The Southeastern Louisiana University men's basketball team plays its final nonconference game of the 2022-23 season while trying to start its first win streak of the season in the final game of the 2022 calendar year as Southeastern heads to Nashville for a date with Vanderbilt at 6:00 p.m. on Friday.

The game between the Lions (6-7) and Commodores (6-6) will be live streamed on SEC Network+. Live stats, provided by the host institution, will be accessible through the men's basketball schedule page at lionsports.net.

Southeastern comes into Friday's game fresh off ending a two-game losing streak in their last contest with an 80-62 win at home over Southern last Wednesday to head into the Christmas holiday.

Roger McFarlane (20 points) had a career day in the game against the Jaguars, scoring a new personal season high in points in the game while hitting a career best four three-point field goals in the win. He also grabbed a team high-tying eight rebounds and doled out four assists.

"Boogie" Anderson (15 points) set a new high water mark for the team this season when it comes to setting up buckets, dishing out nine assists in last Wednesday's contest, which is the most by any SLU player in a game this season, making it also a career high for the first year Lion.

Nick Caldwell (16 points) and **Brody Rowbury** (10 points) continued to fortify the inside for Southeastern, dominating the paint for the second straight game as both players scored in double figures with Rowbury grabbing eight rebounds while Caldwell snagged seven boards. Both also blocked a Jaguar shot in the contest.

Christian Agnew, who did not play in the win over Southern, remains SLU's leading scorer on the season, averaging 12.1 points per contest. He does most of his work behind the arc, where he's hit 20 of his 39 made baskets on the season. He's one of two players who has hit 20 or more three-pointers of the season, joining **Matthew Strange** who has hit 24 shots from long distance on the season. Strange

is the best pure long distance shooter so far for Southeastern this season, hitting on 51.1% of the shots he's taken from beyond the arc this year. Anderson joins Agnew as the only other Lion averaging double digit scoring this season at 11.8 points per game while leading the team in assists and steals on the year.

As a team, the Lions average 77.8 points per game on 45.7% shooting, including 38.1% from three. SLU opponents score an average of 75.6 points per game on 45.5% shooting and hit on 35.5% of their attempts from above the three-point arc.

Scouting Vanderbilt

Much like Southeastern did last Wednesday, Vanderbilt ended its own two-game losing streak right before the Christmas weekend at home with a 70-62 win last Thursday against Alabama A&M.

Liam Robbins (14 points), **Ezra Manjon** (12 points), & **Jordan Wright** (12 points) all came off the bench to lead the Commodores in scoring in the win over the Bulldogs. Wright hit the dagger three to turn a one-point lead with less than a minute left into a two-possession game and the Commodores hit free throws down the stretch to hold on for the win.

Robbins leads Vanderbilt in most categories. He averages 12.3 points per game on 53.1% shooting, rebounds 5.4 missed shots per game, and blocks 2.8 opposing shots per contest. **Myles Stute**, who has hit 38 three-pointers on the season on 47.5% shooting from above the arc, averages 11.8 points per game. **Tyrin Lawrence** averages 10.7 points per game to round out the Vanderbilt leading scorers.

As a team, the Commodores score 67.9 points per game on 42.6% shooting, including 32.8% from long distance. Vanderbilt opponents score 66.8 points per game on 42.1% shooting and hit 31.7% from above the three-point arc.

Southeastern - Vanderbilt Series

Southeastern and Vanderbilt are meeting for just the fourth time. The Commodores have won all three previous meetings by an average score of 81-60.

Head Coach David Kiefer

David Kiefer begins his fourth season in Hammond as the head coach of the Lions team after five years as an assistant on the SLU staff.

Kiefer is coming off of his most successful season at the helm of Southeastern, a year in which he was named the Southland Conference's Coach of the Year as he guided the Lions to a 19-15 record overall, but also a 10-4 record in conference play which was good enough to earn the two-seed in the conference postseason tournament. That led to a run to the Finals as SLU came one step away from a conference title. That run was rewarded by further postseason play as the Lions earned a spot in The Basketball Classic. His Coach of the Year award was only the second earned by a SLU coach from the Southland Conference, joining Billy Kennedy in 2004 to earn the award.

The 2021-22 season also saw three players get selected to the All-Southland team, including Gus Okafor (1st team), Jalyn Hinton (2nd team) and Keon Clergeot (2nd team). Hinton was named Southland Defensive Player of the Year as well after leading the league in blocked shots with 81.

