinner on the Marauder basketball team and earned all-conference and all-region honors during the 2001-02 season. He led the Marauders to the NAIA Division I National Tournament and a Sweet Sixteen appearance with a 24-8 record during 1999-2000 season. Jackson capped his stellar career by being selected as the recipient of the John W. Garland President's Award, presented annually to a student-athlete who embodies the highest standards of leadership, integrity and sportsmanship through academic and athletic achievements.

Jackson is a native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and attended Alexander Hamilton High School. He was an All-City Conference player and received all-state honors his senior year of high school. Prior to attending Central State University, Jackson played one season at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (NCAA Division I).

### HISTORY AT A GLANCE

In 1920, athletic officials from six Texas HBCUs — C.H. Fuller of Bishop College, Red Randolph and C.H. Patterson of Paul Quinn College, E.G. Evans, H.J. Evans and H.J. Starns of Prairie View A&M, D.C. Fuller of Texas College and G. Whitte Jordan of Wiley College — met in Houston, Texas, to discuss common interests. At this meeting, they agreed to form a new league, the SWAC.

Paul Quinn became the first of the original members to withdraw from the league when it did so in 1929. When Langston University of Oklahoma was admitted into the conference two years later, it began the migration of state-supported institutions into the SWAC. Southern University entered the ranks in 1934, followed by Arkansas AM&N (now the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff) in 1936 and Texas Southern University in 1954.

Rapid growth in enrollment of the state-supported schools made it difficult for the church-supported schools to finance their athletics programs and one by one they fell victim to the growing prowess of the state-supported colleges. Bishop withdrew from the conference in 1956, Langston in 1957 and Huston-Tillotson (formerly Samuel Huston) in 1959, one year after the admittance of two more state-supported schools: Grambling College and Jackson State College.

The enter-exit cycle continued in 1961 when Texas College withdrew, followed by the admittance of Alcorn A&M (now Alcorn State University) in 1962. Wiley left in 1968, the same year Mississippi Valley State College entered. Arkansas AM&N exited in 1970 and Alabama State University entered in 1982.

Arkansas-Pine Bluff (formerly Arkansas AM&N) rejoined the SWAC on July 1, 1997, regaining full-member status one year later. Alabama A&M University became the conference's tenth member when it became a full member in September, 1999 after a one year period as an affiliate SWAC member. Most of the former SWAC members that have left the conference are currently a part of the Red River Athletic Conference of the NAIA.

Current championship competition offered by the SWAC includes competition for men in baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, indoor track, outdoor track & field and tennis. Women's competition is offered in the sports of basketball, bowling, cross country, golf, indoor track, outdoor track & field, soccer, softball, tennis and volleyball.

### THE MISSION AND PURPOSE OF THE SWAC

The Southwestern Athletic Conference, Inc. (the "SWAC", the "Conference") is organized exclusively for the purpose of encouraging, promoting, advancing, and conducting intercollegiate sports activities and other recreational and not-for-profit activities among the members of the Conference. Its purposes are:

- To uphold the principles of institutional control of, and responsibility for all collegiate sports conducted by the members of this organization in conformity with the Constitution and Bylaws hereof;
- To stimulate and improve intercollegiate athletic sports;
- To comply with satisfactory standards of scholarship and amateur standing and good sportsmanship;
- To preserve and maintain the collegiate athletic records of the members of the Southwestern Athletic Conference, and make them available upon request;
- To cooperate with other amateur athletic organizations in the promotion and conduct of intercollegiate athletic contests;
- To maintain fiscal management; and
- To legislate through Bylaws or Resolutions on subjects of general concern to the membership.

The members of the conference are committed to the philosophy of maintaining intercollegiate athletics as an integral part of the overall educational program. To this end, the conference believes in and subscribes to the fundamental principles of amateurism, institutional control, sound academic standards, financial aid, recruiting, and ethical conduct that governs intercollegiate athletics, and the enforcement of rules and regulations as adopted by the National Collegiate Athletic Association.
