Background

1. The Bureau elected by the Conference of the Parties (COP) to the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (WHO FCTC) at its tenth session met on 16 November 2025 to examine the credentials submitted to the Convention Secretariat in accordance with Rules 18 and 19 of the Rules of Procedure of the COP.