SLU also broke several school records during year-three of the Kiefer era. The Lions scored 2,679 points, made 302 three-pointers, shot 76.9 percent as a team from the free throw line and made an all-time program high 19 three-pointers in a win over Southeastern Baptist. In his second season with the Lions, Kiefer guided SLU to the Southland Conference Tournament including a win over McNeese in the first round. During the campaign, SLU played one of the most challenging non-conference schedules in the Southland playing nine straight games on the road to start the season. The road trip included games in six different states with contests at LSU, Texas A&M, Louisiana Tech, California Baptist, UAB, Grambling, Stephen F. Austin and Lamar.

The Lions defeated California Baptist in remarkable fashion erasing a 13-point deficit in the game's final nine minutes for an 81-80 win.

Under Kiefer, guard Keon Clergeot was fourth in the nation in free throws made (155) and free throws attempted (192). Clergeot was also second in the Southland in scoring during league games averaging 17.9 points.

In his rookie campaign as Lions' skipper, Kiefer put a competitive squad together that battled their way through a 20-game Southland schedule with six freshmen, three juniors, two sophomores and just one senior. SLU lost six conference games by six points or less including two in overtime.

Kiefer was named the 13th head coach in program history July 2, 2019 following SLU's 12-6 finish in the Southland Conference and 17-16 overall record in the 2018-19 season. The Lions advanced to the Southland Conference Tournament for the 15th time before falling in the semi-finals to Abilene Christian, 69-66. Kiefer helped guide the Lions to the Southland Conference regular season title in 2017-18 finishing 22-12 and 15-3 in the conference.

It was the program's first conference title since the 2004-2005 season. SLU advanced to the Southland Conference Tournament Championship before falling to Stephen F. Austin, 59-55. The 22 wins was second most in program history (24 in 2004-05).

Kiefer helped Southeastern to a .500 record in 2016-17 as the Lions finished 16-16 before losing to Lamar in the first round of the Southland Conference Tournament.

Southeastern advanced to the tournament for the fifth straight year after finishing seventh in the league with a 9-9 record. The Lions had a 4 1/2-game improvement from 2015-16 despite having three potential starters miss the season with injuries.

Kiefer has worked with the Southeastern guards and coordinating the Lions' recruiting efforts. In 2016-17, he helped guard Marlain Veal blossom into one of the top players in the Southland Conference. Veal, the former Lion, concluded his career as the second leading scorer in program history, and all-time leader in assists and steals.

Prior to coming to Southeastern, Kiefer spent a year on the staff at South Carolina, serving as the team's director of video services. At South Carolina he

handled all aspects of the Gamecocks' video services, serving also as coordinator for Frank Martin's Summer Camps.

Kiefer previously served as an assistant coach at Northwest Florida State College where he handled team travel, recruiting and individual player development, along with opponent scouting and film exchange. The 2013-14 campaign saw all eight of its sophomores graduate, with each signing to play Division I basketball. Prior to his time with the Raiders, Kiefer served as an assistant coach at Jones County Junior College (2012-13), as an assistant at Arlington Country Day High School (2011-12), as a volunteer video assistant at Central Florida (2010-11), as the head junior varsity and assistant varsity coach at St. Mary's Ryken of the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference (WCAC), and as a student manager at Kansas State (2006-08) and in the same capacity at Cincinnati (2005-06). While at Kansas State as a student manager Kiefer had the privilege to witness the development of Michael Beasley, who was selected second overall in the 2008 NBA Draft, Cartier Martin and Bill Walker.

While at Cincinnati, Kiefer also saw the development of James White (three NBA seasons with Spurs, Knicks and Rockets), who played for the Bearkats. The Lions' head coach was on staff with South Carolina when current NBA player Sindarius Thornwell was with the Gamecocks.

Kiefer assisted with recruiting classes during his tenures at Northwest Florida and Jones County which provided the foundation for national championships at both institutions.

Kiefer also assisted with two powerhouse AAU programs, the Florida Rams and the D.C. Assault.

Kiefer graduated from Kansas State with a degree in social sciences in 2007, and he received his master's degree from Salem International in 2013. Kiefer and his wife Mia have a son, Austin, and two twin daughters, Kayden and Nola.
