## **RESOLUTION NO. 663**

## ADOPTING AN UPDATED SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN, AN OVERFLOW EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN, AND A WATER QUALITY MONITORING PLAN

## WESTBOROUGH WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in July 2005, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) required public entities that own and operate sanitary sewer collection systems to prepare a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP), and issued guidelines for the preparation of the SSMP; and

WHEREAS, in May 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board, issued

Order No. 2006-0003 General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems, which
required the District to update its SSWP every five years; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2010, pursuant to Ordinance No. 60, the Board of Directors (Board) adopted a SSMP; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2015, the Board adopted a revised SSMP; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2017, the Board recertified the SSMP; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to adopt a revised SSMP, along with an Overflow Emergency Response Plan (OERP) and Water Quality Monitoring Plan (WQMP), all of which are attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Westborough Water District as follows:

- 1. The District hereby adopts the revised Sewer System Management Plan, and adopts the Overflow Emergency Response Plan (OERP) and the Water Quality Monitoring Plan (WQMP).
- 2. The General Manager is hereby authorized to take any further steps necessary to effectuate this action.
