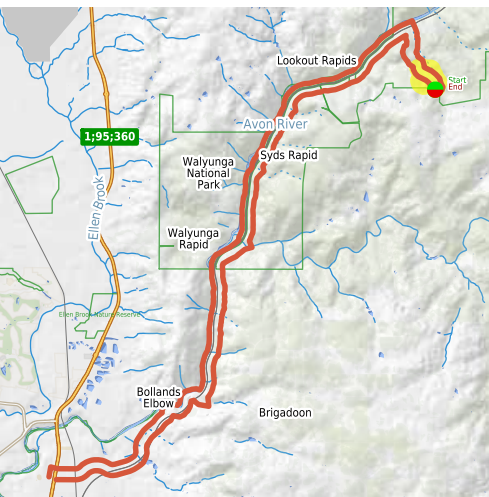
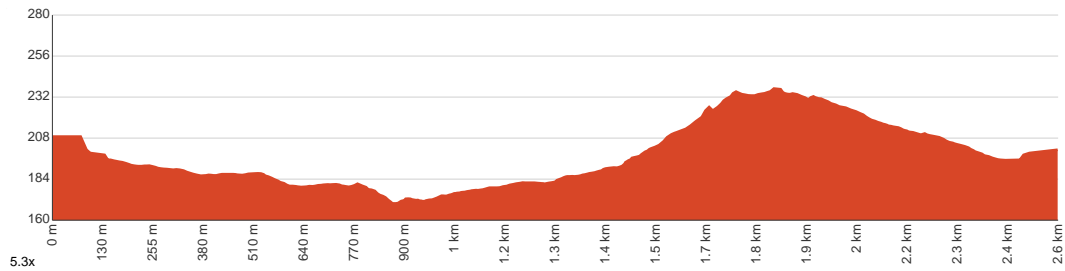

Easy track

Starting from Paruna Sanctuary, Gidgegannup, this walk takes you on a circuit around the area. This is the easiest of three trails in the Paruna Wildlife Sanctuary. You can enjoy views along the Avon River Valley through the walk, with ancient rock formations scattered throughout the spectacular woodland. As the wildlife is pretty rich, you can be ready to have small encounters, especially with croaking frogs during the winter months of June, July and August. You can follow the beige markers depicting a possum at turns and junctions while you traverse. It is also suitable for all fitness levels. Let us begin by acknowledging the Wajuk people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (1/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (1/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (1/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (1/6)

Getting to the start: From Great Northern Highway, 1, 95, Baskerville.

- Turn on to Cathedral Avenue then drive for 16.8 km
- Keep right and drive for another 2.1 km
- Turn sharp right and drive for another 730 m
- Turn left and drive for another 1.4 km
- Turn right and drive for another 20 m

Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







Start.




After another 15 m **turn right.**




After another 70 m **turn left.**




After another 70 m come to the end.




After another 15 m **continue straight.**




After another 85 m cross the ford.




From the Possum Trail **turn sharp right**, to head along Possum Trail (a footpath).



After another 610 m cross the ford.




After another 30 m cross the bridge (about 8 m long)



After another 430 m (from the Possum Trail) **continue straight**, to head along Possum Trail.



After another 630 m (from the Possum Trail) **continue straight**, to head along Possum Trail.



After another 590 m (from the Possum Trail) **continue straight** (a vehicle track).



After another 45 m **continue straight.**
