THE MATCHUP:

Series History

- Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 15-10-8, with the last match up coming last season in Music City when South Carolina was ranked #24 and Vanderbilt took a 1-1 draw
- The Commodores are 8-7-1 all time in Columbia, with the last visit coming in 2023 when South Carolina took a 3-1 victory
- Under head coach Darren Ambrose, the programs have met 11 times, and boast a 7-3-2 record
- Vanderbilt is the only team in the SEC with 12 wins on the year

The Opponent

- South Carolina enters the contest 10-2-5 (4-1-4 SEC) and are coming off a 0-0 draw with Texas A&M
- The Gamecocks lost to Georgetown, 1-0, just after Vanderbilt took down the Hoyas 1-0
- South Carolina's lone conference loss came at Kentucky on Oct. 16 with a 3-2 decision, just after the Commodores took down Kentucky 2-1

Scouting Report

- Katie Shea Collins leads the Gamecocks with 24 points, tied for the conference lead, off 10 goals and four assists
- Mackenzie Johnson has the second-most points with 15 off six goals and three assists
- Christina Tsaousis has the second-most shutouts in the SEC with seven

STORYLINES:

Last Time Out

- No. 21 Vanderbilt soccer shut out No. 4 Tennessee 2-0 on Sunday afternoon at the Vanderbilt Soccer Complex. It marks the program's first-ever win against a top-5 opponent. Vanderbilt (12-3-1, 6-2-1 SEC) has now won five straight SEC games and six of the last seven. The Dores conclude the home portion of the regular season 8-0-1 at The Plex, unbeaten at home for the first time since 2018 (10-0-1)
- The Commodores struck early when freshman Reagan Pentz scored her first career goal in the ninth minute, finishing off a cross from Olivia Stafford with an assist also credited to Courtney Jones
- Vanderbilt added insurance late in the second half as junior Sydney Watts found the back of the net in the 82nd minute, converting a setup from Grace Freeman and Margo Matula for her team-leading 11th goal of the season. Keeper Sara Wojdelko anchored the Commodore defense with six saves en route to her seventh shutout of the year and 18th of her career. Vanderbilt now has 10 clean sheets, the most since 2019 when the program had 11 shutouts

Vandy Firsts

- Opening weekend with was filled with plenty of first for those in black and gold
 - Adysen Armenta, Reagan Pentz, Brooke Dardano, Margo Matula, and Olivia Stafford each clocked their first starts for the black and gold against Austin Peay
 - Armenta, Susanna Soderman and Vicky Pugh scored their first career and Commodore goals
 - Grace Freeman, Pentz and Stafford dished their first career assists
- In the Dores second match of the year against Louisville, freshman Olivia Stafford scored her first career goal off a long ball from Mary Beth McLaughlin, which was later credited as the game winner in the 2-0 victory over Louisville
- Freshman Ellett Smith posted her first career goal and assist in the Dores 3-0 win over Oklahoma

Reagan Pentz Machine

- In her freshman debut against Austin Peay, Regean Pentz dished three assists, which were the most by a Commodore since Grace Jackson achieved the feat in 2019 against Jacksonville State

Preseason Nods

- The Commodores placed six student-athletes on the SEC Preseason Watchlist, the conference announced on Tuesday afternoon. Commodores included on the list are Courtney Jones, Hannah McLaughlin, Mary Beth McLaughlin, Maci Teater, Sydney Watts and Sara Wojdelko
 - Jones, a midfielder out of Orlando, Florida, started all 21 contests for the Dores during the 2024 season. The junior registered a career-best 14 points off five goals and four assists as the Commodores reached the Sweet 16 for the first time in program history
 - Hannah McLaughlin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, made 19 starts for the black and gold in 2024. The senior was named first-team All-SEC and United Soccer Coaches fourth-team all-region after anchoring a defense that allowed only 19 goals in the season and posted nine shutouts.
 - Mary Beth McLaughlin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, appeared in 16 matches, making four starts and logging over 580 minutes of play during her rookie season. The sophomore dished her first career assist in the 2024 conference opener at Auburn and was named SEC All-Freshman Team.
 - Teater, a midfielder out of St. Louis, started in all 21 matches for Vanderbilt in 2024 and dished a team-high-tying six assists. The senior scored her first career goal in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb and helped control a midfield that took down reigning national champion Florida State to advance to the Sweet 16.
 - Watts, a junior out of Lenexa, Kansas, led the team with nine goals last season and dished an assist to register a career-best 19 points. The forward posted the second brace of her career in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb, with her first brace coming earlier in the season against Saint Mary's (Calif.)
 - Wojdelko, a graduate out of Northville, Michigan, is back in goal after leading the Commodores to a historic season in 2024. The shot stopper made 14 saves in Vanderbilt's penalty kick win over Florida State to advance to the program's first Sweet 16 appearance. Her 14 stops were the most in a single game since Christy Barringer in 1992

New Staff

- Vanderbilt's soccer staff has welcomed three new faces ahead of the 2025 season:
 - **Jennie Clark** joins the program as an assistant after spending the last two seasons as an assistant at Northwestern, has earned a B license and a scouting license through the US Soccer Federation. Clark served as the first assistant coach for Minnesota Aurora FC, helping lead the squad to a perfect regular season and berth in the quarterfinals of the USL W League playoffs. Before joining the pros, Clark was an assistant at Utah Tech for two seasons, helping the program transition from Division II to Division I while coaching seven All-Western Athletic Conference honorees during her stint
 - **Calum Langdale** also joins the Commodores coaching staff as an assistant and goalkeeper coach. Langdale joins the black and gold after spending one season at Arkansas State as an assistant, where he served primarily as a goalkeepers coach. During the 2024 campaign at Arkansas State, Langdale helped the Red Wolves to a top-70 national ranking in all major goalkeeping categories, including save percentage, saves per game, shutout percentage and goals-against average
 - In the director of operations role, **Rachel Biddle** joined the program in March after spending a large part of her career as general manager at several boutique fitness studios in Nashville, combining her passion for sports and wellness. Some of her responsibilities included overseeing daily operations, driving sales, community outreach and programming.

