



Adventure Park Safety Rules

1. Traditional swimwear is required at Clay's Resort Jellystone Park™.

This is a family-friendly park, and we reserve the right to determine whether a guest's attire is appropriate. No provocative or thong swimsuits, clothing with rivets, buckles, belts or metal ornaments are permitted. No long pants or cut-off shorts. Children in diapers and those being toilet trained must wear approved swim pants in the water. Failure to comply with any part of the dress code may result in you being asked to change clothing or to leave the park without refund.

2. For your safety, life vests are required for all guests except in our "Chill Zone."

You are encouraged to bring your own if it is well fitting and U.S. Coast Guard approved. Complimentary life vests are available in the adventure park on a first-come, first-served basis. Flotation devices are for adult use only and can be used in the CHILL ZONE. Guests are encouraged to bring their own for sun-bathing or to use ours.

3. Clay's Resort allows personal flotation devices for adults in our Chill Zone ONLY.

No food or drinks are permitted on these devices. For Safety Reasons floatation units may be limited based on the capacity of the swimming lake. Clay's Resort Management reserves the right to limit the size and number of flotation devices at any time.

4. Glass bottles of any kind are not permitted.

5. Pets of any kind are not permitted on the beach or near the water.

Designated areas along the tree lines are available for your pets that are leashed. Please pick up after your pets to keep our adventure park clean!

6. The slides in the baby section are meant for young children.

Please make sure they are sitting down in a forward position. Please don't catch your child at the bottom of the slides.

7. There is no pushing, pulling or head-first entry off of the barrel.

Do not hold onto the handrails while standing on the barrel.

8. Alcohol is not permitted to be brought into the adventure park but may be purchased at the Beach House Tiki Bar.

9. Enjoy grilling in our designated areas.

10. Please park bikes in the bike racks provided above the Beach House.

11. Please park your car or golf cart in the designated area for parking. No carts or vehicles are permitted in the beach areas.

16. Diapers are not permitted in the water. Swimmers are required.
17. Please take children on frequent bathroom breaks.
18. Please don't ever swim when you have diarrhea.
19. Please wash hands with soap and water after bathroom breaks/diaper changes.
20. Zipline riders must be able to hold their own body weight.
21. Zipline riders must ride all the way to the end of the zipline.
22. No climbing or hanging on splash pad equipment.
23. No flipping is allowed
24. No diving is permitted
25. Patrons must be 42" tall to be on the large obstacle course.
26. Non-swimmers are not permitted in the water.
27. Patrons must remain in boats at all times.

Bad Weather & Thunder Breaks

When severe thunderstorms or bad weather are spotted, our priority is the safety of our guests and staff.

- The Aquatic Supervisor or Head Guard will announce that severe thunderstorms are in the area and EVERYONE must exit the water immediately.
- This includes all boaters, swimmers, patrons standing on or near the Zipline & Wet Willy Towers, as well as anyone sitting near the water's edge.
- Lightning most frequently occurs within 10 miles of a thunderstorm, and patrons and staff will be notified to seek shelter when thunderstorms move within 10 miles or when thunder is heard.
- There is a 30-minute waiting period after each thunder is heard or lightning sighted before patrons and staff will be permitted back in or near the water.
- Lightning's behavior is random and unpredictable. We recommend a very conservative attitude towards it.

When in doubt, remember "When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors!"
