THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt completes a three-game road stretch Wednesday, Dec. 7 against Vanderbilt. Tipoff at Memorial Gymnasium is set for 9:00 p.m. [ET] with Roy Philpott and Dane Bradshaw calling the game on SEC Network.
- The Panthers have won their past five games and will look for their first six-game win streak since the opening of the 2018-19 season.
- Pitt is 2-0 in true road games this season with wins at Northwestern and NC State. The Panthers have not opened a season with wins in their first three road games since earning victories in the first six road games of the 2010-11 season.
- The Panthers have held the opposition to 59.4 points per game and 27.4 percent (34-of-124) shooting from three-point range during their five-game win streak.

- Blake Hinson has posted eight double figure scoring games, including five 15+ point efforts and three games with 20 or more points. He leads the Panthers and ranks seventh in the Atlantic Coast Conference in scoring at 16.3 points per game, while shooting 51.6 percent (47-of-91) from the field, including 40.8 percent (20-of-49) from three-point range.
- Jamarius Burton has scored in double figures in all eight games he has played this season and 31 of his 38 games at Pitt. He is averaging 15.8 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 4.3 assists per game, while shooting a team-high 55.8 percent (48-of-86) from the field.
- Nike Sibande has come off the bench to score in double figures in four of the past five games and is averaging 11.2 points per game in that span.

BY THE NUMBERS

- **Blake Hinson** is one of two players in the ACC averaging over 16.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, while shooting over 50.0 percent from the field this season. He leads the Panthers in scoring (16.3 ppg.), rebounds (6.8 rpg.), free throws made (33), three-point field goals (20) and steals (11).
- **Jamarius Burton** is averaging 18.0 points and 4.8 assists per game, while shooting 58.3 percent (28-of-48) from the field and 84.6 percent (11-of-13) from the free throw line over the past four games.
- The Panthers' starting backcourt of **Nelly Cummings** and **Jamarius Burton** has combined for 2,319 points, 680 rebounds, 619 assists, and 204 steals in 246 career games. The tandem is averaging 24.5 points, 7.3 rebounds, and 8.6 assists per game this season. Cummings and Burton have combined for 30 or more points scored in each of the past two games.
- **Jamarius Burton** (48-of-86, .558), **Blake Hinson** (47-of-91, .516) and **John Hugley IV** (19-of-37, .514) are a combined 114-of-214 (.532) from the field, while combining to average 41.1 points per game.
- **Nelly Cummings** has drawn a team-best 10 offensive fouls through the first nine games of the season. He also leads the team in assists (39) and free throw percentage (14-of-14, 1.000).
- **Nike Sibande** has made two or more three-point field goals in four of the past five games for the Panthers. He is 10-of-27 (.370) from beyond the arc in that span.
- The Panthers are averaging 15.8 assists per game during their five-game win streak with 17 or more assists in three of the past four games. Guards **Nelly Cummings** (24), **Jamarius Burton** (19), and **Nike Sibande** (15) have combined for 58 assists (11.6 apg.) in that span.
- **Blake Hinson** is five points shy of the 700-point mark for his career. He is averaging 10.1 points per game in 69 career contests.

