## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Co-Players of the Week

- Alabama's Brittany Davis had back-to-back double-double performances, recording a 22-point, 11-rebound double-double against Kentucky and an 18-point, 17-rebound performance against Auburn. She is UA's first player to record 17 rebounds since Erin Hogue pulled down 18 boards against Louisiana Tech on Nov. 26, 2011. Her 17 rebounds on Sunday were a single-game best for the conference this week. She also averaged a conference-leading 11.5 defensive boards for the week, while her combined 40 points for the week ranked second among conference players. Overall, she averaged 20 points, 14 rebounds, four assists and 1.5 steals this week.
- South Carolina's Kamilla Cardoso averaged a double-double for the week with 12.0 points and 10.0 rebounds over the two wins. She was the most efficient shooter of the week, hitting 76.9 percent from the field in addition to a perfect free throw week (4-of-4). She grabbed nine of her 13 rebounds against LSU in the first half to lead the Gamecocks to a +10 rebounding margin over the first 20 minutes to help build a 10-point halftime lead. Scored 16 of her team-high 18 points against LSU in the second half, including 12 in the fourth quarter to shut the door on any Tiger comeback. At Auburn, played just 13 minutes and was a defensive menace in just 3:30 in the first quarter with four rebounds and a block as Gamecocks held the Tigers to just 18.8 percent shooting in the period.

### Freshman of the Week

- Ryanne Allen scored 12 points—the first time she reached double figures since Dec. 8—and a career-best six rebounds while adding two assists and a block to help Vanderbilt to an eight-point victory over Arkansas. She then went 2 of 3 from 3-point range at Tennessee on Sunday, giving the freshman multiple 3-point field goals in four of the last five contests, and again handed out multiple assists with two more against the Lady Vols. She averaged 9.0 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 2.0 apg. She shot 4-of-8 from the arc while also going 6-for-6 from the free throw line.

### Around the League

- The recently announced 2023 Werner Ladder Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year candidates includes LSU's Kim Mulkey and South Carolina's Dawn Staley.
- Auburn overcame an eight-point deficit in the second half to defeat Texas A&M for the first time in the teams' 17th meeting.
- South Carolina shot 47.1 percent (8-of-17) against Florida. It's the highest 3-point percentage of the season in conference play for the Gamecocks.
- Five Lady Vols scored in double figures against Arkansas. It's the second time this season UT has had five players score 10 or more points.
- Georgia forced 22 Kentucky turnovers, marking the 17th time this season the Lady Bulldogs have forced 20-plus opponent miscues in a game.
- Alabama reached the 20-win milestone during the regular season for the first time since 1997-98. The win was also the ninth victory in conference play, marking the first time since 1997-98 that the Tide has secured nine SEC wins before March

## 2023 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with seven, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

### Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

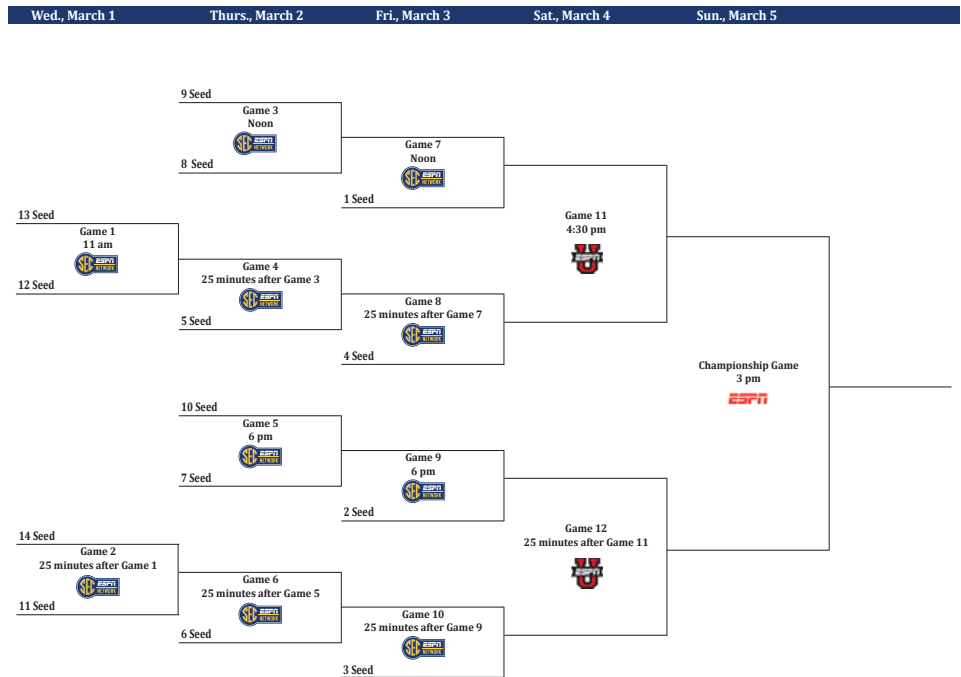
1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.
  
2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

## SEC SUCCESS

- With 10 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 40 Final Four appearances and 159 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Eleven of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, nine with their respective SEC teams.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 14 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 79 players named first-team a total of 159 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdscaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The league has also had two Honda-Broderick Cup winners. South Carolina's Aliyah Boston won in 2022 with Tennessee's Chamique Holdscaw claiming it in 1998.
- The Southeastern Conference had 23 former student-athletes make 2022 WNBA opening day rosters.
- Overall, the SEC has had 159 former players go on to play in the league.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 179 former players drafted for the professional league, including six No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- A total of 112 women's basketball students were named to the 2021-22 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball attendance for the seventh consecutive season. A total of 1,016,345 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. The conference set the all-time attendance high for any conference with 1,108,511 fans in 2016. The SEC and the Big 12 Conference remain the only two conferences to host more than 1 million fans during the course of a season.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.

### Polls

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/WBCA poll began in the 1985-86 season).

- Two SEC teams have run the season at the No. 1 spot in the both the AP and USA Today coaches poll. Tennessee in the 1997-98 season and South Carolina in the 2021-22 season.

- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).

- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.

- Since the 1982 season, SEC teams have been ranked for 763 consecutive weeks of the AP poll.

- Since 1982, league teams have been ranked in the AP poll 3,766 times, including 1,768 Top 10 appearances, 958 Top 5 appearances and 196 No. 1 rankings.

- Overall, SEC teams have been ranked 838 weeks for a total of 4,597 times. The SEC has 1,865 Top 10 appearances and 1,019 Top Five appearances. SEC teams can also boast a total of 208 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week two in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

- Since the USA Today Coaches poll began in 1985 season, SEC teams have been ranked in every poll. A total of 708 consecutive weeks.

- League teams have been ranked in the coaches poll 3,422 times, including 1,592 Top 10 appearances, 924 Top 5 appearances and 186 No. 1 rankings.

- The most SEC teams in the final coaches poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1995, 1997, 2003, and 2021).

- The league has had the top three teams in the coaches poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week seven in 1989.

### Non-Conference Success

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5849-1710 (.774) record against other conferences.

- In the postseason, SEC teams are 519-273 (.655) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6368-1983 (.763).

- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 27 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