New Year, New Faces

- This year, Vanderbilt welcomes eight new freshman to campus: Alexis Smith, Reagan Pentz, Caitlin Chase, Olivia Stafford, Foley Robertson, Vicky Pugh and Ava Sherrer ahead of the 2025 campaign
- Vanderbilt was ranked #13 in top recruiting classes for 2025

Splash in the Portal

- Ahead of 2025, Vanderbilt welcomed three transfers who bring a lot of experience to the squad
 - Brooke Dardano joins the black and gold after four years at Louisville where she appeared in 49 matches (32 starts). At midfield, she posted three goals and dished 11 assists to tally 17 points. Dardano missed the 2023 season due to injury
 - Grace Freeman joins the Commodores after spending her three years at Ole Miss. She appeared in 37 matches, making 32 starts and scored one goal and dished two assists. Freeman missed the majority of the 2022 season due to injury
 - Susanna Soderman joins Vandy after her time at Villanova where she was an All-BIG EAST First Team selection in her senior season while appearing in 51 games and making 34 starts

- This season, Vanderbilt has one set of sisters in the black and gold, Hannah (senior) and Mary Beth (sophomore) McLaughlin. It marks just the fourth time in program history that Vanderbilt will have a set of sisters playing together in the same season.

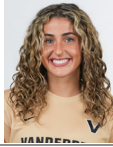

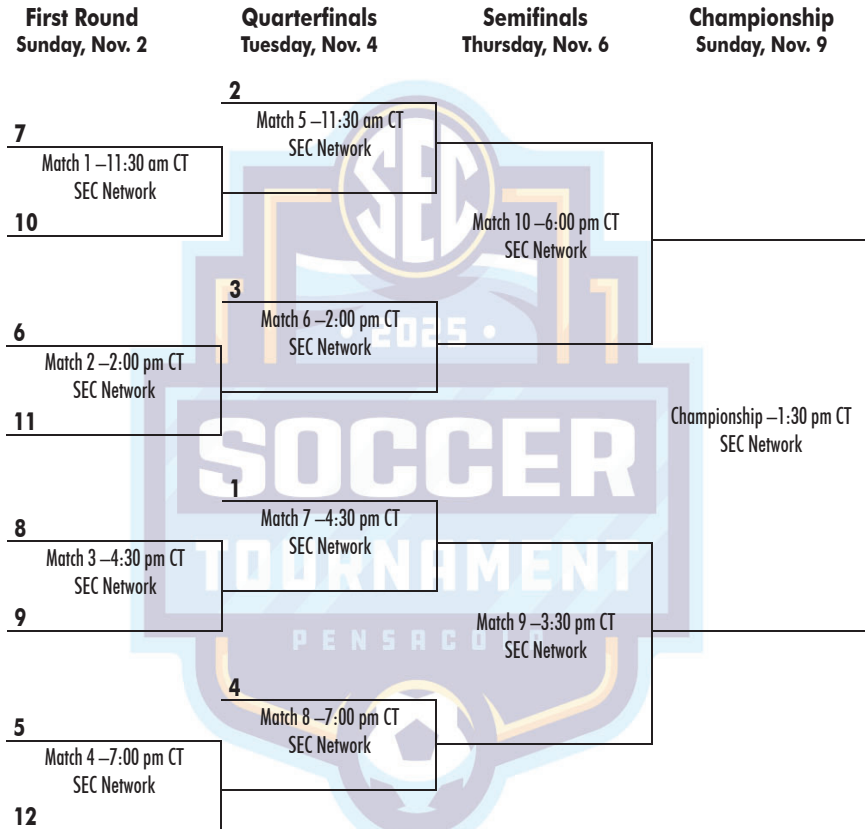

There shall be a single-elimination tournament of the top 12 teams played at the conclusion of the regular season schedule. The tournament champion shall be the Conference representative to the NCAA championship.

The top 12 teams with the highest point total will participate in the tournament. The following point system is utilized to determine regular season standings and seeding for the tournament: a win counts as three points, a tie as one, and a loss as zero points. If a game(s) is cancelled, neither team will receive a point and the standings will be determined by average points per game.

Tie-Breaker Procedures

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - A. Head-to-head competition between the tied teams.
 - B. Points earned versus common opponents.
 - C. Goal differential versus common opponents.
 - D. Goals scored versus common opponents.
 - E. Won-Lost record of the two teams versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if necessary.
 - F. Goal differential versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** The following procedure will be used until the tie is broken. If at any time this tie breaker results in only two remaining tied teams, then the two-team tiebreaker will be used beginning with Subsection A in that procedure and continuing from that point:

- A. If all teams have played one another, then most points earned in those matches only.
- B. If all teams have not played, but one team has defeated all teams in the tie break, then that team breaks the tie and shall be placed highest. Remaining teams will continue with the tie break procedure.
- C. If all teams have not played one another and a team does not have all wins over the tied teams, then use Subsection B in the two-team tie break procedures and continue through the two team tie-break procedures until ties between all teams are broken (except Subsection H will read "if three or more teams are still tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw").
