This is in furtherance to our disclosure dated May 3, 2023 and May 17, 2023 in the matter of Civil Miscellaneous Appeals filed before the Hon'ble Madras High Court by Phonographic Performance Limited & Ors against the FM Radio Broadcasters wherein D. B. Corp Limited (earlier Synergy Media Entertainment Limited) is one of the FM Radio Broadcasters and was one of the parties to this Order.

B. Corp Limited is one of the parties. The hearing of same is yet to be held.</p> <p>Contempt Petition had been filed by the appellant in C.M.A. No. 3383 of 2010 viz. Phonographic Performance Limited (PPL) under Section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971 seeking to punish the respondents for their alleged wilful disobedience of the common judgement dated 27.04.2023 in C.M.A. No. 3383 of 2010.</p>

		<p>The Hon'ble Madras High Court ('the Court') heard the said contempt petition and passed an order on July 31, 2024.</p> <p>The Court has not held any contempt, however, has asked the Company to deposit 50% of its tentative liability in the Court within 4 weeks i.e. up to August 30, 2024. The approximate amount will be Rs. 11,50,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven crore fifty lakh only).</p> <p>The Company is in the process of evaluating the further course of action in this regard.</p>