- Pitt is shooting 47.5 percent (123-of-259) from the field in the second half of play this season. **Federiko Federiko** (.750), **Guillermo Diaz Graham** (.750), **Jamarius Burton** (.630), **John Hugley IV** (.625), **Aidan Fisch** (.500), and **Blake Hinson** (.500) are each shooting 50 percent or better from the field after halftime.
- The Panthers are 49-of-126 (.389) from three-point range over the past five games with **Blake Hinson** (11-of-22) and **Jamarius Burton** (5-of-10) leading the way at a combined 16-of-32 (.500). Pitt shot just 25.5 percent (27-of-106) from beyond the arc in its first four games.
- Pitt is averaging 41.8 rebounds per game during its current five-game win streak. The Panthers have a +8.0 rebound margin with **Blake Hinson** (7.2 rpg.), **Nike Sibande** (5.8 rpg.), and **Greg Elliott** (5.8 rpg.) each averaging five or more rebounds per game in that span.
- The Panthers are averaging 44.2 points per game on 93-of-179 (.520) shooting from the field in the second half of play over the past six games. Pitt has scored 45 or more points in the second half in three of the past four games.
- Pitt has stepped up its three-point defense during its five-game win streak limiting the opposition to 27.4 percent (34-of-124) shooting from beyond the arc. The Panthers rank third in the ACC in three-point percentage defense (.292) for the season.
- The Panthers rank third in the ACC in rebounds (39.3 rpg.), offensive rebounds (11.6 rpg.) and rebound margin (+5.0). Pitt has won the rebounding battle in six of its nine games and has a +8.0 rebound margin during its current five-game win streak.
- Pitt has held its past two opponents to a combined 33.2 points below their scoring average entering the contest. The Panthers limited NC State to a season-low 60 points despite the Wolfpack entering the game averaging 83.0 points per game.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitt opened ACC play with a 68-60 road win over NC State Friday evening at PNC Arena. The Panthers won their second consecutive road game and began the season 2-0 in road contests for the first time since the 2013-14 season.
- The Panthers extended their win streak to five consecutive games. Pitt won the first six games of the 2018-19 season for the longest win streak under head coach **Jeff Capel**.
- Pitt's defense held NC State 23 points below its season average entering the game. The Wolfpack shot just 35.0 percent (21-of-60) from the field, including 22.2 percent (6-of-27) from three-point range, in the contest.
- **Jamarius Burton** scored a career-high 24 points to go along with four rebounds, four assists and two steals. He went 9-of-14 from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line in the win. Burton scored 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the field in the second half of play.
- **Blake Hinson** scored in double-figures for the eighth time finishing with 13 points, eight rebounds and two blocked shots.
- **Greg Elliott** recorded a career-high nine rebounds, including eight defensive rebounds in the first half. He added seven points and two steals in the win.
- **Nike Sibande** made a pair of three-point field goals and finished with 10 points for his fourth double-figure scoring game in the past five contests. He made a clutch three-point field at the 6:54 mark of the second half to stop a 6-0 NC State run and give the Panthers a 59-50 lead.
- The Panthers held NC State starters Jarkell Joiner and Jack Clark to a combined three points on 0-of-20 shooting from the field, including 0-of-14 from three-point range.
- Pitt went 19-of-32 (.594) on two-point field goal attempts, including 10-of-15 (.667) in the opening half of play.

PANTHER SPOTLIGHTS



- **Jamarius Burton** is one point shy of reaching the 500-point plateau at Pitt. He is averaging 13.1 points per game in 38 contests (34 starts for the Panthers).



- **Blake Hinson** has scored in double figures in a career-best seven consecutive games and eight times overall on the season.

PORTAL ADDITIONS

- Pitt used the Division I transfer portal to add three players to the 2022-23 roster. **Nelly Cummings** (Bowling Green/Colgate), **Greg Elliott** (Marquette) and **Blake Hinson** (Ole Miss/Iowa State) have now combined for 2,612 points, 833 rebounds and 485 assists over 310 career games.
- The transfer trio of Cummings, Elliott, and Hinson is combining for 34.2 points, 13.8 rebounds, and 6.4 assists per game this season.
- The trio delivered 57 points, 16 rebounds, and 11 assists, while going 16-of-25 (.640) from the field, including 10-of-13 (.769) from three-point range, in a win at Northwestern.

THREE-POINT THREATS

- Pitt has reshaped its perimeter attack and is now one of two programs in the ACC with four or more players with 100 or more three-point field goals.
- **Nike Sibande** leads the Panthers with 215 career three-point field goals, while **Nelly Cummings** has made 159 threes in his career. **Blake Hinson** (111) and **Greg Elliott** (109) both passed the the 100 career threes mark in November.
- The Panthers have made 10 or more three-point field goals four times this season and 14 times under head coach **Jeff Capel**. Pitt is 4-0 on the season when making 10 or more threes in a game.
- Pitt is averaging 8.4 made threes per game, despite not finding its shooting stroke from beyond the arc over the first eight games of the season. The Panthers are 76-of-232 (.328) from three-point range on the young season.
- The Panthers made a season-high 14 threes (tied for second most in program history) in a road win over Northwestern. Pitt also made 10 or more threes in wins over UT Martin (11), William & Mary (11), and Alabama State (10).
- Pitt went a season-best 14-of-22 (.636) from three-point range at Northwestern marking the first time since Jan. 4, 2017 the Panthers have shot 60 percent or better from beyond the arc in a game.
- **Blake Hinson** (4-of-5), **Greg Elliott** (3-of-4), **Nike Sibande** (3-of-6) and **Nelly Cummings** (3-of-4) combined to go 13-of-19 from three-point range against the Wildcats. The long range performance at Northwestern marked just the second time in program history four players have made three or more three-point field goals in a game.
- The Panthers are averaging 9.8 threes per game, while shooting 38.9 percent (49-of-126) from beyond the arc during their current five-game win streak.

