CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Aliyah Boston stretched her current double-doubles streak to eight with a pair last week to finish the week averaging 20.0 points and 12.5 rebounds over a pair of wins. She has been key to helping Gamecocks to best-ever start of 23-0 and tying program record for consecutive wins at 29. Her 26 points at #5/4 UConn were a career-high vs. a top-5 opponent. The game was also her 34th double-double against a ranked opponent, 11th against a top-5 team. She absolutely dominated the second half at UConn, especially the fourth quarter as 23 of her 26 points came in the second half on 8-of-11 shooting, including a 14-point, 4-of-6 fourth quarter, and eight of her 11 boards came in the final 20 minutes. In the fourth quarter at UConn, she scored six straight points in 75 seconds to build a 10-point lead with 3:42 to play then added six more points, including a 3-pointer, to make it a 74-62 margin with 2:13 on the clock. She scored eight points off four of her six offensive rebounds against the Huskies. Against Kentucky, nearly had her double-double by halftime with eight points and eight rebounds in the opening 20 minutes, including six rebounds in the second quarter to match the Wildcats' team total for that period.

Freshman of the Week

• Raven Johnson was key to helping the Gamecocks to their best-ever start of 23-0 and tying program record for consecutive wins at 29. She was masterful running the team at #5/4 UConn, playing 36 minutes, including the entire second half, without committing a turnover. She handed out six of her seven assists at UConn in the second half, adding seven of her 14 points in the final 20 minutes as well. Between her points (14) and points off her career-high tying seven assists (15), had her hands on 35.8 percent of the Gamecocks' total offense at UConn. Her final two points against the Huskies came on free throws in the final 16 seconds to help seal the victory. Against Kentucky, Johnson added points to two key Gamecock runs – 9-0 in the first quarter to take an eight-point lead and 11-0 in the third quarter to turn a six-point game into a 17-point margin. She also handed out four assists on the night.

Around the League

• Monday's win over UT was Sam Purcell's 16th victory as

a Bulldog, making him the winningest first-year head coach in program history.

• UGA's Diamond Battles posted her ninth-straight game in double figures with 14 points.

• Angel Reese put together her third 20 and 20 performance of the season as she tallied 26 and hauled in 22 boards in the win. Her double-double streak sits at 23 for the season.

• Ole Miss held its seventh opponent under 50 points this season in the 68-42 win over Florida on Sunday. The 26 point win is also the largest victory over the Gators in series history.

• The Rebel defense also restricted the Gators to shoot 24.1%, the lowest field goal percentage Ole Miss has held an SEC team to in the last 20 seasons.

• Brittany Davis had a career high 33 points in the 76-69 win over Missouri on Sunday. She tallied 23 of those points in the second half.

• Cjaja Harbison has scored in double figures each of the last four contests—pacing Vandy in the category on each occasion—while totaling 19 steals during that stretch.

2023 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with seven, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

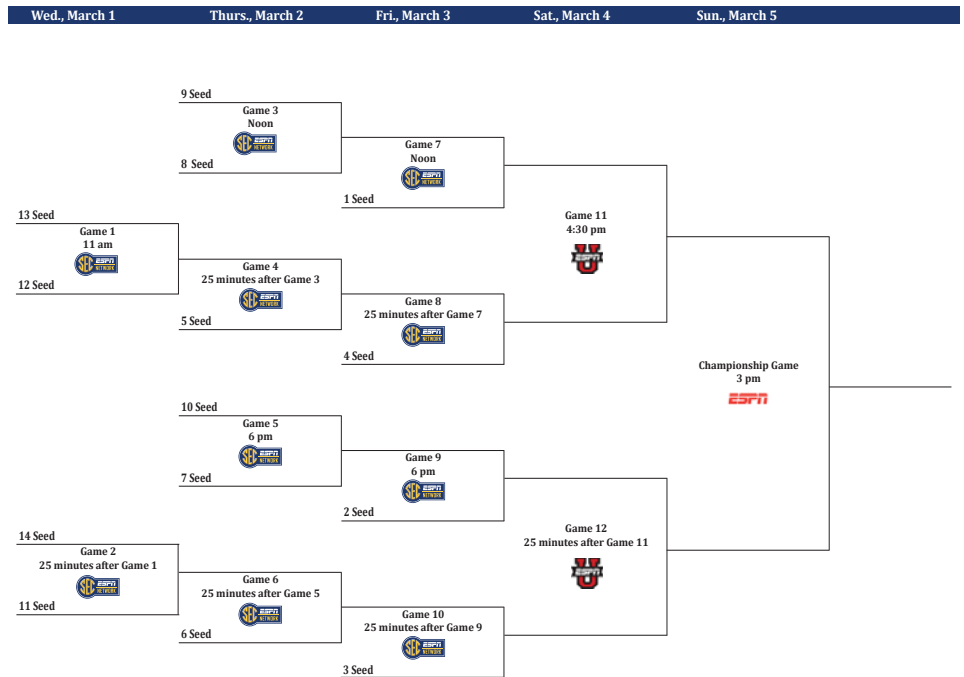
2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 10 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 40 Final Four appearances and 159 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Eleven of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, nine with their respective SEC teams.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 14 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 79 players named first-team a total of 159 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdscaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The league has also had two Honda-Broderick Cup winners. South Carolina's Aliyah Boston won in 2022 with Tennessee's Chamique Holdscaw claiming it in 1998.
- The Southeastern Conference had 23 former student-athletes make 2022 WNBA opening day rosters.
- Overall, the SEC has had 159 former players go on to play in the league.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 179 former players drafted for the professional league, including six No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- A total of 112 women's basketball students were named to the 2021-22 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball attendance for the seventh consecutive season. A total of 1,016,345 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. The conference set the all-time attendance high for any conference with 1,108,511 fans in 2016. The SEC and the Big 12 Conference remain the only two conferences to host more than 1 million fans during the course of a season.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.

Polls

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/WBCA poll began in the 1985-86 season).

- Two SEC teams have run the season at the No. 1 spot in the both the AP and USA Today coaches poll. Tennessee in the 1997-98 season and South Carolina in the 2021-22 season.

- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).

- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.

- Since the 1982 season, SEC teams have been ranked for 762 consecutive weeks of the AP poll.

- Since 1982, league teams have been ranked in the AP poll 3,764 times, including 1,766 Top 10 appearances, 956 Top 5 appearances and 195 No. 1 rankings.

- Overall, SEC teams have been ranked 837 weeks for a total of 4,595 times. The SEC has 1,863 Top 10 appearances and 1,017 Top Five appearances. SEC teams can also boast a total of 207 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week two in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

- Since the USA Today Coaches poll began in 1985 season, SEC teams have been ranked in every poll. A total of 707 consecutive weeks.

- League teams have been ranked in the coaches poll 3,420 times, including 1,590 Top 10 appearances, 922 Top

5 appearances and 185 No. 1 rankings.

- The most SEC teams in the final coaches poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1995, 1997, 2003, and 2021).

- The league has had the top three teams in the coaches poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week seven in 1989.

Non-Conference Success

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5849-1710 (.774) record against other conferences.

- In the postseason, SEC teams are 519-273 (.655) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6368-1983 (.763).

- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 27 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
