

# **The Water Faucet**

### **Water Supply Conditions**

California is in the midst of a statewide drought emergency and we need to continue to preserve water supplies in the event that subsequent years of drought condition persist. There was above normal precipitation during February at Hetch Hetchy and within local watersheds. March returned to below normal conditions. Precipitation at Hetch Hetchy for March was just below 77% of normal. As of April 15<sup>th</sup> Hetch Hetchy was about 50% of average annual total precipitation. Generally we receive about 14% of our annual precipitation from April to June. We would like to commend everyone for their water conservation efforts, though we are continuing to request a 10 percent reduction in your water use. The SFPUC will evaluate the water storage supply on June 15<sup>th</sup> to determine if the 10% voluntary reduction is sufficient for San Francisco customers and Westborough Water District customers.  $\[match = 10\]$ 

#### **Sewer Service Charge on Property Tax Bill**

The amount of water you consumed during January and February 2014 will be used to determine your annual sewer service charge, which appears on your property tax bill effective July 1, 2014. Westborough Water District (WWD) customers mistakenly received a notice from the City of South San Francisco concerning the City's sewer service charge rate increase.

The automated system prevents human errors when reading the meters or transposing numbers. The District has touch and wireless meter reading equipment. Our

wireless meter reading equipment (for commercial meters only) allows us to remotely read the meters efficiently without leaving the

vehicle. With this technology we can read meters in inclement weather.

The funds can be deducted from your checking, savings, or Visa/MasterCard account automatically each billing period. This will eliminate ever having a late charge and saves you money. #### Rebates

The WWD offers washing machine and toilet rebates. Both programs are administered through the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA). They will reimburse

customers \$50 to \$125 for qualifying new washing machine purchases depending on the type of machine you purchase. The District offers up to \$100 rebate to customers who replace a toilet that uses 3.5 gallons per flush or more with an EPA WaterSense labeled HET (High-Efficiency Toilet). The HET are modern water-efficient toilets that are designed to use 1.3 GPF or less.
