Technology at Treeapp

Our end goal is to let anyone come on our platform and be able to start living a sustainable lifestyle, through both tailored suggestions of products/information and the ability to create real impact (plant trees only for now) online/offline. Treeapp has been growing rapidly and gained over 60,000 users. We are dynamic and are constantly building different new systems and evolving/scaling our existing systems. Some of the technologies we use include Flutter, Spring, Postgres and Google Cloud for most of our infrastructure.

The role

As a Mobile QA Test Engineer you will join a cross functional Agile team analysing what level testing should be completed and then write and execute functional, physical and user tests on our mobile application platform(s). You'll be profiling and debugging using tools such as XCode, Android Studio and VS Code; and logging and investigating when and how bugs were introduced.

You will liaise with the customer service team to monitor bugs reported by our users and triage each report so that the development teams can fix known issues.

There's currently a remote interview and onboarding process as well as the ability to work from home. In time, you will join colleagues in the London office. You will be joining a diverse team environment with a range of perks, training and career development opportunities.

What we look for:

- Experience of testing mobile applications or a passion and desire to learn how.
- Knowledge or want to learn mobile test automation tools or processes.
- Passion and desire to think like our users and design testing, aiming to deliver a high quality product.
- Ability to work with a number of different teams and consolidate and manage feedback accordingly.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.

- Successfully held a QA Tester role OR wishes to start a career in QA and testing.
- Holds or is studying towards a computer science or equivalent degree.
- Experience in testing on multiple platforms, including Mobile, Console and Web.
- Experience in creating Test and Use Cases.

- Knowledge of process within an agile environment (scrum).
