(Wiradjuri Country)



Don't forget to buy tickets at Yarrangobilly Caves Visitor Centre beforehand. Let us begin by acknowledging the Wiradjuri people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Snowy Mountains Highway, B72

- Turn on to Caves Entrance Road then drive for 2.6 km
- Turn sharp left onto Caves Entrance Road and drive for another 2.9 km
- Turn sharp right and drive for another 20 m

## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- $\bullet$  Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- $\bullet \ \ \text{Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely}\\$
- $\bullet$  Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.
