## STORYLINES

### NEXT UP

- Vanderbilt begins its run at the 2025 National Collegiate Bowling Championship at the Lansing Regional in Lansing, Michigan, opening play against Fairleigh Dickinson

### SEASON REWIND

- The Commodores won the PVAMU Invitational and Stallings Invitational
- Vandy student-athletes have received 10 all-tournament team honors this season
- Isabel Allen and Alyssa Ballard have each registered a first-place individual finish this season—Allen at the PVAMU Invitational and Ballard at the Stallings Invitational
- Vanderbilt has notched eight top-five finishes in its 10 regular season tournaments (did not bowl the third day at the Northeast Classic due to inclement weather)

### PAST POSTSEASON SUCCESS

- The Dores advanced to the Rochester Regional final in 2024, before ultimately falling to national runner-up Arkansas State
- Vanderbilt won back-to-back Lansing Regionals in 2022 and 2023, finishing third at the Final Four in 2022 and winning the NCAA title in 2023
- The Dores have made the NCAA Bowling Tournament every year since 2006, excluding 2020, and won the national championship in 2007, 2018 and 2023
- The 2025 tournament will be Vanderbilt's 19th consecutive appearance

### NEW STANDARDS SET

- Vandy broke a school record for high team traditional game at the Ladyjack Classic (1, 237 pins) and came close to repeating the feat with the third-ranked traditional game in program history at the PVAMU Invitational (1,214 pins)
- The Dores bowled a 299 Baker game at the Storm Flyer Classic
- Saphyre Nofuente bowled a season-high game of 289 pins at the Storm Flyer Classic, which ranks seventh in program history
- Allen (240.0 - six games) and Sydney Bohn (234.8 - five games) are ranked third and ninth in Vanderbilt history for high individual tournament average

## JUST GETTING STARTED

- Bohn was named the CUSA Co-Newcomer of the Month (Feb.)
- The freshman anchored the Dores in both tournament championship matches this season
- She was the top freshman, third overall finisher at the Mid-Winter Invitational and was named to the all-tournament team
- At the PVAMU Invitational, Bohn compiled scores of 269, 214, 247, 220 and 224 for a 234.80 average, which was the second highest game average of the tournament behind teammate Allen
- Bohn is No. 8 on the Vanderbilt all-time performers list for high individual tournament average with 234.8 pins per game

## NASHVILLE NEWCOMER, BOWLING VET

- Allen joined the Commodores in 2024 as a graduate transfer from Jacksonville State
- Allen has made four all-tournament teams this season and earned an MVP nod after placing first individually at the PVAMU Invitational
- She was named the January CUSA Co-Bowler of the Month
- Allen ranks top 10 in the country in spare conversion percentage (75.5 percent)
- Before Vandy, Allen won NCAA championships with McKendree and Jax State
- She is a three-time All-American, making the second team in 2023 and 2024 and earning an honorable mention nod in 2021
- During her debut season, Allen was tabbed the NTCA Rookie of the Year and Great Lakes Valley Conference Freshman of the Year and was named to the NCAA All-Freshman Team
- Allen is a three-time member of Team England and has won five gold medals at the European Youth Championships

## AN EXPERIENCED LINEUP

- Vanderbilt returned all three All-Americans from the Commodores' 2023-24 roster
- Paige Peters, who was the 2022 NTCA Rookie of the Year, was a first-team selection in 2024 and a third-team All-American in 2022 and 2023
- Peters was named All-CUSA and All-Central Region first team in 2024
- Victoria Varano, who earned an honorable mention nod as a freshman in 2023, was tabbed a second-team All-American, All-CUSA second team and All-Central Region honorable mention in 2024
- Haley Lindley received All-America honorable mention recognition as a freshman and also made the NTCA All-Rookie first team

## ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- The Vanderbilt bowling team compiled a 3.374 team GPA for the 2024 fall semester
- Seven Commodores were honored on the 2023-24 SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll, and Lindley was named to the 2023-24 First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll
- Allen was named to the CUSA All-Academic Team for her achievements on the lanes and in the classroom

## IMPACT ON & OFF THE LANES

- Kaylee Hitt was nominated for the first-ever Allstate NACDA Good Works Team
- She has aided Soles4Souls after taking part in Vanderbilt's international social impact trip serving communities in Guatemala, and she has also assisted at numerous events at Jones Elementary School near campus
- Hitt has also volunteered with the Ronald McDonald House and Dream Streets while participating as a college and career fair volunteer at Gateway Elementary school as well

**WILLIAMSON, A WINNER**

- John Williamson enters his 21st season as the Commodores' head coach
- Since starting the program from what used to be a club bowling team in 2004, he has transformed Vanderbilt bowling into one of the best in the country, boasting three NCAA championships and three runner-up finishes
- Under Williamson's direction, the Does won four Southland Bowling League titles before transitioning to Conference USA in 2023
- The program has produced 17 first-team All-Americans, four national players of the year and seven national rookies of the year
- Commodores have received a total of 60 All-America honors on the first, second and third teams and as honorable mentions
- With Williamson's guidance, Vanderbilt has won 52 tournament titles in its 21-year history
- He has been named the NTCA Coach of the Year on four occasions, most recently in 2023
