B. Report on Intertie Agreement Supplying Emergency Water to City of Pacifica.

General Manager Barrow reported that District had been supplying water to the entire City of Pacifica since November 4th due to a leak in their main transmission line. Mr. Barrow pass around photos of the repair to the transmission line.

C. Report on District Facilities During P.G.&E. Power Outage.

General Manager Barrow reported during the P.G.&E. power outage the District lost power to the Skyline Pump Station and the Avalon Sewer Lift Station. With the power outage at the Skyline Pump Station the District was unable to determine the actual tank levels and staff had to visit the site daily to run the pumps manually. Mr. Barrow reported that the standby power generator at the Avalon Sewer Lift Station worked great. Mr. Barrow stated he learned during a power outage it would be very difficult to find a generator due to the high demand. Also, P.G.&E had reserved generators in advance which made it even more difficult. Mr. Barrow stated that the District should consider purchasing a standby power generator for the Westborough Water Pump Station.

D. Report on Coastside County Water District Election.

General Manager Barrow reported that Coastside County Water District had received a request to convert their District elections to an At-Large Zone Based elections.
