TICKETS & PARADE OF HOMES PROGRAMS

\$15/TICKET/PERSON

- Where to purchase tickets:
 - » Safeway locations in Grand Junction
 - » Online at gjparade.com (Click on "Buy Tickets")
 - Print or download your ticket on the app

PROGRAMS

- Safeway locations in Grand Junction
 - » They will give you a program after you purchase your ticket at the store
 - » Purchased your ticket online? Show Safeway a copy of your ticket and they will give you a program
 - One program per ticket
- » Publishes in The Daily Sentinel on Friday, October 2

TICKET FAQ

- Tickets good for all six days of the Parade
- Tickets are good for both in person and virtual Parade
 - » **In Person Parade**
 - Each ticket allows one (1) admission into each home in the parade, plus one (1) re-entry into a house of your choice.
 - » **Virtual Parade**
 - Go to gjparade.com and enter your unique ticket code
- Children 4 years old and over require a ticket.
Children must always be under parental supervision.



HOUSE LOCATIONS

- Homes are in Fruita and Grand Junction
- Number of in-person Parade Homes – 7; Virtual Only - 1
- Several homes are in new subdivisions not yet registered on GPS or Google Maps. Watch for Parade signs along popular roadways that will help navigate you to each home. You may find it helpful to download our app which provides driving directions.



SCAVENGER HUNT

- Located on page 40
- There is one photo for each of the eight homes in the parade.
Match the photo to the home the item is found in.
 - » Item on the scavenger hunt can be seen in person or on the virtual tour.
- Drop off your completed entry form to the American Furniture Warehouse in Grand Junction to be entered in a drawing for one \$500 gift card or for one \$250 gift card.
- Entries dropped off at Parade Homes will not be entered in the drawing.

FALL PARADE OF HOMES COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES & DETAILS

Our highest priority remains everyone's health and well-being, which means things will look a little different when attending the in-person parade homes. We continue to monitor the situation, and our builders have implemented a series of safety recommendations to keep visitors safe. The HBA of Western Colorado met with the Mesa County Health Department prior to Parade of Homes planning to obtain their professional advice in planning this year's event.

AS YOU TOUR THE HOMES, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

MASKS

Masks are required unless you have a health condition that prevents you from wearing one. Please come prepared with your own mask as they will not be provided by the builders.

BOOTIES

Builders may ask that you use stocking feet instead of wearing booties. If a home offers booties, please take your pair with you and use at the remaining parade homes. Booties are unable to be shared this year.

To keep traffic moving, please carry your shoes as you tour the homes.

HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizer stations are located at the entry of each home in the Parade and are supplied and sponsored by Rocky Mountain Sanitation.

DO NOT TOUCH

Do not touch surfaces. Please do not open cabinet doors and do not touch surfaces such as faucets, door handles, etc.

All high touch surfaces will be frequently sanitized.

IN PERSON & VIRTUAL

Seven of the Parade Homes are available to tour both in person and virtually. One of our Parade homes is virtual only. Your ticket is good for both the in-person and virtual Parade

RULES MAY CHANGE
