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## **DECISION**

**FCTC/COP10(1)      Special procedures for the conduct of the *de minimis* session of the  
Tenth session of the Conference of the Parties to the WHO FCTC**

The Conference of the Parties,

Having considered the report on special procedures submitted and contained in document FCTC/COP/10/27,

DECIDES to adopt the special procedures set out in the Annex to this decision to regulate the conduct of the virtual *de minimis* session of the Tenth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP10).

## ANNEX

### **SPECIAL PROCEDURES TO REGULATE THE CONDUCT OF THE *DE MINIMIS* VIRTUAL SESSION OF COP10**

#### **RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE COP**

1. The Rules of Procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP) to the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (WHO FCTC) shall continue to apply in full, except to the extent that they are inconsistent with these special procedures, in which case the COP decision to adopt these special procedures shall operate as a decision to suspend the relevant Rules of Procedure to the extent necessary.<sup>1</sup>

#### **ATTENDANCE**

2. Attendance by Parties, States and regional economic integration organizations that are not Parties, the Secretariat, intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations accredited by the COP pursuant to Rules 30 and 31, and accredited media<sup>2</sup> shall be through secured access to videoconference or other electronic means allowing representatives to hear other participants and to address, as appropriate, the meeting remotely.

#### **QUORUM**

3. It is understood that virtual attendance of Parties shall be taken into account when calculating the presence of a quorum.

#### **ADDRESSING THE COP**

4. Parties, States and regional economic integration organizations that are not Parties, the Secretariat, and intergovernmental and nongovernmental organizations accredited by the COP pursuant to Rules 30 and 31, shall be provided with the opportunity to take the floor.

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<sup>1</sup> This will affect notably the relevant provisions of the following Rules of Procedure of COP:

- Rules 18 (credentials);
- Rules 24quinquies (committees of the COP);
- Rule 51 and Rules 54–56 (voting by show of hands and secret ballot); and
- Rule 66 (insofar as these special procedures may not be regarded as amendments, but only as exceptional suspensions or additions to the Rules of Procedure, subject to consensus by the COP).

<sup>2</sup> Considering the virtual format of the meeting, the accreditation of members of the public will be suspended. Subject to decision of the COP, the *de minimis* virtual session of the Tenth session of the COP shall be open and therefore not suitable to be webcast live by the COP.

## COMMITTEES

5. All business shall be conducted in plenary. Accordingly, committees shall not be established. Matters generally entrusted to Committee B under Rule 24quinquies shall be determined by the plenary.

## REGISTRATION AND CREDENTIALS

6. Given the need to grant virtual access to the meeting with due regard for timely and secure conduct of business, as well as Article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC, all credentials and lists of representatives shall be submitted electronically to the Convention Secretariat through the online registration system no later than 21 November 2023.

7. The credentials accepted by the COP for the *de minimis* virtual session of the Tenth session of the COP (COP10) will remain valid for the resumed COP10, to take place at dates to be confirmed. Parties not among those listed in the decision of the COP adopting credentials for the *de minimis* virtual session of COP10 shall submit credentials in accordance with Rule 18 for the resumed COP10.

## DECISION-MAKING

8. As already provided for by the Rules of Procedure, in accordance with Rule 50, decisions on budgetary and financial matters shall be taken by consensus and in conformity with the financial rules referred to in Article 23.4 of the Convention. For all other decisions, the COP shall make every effort to reach agreement by consensus.

9. If all efforts to reach consensus on decisions referred to in paragraph 8 have been exhausted and no agreement has been reached, the COP shall proceed as a last resort as follows:

(a) in the event that a vote is required, voting shall take place by roll call conducted through the virtual system; and

(b) during a roll-call vote, should any delegate fail to cast a vote for any reason during the roll call, that delegate shall be called upon a second time after the conclusion of the initial roll call. Should the delegate fail to cast a vote on the second call, the delegation concerned shall be recorded as absent.

## EXCEPTIONAL MEASURES

10. The procedures set out above are adopted only for the purpose of the *de minimis* virtual session of COP10 as exceptional measures to enable the work of COP10 to continue during the extraordinary situation arising from the postponement of COP10, and they should not be considered as setting a precedent for future sessions of the COP.

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
