Top universities

The universities in the region are ranked among the best in the world. Besides Erasmus University and Delft University of Technology, the Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences has a dedicated maritime faculty. In Rotterdam you will also find the headquarters of the STC Group, one of most international maritime education and training institutes in the world.

Vibrant networks for young professionals

In the Rotterdam region there are various student associations and network initiatives for maritime oriented young professionals. All off these initiatives organise various kinds of events.