BACKCOURT PRODUCTION

- Pitt has one of the most productive backcourt rotations in the NCAA with the quartet of **Jamarius Burton**, **Nelly Cummings**, **Greg Elliott**, and **Nike Sibande** combining for 4,668 points and 560 three-point field goals in their careers.
- Pitt, Notre Dame, and UAB are the only schools in the NCAA with three 1,000-point scorers in the backcourt. Sibande (1,622), Cummings (1,190) and Burton (1,129) have combined for 3,941 points in 366 career games.
- The guard group of Burton, Cummings, Elliott, and Sibande combined for a season-best 60 points, 15 rebounds, and 17 assists at Northwestern. The quartet went 9-of-15 (.600) from three-point range in the win.
- Pitt's veteran backcourt rotation combines to average 40.6 points, 16.2 rebounds, and 11.2 assists per game. The group has combined for 19 double-figure scoring games this season.

- Pitt's roster features five players who have averaged double figures for a season at the NCAA Division I level. **Nelly Cummings** (3x), **Nike Sibande** (3x), **Jamarius Burton** (2x), **John Hugley IV** (1x) and **Blake Hinson** (1x) have combined for 10 double-figure scoring seasons.
- Hinson (16.3 ppg.) and Burton (15.8 ppg.) have each scored in double figures eight times this season. Both players rank in the top 10 of the ACC in scoring.

HINSON LEADING THE WAY

• **Blake Hinson** has scored in double figures eight times with 15 or more points in a game on five occasions this season. He leads the Panthers in scoring (16.3 ppg.), rebounding (6.8 rpg.), three-point field goals (20), free throws (33), free throw attempts (43) and steals (11).

• Hinson is one of two players in the ACC averaging over 16.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, while shooting over 50 percent from the field.

• Hinson ranks among the ACC leaders in scoring (4th), rebounding (T-11th), field goal percentage (.516 - 9th), three-point field goals (2.22 3pg. - T-8th), and offensive rebounds (2.56 orpg. - T-8th).

• Hinson has registered 695 points (10.1 ppg.) and made 111 three-point field goals in 69 career games.

• Hinson has scored in double-figures 32 times in his career and has made three or more three-pointers in a game 17 times.

• Hinson set career highs in points (27) and rebounds (13) in his Panthers debut. He went 9-of-18 from the field and made four three-point field goals in the win over UT Martin.

• Hinson became the fourth player since the 1986-87 season to post 25 or more points and 10 or more rebounds in the season opener. He knocked down four three-point field goals and was 9-of-18 from the field overall for the game.

• Hinson averaged 15.5 points and 4.5 rebounds, while going 11-of-20 from the field, including 4-of-9 from three-point range, against No. 20 Michigan and VCU in the Legends Classic.

• Hinson scored 21 points, while adding five rebounds (four offensive) and a career-best four steals in a win over Alabama State. He was 7-of-12 from the field, including 3-of-6 from three-point range, against the Hornets.

• Hinson posted 11 points, four rebounds, three assists, two steals, and a blocked shot in a win over FDU.

• Hinson scored a team-high 17 points on 5-of-7 shooting from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line in a win over William & Mary. He added 11 rebounds for his second double-double as a Panther.

• Hinson tallied a game-high 22 points to go along with eight rebounds (six offensive), and a career-best five assists in a road win over Northwestern. He went 4-of-5 from three-point range and 8-of-11 from the foul line against the Wildcats.

