These measures apply from 01.02.22 and replace the previous ones.

TESTING: WHEN, HOW, WHERE?



HIGH RISK CONTACT WITHOUT SYMPTOMS

Have you been in contact with an infected person for more than 15 minutes and within a distance of less than 1.5 metres?

VACCINATED

Last vaccination <5 months or booster vaccination or you are between 12 and 17 years old and have received your basic vaccination.

Last vaccination >5 months and no booster vaccin.

PCR TEST AND QUARANTINE NOT NEEDED

but remain cautious for 10 days after the high-risk contact: limit your social contacts, avoid vulnerable people, respect distance, wear a face mask (preferably FFP2) and keep on teleworking.

7 DAYS QUARANTINE.

Can be terminated from day 4 on condition of a daily negative self-test from day 4 to day 7 In the meantime, remain extra cautious for 10 days after the high risk contact.

POSITIVE SELF-TEST

(you are probably infected)

NEGATIVE SELF-TEST

(you are probably not infected)

Request an activation code for a PCR test on www.myhealth.belgium.be or at the Contact Centre 02 214 19 19 and go into isolation until you get the result of the PCR test.

POSITIVE

NEGATIVE

7 DAYS OF ISOLATION.

Isolation ends on day 7 on condition of 3 days without fever and improvement of the symptoms. After that, remain extra cautious for 3 days: limit the number of contacts to the strictly necessary.

Wear continuously a mask indoors

[preferably FFP2].

QUARANTINE CAN BE TERMINATED.

NOT VACCINATED

10 DAYS QUARANTINE.

Can be terminated from day 7 on condition of a daily negative self-test from day 7 to day 10. In the meantime, remain extra cautious for 10 days after the high risk contact.

POSITIVE SELF-TEST

(you are probably infected)

NEGATIVE SELF-TEST

(you are probably not infected)

Request an activation code for a PCR test on www.myhealth.belgium.be or at the Contact Centre 02 214 19 19 and go into isolation until you get the result of the PCR test.

POSITIVE

7 DAYS OF ISOLATION.

Isolation ends on day 7 on condition of 3 days without fever and improvement of the symptoms. After that, remain extra cautious for 3 days: limit the number of contacts to the strictly necessary.

Wear continuously a mask indoors

[preferably FFP2].

NEGATIVE

QUARANTINE CAN BE TERMINATED

Anyone who took a positive PCR- or rapid test less than 5 months ago follows the same measures as the vaccinated people (see above), as long as he or she has no symptoms.
