What is a Water Meter Service Charge?

The water meter service charge is a standard fee charged by water utilities to pay for meter reading, and the periodic replacement of water meters, meter boxes and lids, as well as other maintenance needed to ensure the availability of water delivery to each customer.

Water rates are based on water use as shown by each customer's water meter and generate the revenue needed to pay for wholesale water supplies, to operate the water system and to invest in necessary upgrades to the water delivery system to provide safe and reliable water service.

Below are the results of surveys to see how we compare to other water utilities in the area:

LOWER YOUR SEWER SERVICE CHARGE

Are you aware that your sewer service charge for the entire fiscal year is based on how much water you use during January-February meter reading period?

Lowering your sewer charges is easy to do, but **must be done NOW**! All you have to do is reduce your water usage as much as you can from January 2 through March 4, 2013. The sewer service charge on your annual property tax bill for fiscal year 2013-2014 will reflect your savings. *Note:* There is a 12 unit minimum annual sewer service charge. Please check all plumbing fixtures and repair any leaks!

The Westborough Water District is now offering our NEW ONLINE PAYMENT SYSTEM where you can access your utility account for payments, history, and sign up for AUTOPAY (recurring payments via MasterCard, Visa or Check). Now you can securely view or pay your bi-monthly water bill and payments are recorded in real time. Bill payment service is free at this time.