BIG JOHN AMONG ACC TOP RETURNEES

- **John Hugley IV** returns for his junior season after ranking among the ACC leaders in scoring (T-15th - 14.8 ppg.), rebounds (4th - 7.9 rpg.), offensive rebounds (2nd - 2.69 orpg.), defensive rebounds (9th - 5.22 drpg.), free throw percentage (15th - .710) and double-doubles (3rd - 9) a year ago.
- Hugley IV is averaging 9.0 points and 4.0 rebounds in 18.8 minutes per game, while shooting 51.4 percent (19-of-37) from the field, in six contests. He missed six weeks of the preseason and three games early in the season due to a knee injury.
- Hugley IV has scored in double figures three times this season and 26 times over the past two seasons.
- Hugley IV finished with 10 points, nine rebounds, and two blocks in 19 minutes against Alabama State. He knocked down a three-point field goal and had six offensive rebounds in the win.
- Hugley IV scored a season-high 17 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the field in a win over FDU. He also added five rebounds and two blocks against the Knights.
- Hugley IV recorded 16 points, seven rebounds, and four assists in a win over William & Mary. He went 5-of-9 from the field and 5-of-7 from the foul line in the win. Hugley IV had 10 points, seven rebounds and three assists in the second half against the Tribe.

HOME CUMMINGS

- Graduate transfer **Nelly Cummings** returns to the Pittsburgh area for his final season of eligibility after spending the past three seasons at Colgate. The Midland, Pa., native grew up in the area and used to workout at the Petersen Events Center as a youth.
- Cummings has scored 1,190 points and made 159 three-point field goals in 118 career games (88 starts). He is shooting 34.8 percent (159-of-457) from three-point range and 80.2 percent (231-of-288) from the foul line for his career.
- Cummings has scored in double-figures 57 times in his career, including 11 games with 20 or more points scored.
- Cummings ranks among the ACC leaders in assists (4.3 avg. - 6th) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.77:1 - 9th). He has recorded five or more assists in a game five times this season.
- Cummings recorded seven assists to go along with eight points and three rebounds in the season opener against UT Martin.
- Cummings posted his first double-figure scoring game as a Panther with 11 points on 4-of-8 shooting against VCU.
- Cummings scored 11 points and added five assists in a win over FDU.
- Cummings posted a season-high 17 points to go along with four rebounds and six assists in a win at Northwestern. He went 6-of-8 from the field, including 3-of-4 from three-point range in the contest.

ELLIOTT DELIVERS FROM DEEP

- With the addition of **Greg Elliott**, Pitt gained an outstanding three-point weapon and another experienced leader in the backcourt. He has totaled 727 points and 109 made threes in his career.

- Elliott is averaging 9.2 points and 1.67 three-point field goals on the season. He has scored in double figures four times and has three games with three or more three-point field goals.
- Elliott went 3-of-7 from three-point range and scored 11 points in his Pitt debut against UT Martin.
- Elliott scored 12 points on 3-of-7 shooting from three and 3-of-3 from the foul line against West Virginia.
- Elliott scored 12 points with a pair of threes and 4-of-5 shooting from the foul line against No. 20 Michigan.
- Elliott went 3-of-4 from three-point range and 5-of-5 from the foul line in a season-best 18-point effort at Northwestern.
- Elliott grabbed a career-high nine rebounds in a road win over NC State. He added seven points and two steals against the Wolfpack.

SIBANDE PITT'S SIXTH STARTER

- **Nike Sibande** missed the 2021-22 season after suffering a torn ACL in the first half of Pitt's exhibition win over Gannon (Nov. 1, 2021). He underwent successful surgery on his knee Nov. 19, 2021 and was cleared to full contact workouts in September of 2022.
- Sibande has totaled 1,622 points, 571 rebounds, 174 assists and 101 steals with 215 three-point field goals in 120 career games at Miami [Ohio] and Pitt. He has scored in double figures 83 times in his career
- Sibande is averaging 6.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in 19.8 minutes per game as Pitt top reserve. He has recorded four double-figure scoring games as the Panthers' first sub in all nine games.
- Sibande has scored in double figures in three of the past four games and is averaging 11.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 3.5 assists per game in that span.
- Sibande delivered 17 points, four rebounds and three assists in the win over Alabama State. He knocked down a pair of three-point field goals and added a steal in the win.
- Sibande had a Pitt career-high nine rebounds to go along with three assists and a steal against FDU.
- Sibande recorded 15 points, nine rebounds, four assists and two steals versus William & Mary. He had 12 points, seven rebounds and both steals to spark a dominating second half performance by the Panthers.
- Sibande scored 11 points to go along with four rebounds, four assists and a steal in a win over Northwestern. He knocked down three three-point field goals in the contest.

