

RESOLUTION NO. 691

ADOPTING AN UPDATED SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN

WESTBOROUGH WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, in July 2005, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) required public entities that own and operate sanitary sewer collection systems to prepare a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP), and issued guidelines for the preparation of the SSMP; and

WHEREAS, in May 2006, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board), issued Order No. 2006-0003 General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems, which required the District to update its SSWP every five years; and

WHEREAS, in December, 2022, the State Board reissued Order No. 2022-0103 General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems, which now requires that SSWPs be updated every six years; and

WHEREAS, according to the State Board's records, a revised SSWP is due by August 2, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2010, pursuant to Ordinance No. 60, the Board of Directors (Board) adopted a SSMP; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2015, the Board adopted a revised SSMP; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2017, the Board recertified the SSMP; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2022, the Board recertified the SSMP; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to adopt a revised SSMP, which is attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Westborough Water District as follows:

1. The District hereby adopts the revised Sewer System Management Plan.

2. The General Manager is hereby authorized to submit and certify the SSWP with the State Board and take any further steps necessary to effectuate this action.