- Pitt's 29-point win on the road over the Wildcats was the second largest victory margin in a true road game in the past 20 seasons.
- The Panthers' 87 points were the most scored on the road since an 89-78 win at Seton Hall Feb. 28, 2009.

PITT SIGNS TOP 25 CLASS

• Pitt added a trio of talented high school seniors during the fall signing period as **Marlon Barnes, Jr.**, **Carlton Carrington**, and **Jaland Lowe** signed national letters of intent during the fall signing period. The three-man class ranked No. 21 in the country and second in the ACC by 247 Sports.

• Barnes, a three-star prospect ranked No. 5 overall in the state of Ohio, is an excellent perimeter shooter with the length and athleticism to be a high-level defender. The 6-6, 185-pound forward out of Brush High School verbally committed to Pitt last January. Barnes slipped out of the top 100 in the recruiting rankings after dealing with injuries over the past two seasons. He closed his junior season at Brush strong helping the Arcs to a 20-4 record and a pair of state playoff wins.

• Carrington, one of the top prospects out of the talent-rich DMV area, is a skilled combo guard with deep shooting range and a smooth mid-range game. A Second Team Baltimore Catholic League selection as a junior, he helped lead St. Frances Academy to a 35-8 record and a BCL regular season championship. He averaged 14 points, five rebounds, three assists and two steals per game for the season. The 6-4, 180-pound guard is listed as a four-star recruit and ranked No. 94 overall by Rivals.

• Lowe, a four-star recruit ranked No. 83 overall by 247 Sports and No. 89 in the ESPN Top 100, is coming off an outstanding summer in which he shined for Houston Hoops on the EYBL circuit. The 6-2, 165-pound guard averaged 18.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists, and 2.0 steals per game to earn First Team All-Tournament honors at the 2022 Peach Jam and was also named Pool Play Co-MVP at the event. The Missouri City, Texas, native garnered all-region, district offensive MVP, and all-district accolades as a junior after averaging 25.6 points, 8.1 rebounds and 4.2 assists per game at Fort Bend Marshall High School. Lowe, a high IQ point guard with an outstanding basketball pedigree, has a reputation as a terrific ball handler with lethal three-point shooting range.

EXHIBITION EXCELLENCE

• Pitt improved to 63-5 all-time and extended its win streak to 39 consecutive games with a pair of victories in exhibition games prior to the season opener. The Panthers topped Clarion (103-51) and Edinboro (92-53) in preseason exhibition play.

• Six Panthers scored in double figures as the team topped the 100-point mark in exhibition play for the first time since a 101-33 win over Division III LaRoche Oct. 29, 2011. **Blake Hinson** scored a game-high 20 points, followed by **Jamarius Burton** (18), **Nelly Cummings** (16), **Greg Elliott** (12), **Nate Santos** (12), and **Federiko Federiko** (10).

• Pitt shot 59.4 percent (38-of-64) from the field and closed the game with 21 assists. The Panthers made 12 three-pointers and shot over 42 percent from beyond the arc in the game.

• The Panthers capped off exhibition play with a 92-53 win over Edinboro as four players reached double-figures in scoring. Hinson led the way with a game-high 29 points, including 28 in the opening half.

• Hinson was an efficient 10-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-8 from three-point range, and added seven rebounds and three assists on the night.

• **Nike Sibande** came off the bench to score 14 points on 5-of-7 shooting, while Elliott added 10 points.

• Federiko recorded his second double-double of the exhibition season with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

• Pitt held visiting Edinboro to 21 made field goals, while forcing 24 turnovers. The Panthers scored 31 points off turnovers in the win.

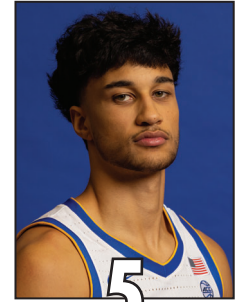
